THE TWINS: Have gone 2-1 through three games on their seven-game roadtrip, winning the first two at Guaranteed Rate Field on Thursday and Friday nights, following by a loss last night... today, the Twins will play the season/series finale against the White Sox... after today's game, the Twins will travel to Cincinnati to play the Reds for three games from Monday-Wednesday... the Twins have gone 43-32 at home and 35-39 on the road. The Twins have gone 8-5 in their last 13 road games.

TWINS COME BACK LATE, FALL SHORT: The Twins lost to the White Sox last night at Guaranteed Rate Field by a score of 7-6, scoring five runs across the eighth and ninth innings combined... Pablo López (10-8) was the starter and loser, allowing five runs on eight hits in 5.0 innings pitched, with no walks and eight strikeouts... the offense recorded nine hits and were led by Royce Lewis, who went 3-for-4 with a walk... Minnesota went 3-for-14 with runners in scoring position and left 10 men on base.

CENTRAL FOCUS: Last night's loss in Chicago paired with the Guardians win over Texas, kept the Twins' magic number at seven... Minnesota enters today at 78-71 with a 7.0 game lead on the Guardians, who sit at 71-78... below is a brief look at Minnesota and Cleveland: Minnesota 78-71 -- Lost at CWS, 6-7 at CWS (Gray vs. Cease) 3 at CIN (9/18-20) Cleveland 71-78 7.0 Won vs. TEX, 2-1 at TEX (Williams vs. TBA) 3 at KC (9/18-20)

TWINS AND SOX: Twins and White Sox are playing the 13th and final time in 2023... Minnesota has gone 8-4 against the Sox this season, going 5-1 at Target Field and 3-3 at Guaranteed Rate Field... the Twins have outscored the Sox this season 66-41. These two will play 13 times in 2024... the Twins will host the White Sox for the first time for a four-game series from April 22-25... Minnesota will travel to Chicago from April 29-May 1 for a three-game series.

Minnesota has won six of their last seven over Chicago. Since 2015, the Twins have gone 86-69 against the Sox, their most wins against any opponent in that span. Since 2019, no opponent has homered at Guaranteed Rate Field more than the Twins, with 78 (next is Kansas City with 46). Christian Vázquez is hitting .317 (40-for-126) with seven doubles, one home run, 17 RBI, 10 walks, a .368 on-base percentage and a .764 OPS in 40 career games vs. the Sox... Vázquez is hitting .333 (22-for-66) with an .813 OPS in 21 career games at Guaranteed Rate. Alex Kirilloff is hitting .333 (26-for-78) with six doubles, three home runs, 17 RBI and an .891 OPS in 21 career games vs. the Sox... he has driven in 15 runs in his last 13 games against Chicago... he is slashing .366/.366/.561 in 11 career games at GRF. Jorge Polanco is hitting .317 (53-for-104) with three doubles, seven home runs, 23 RBI and a .958 OPS in his last 26 games on the South Side... he has driven in 15 runs in his last 11 games here... Polo's 14 career homers and 44 career RBI at Guaranteed Rate are his most in any opposing ballpark.

SERIES CONVERSATIONS: The Twins are seeking their 24th series victory this season... they are 23-19-5 in series play in 2023, going 13-8-3 at home and 10-11-2 on the road. The Twins have gone 6-3-1 in series play since August 11. The Twins have won three of their last four road series* and four of their last six away from Target Field. Minnesota is looking for its second-straight series win over the White Sox and their first at Guaranteed Rate Field since taking two of three from July 4-6, 2022.

MINNESOTA'S GREATEST HITS: In 31 games since August 12, the Twins have posted an .816 OPS with 5.9 runs-per-game in that span... since that date, they rank first in baseball in walks (137), second in on-base percentage (.353), third in runs-per-game (5.9), fourth in OPS (.816), fifth in slugging percentage (.463), tied for fifth in home runs (52) and eighth in batting average (.263). Of the Twins' 26 runs scored this series, 17 have been scored after the sixth inning, including four four-run innings.

SEPTEMBERS TO REMEMBER: In 13 games since September 1, Carlos Correa has hit .320 (16-for-50) with three doubles, two home runs, eight RBI, six walks, a .404 on-base percentage, a .500 slugging percentage and a .904 OPS... last September/October, he hit .355 (44-for-124) with eight doubles, seven home runs, 19 RBI, a .412 on-base percentage, a .589 slugging percentage and a 1.000 OPS in 31 games.

POLO ON THE MARK: Jorge Polanco has reached safely in 19 of his last 20 games since August 22, hitting .315 (23-for-73) with four doubles, four home runs, 13 RBI, 14 walks, a .420 on-base percentage, a .534 slugging percentage and a .955 OPS in that span... since that date, he ranks fourth in the AL in OBP and ninth in OPS.

RED HOT ROOKIE: After starting the season hitting .182 (6-for-33) with a .576 OPS in his first eight games, Royce Lewis has hit .335 (58-for-173) with a .985 OPS in his last 47 games. Since August 23, his 34 RBI lead baseball... additionally, his 10 home runs since that date are third most in baseball, trailing Trea Turner (12) and Kyle Schwarber (11). Among all MLB rookies with a minimum of 225 plate appearances, Lewis ranks first in batting average (.311), OPS (.923), OPS+ (152.1), at-bats-per-RBI (4.04), wOBA (.396) and slugging percentage (.549).

TWINS MINOR LEAGUE WEEKLYS: High-A Cedar Rapids catcher Noah Cardenas and Cedar Rapids right-handed pitcher C.J. Culpepper have been named Twins minor league Player and Pitcher of the Week. Cardenas, 24, played in three games for the Kernels, hitting .500 (4-for-8) with one double, two RBI, five walks and no strikeouts, while posting a 1.317 OPS. Culpepper, 21, made the start for Kernels on Friday against Peoria in the decisive Game 3 of the Midwest League West Division Series, allowing one run on four hits in 5.0 innings pitched, with one walk and eight strikeouts.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2022, Matt Wallner made his major league debut in game one of a doubleheader at Progressive Field... he homered in his third at-bat of the game, a solo shot in the eighth inning off Shane Bieber.

- ☞ Making his 277th career appearance and 268th career start...also his 30th start/appearance this season.
- ☞ Owns the second-lowest ERA (2.96) among qualified American League pitchers and ranks fourth in MLB, trailing SD's Blake Snell (2.43), CHC's Justin Steele (2.73), NYY's Gerrit Cole (2.79) and NYM's Kodai Senga (2.95).
- ☞ Facing Chicago-AL for the 13th time in his career and the third time this season...is 5-2, 3.98 ERA (63.1 IP, 28 ER) with 24 walks and 57 strikeouts in his previous 12 appearances (11 starts).
- ☞ Acquired by the Twins on March 13, 2022 in a trade with the Cincinnati Reds, along with right-handed pitcher Francis Peguero, in exchange for right-handed pitcher Chase Petty.

LAST TIME OUT: Took his seventh loss of the season in his last start on September 11 vs. Tampa Bay...pitched 4.0 innings and allowed two runs (1 earned) on six hits, with one walk and five strikeouts in a 7-4 Twins' defeat...allowed an RBI single to Josh Lowe in the first inning...allowed an unearned run in the top of the third when Randy Arozarena reached on an error (Carlos Correa) and scored on Jose Siri's RBI single...recorded his third pickoff of the year in the third (Siri, second base), tying his single-season career high (also 3 pickoffs in 2018 with New York-AL)...matched his single-game career high by hitting two batters (Luke Raley, first and third innings), last doing so on July 18, 2021 vs. Milwaukee with Cincinnati...relieved by Dylan Floro in the fifth inning, who surrendered a three-run home run to Taylor Walls...Brent Headrick entered in the sixth inning and yielded a solo home run to Yandy Diaz and an RBI groundout to Vidal Brujan.

- ☞ Snapped his nine-start streak of pitching 6.0-or-more innings, dating back to July 22...marked his longest streak since another nine-game stretch in 2017 with Oakland and New York (career long is 13 starts from May 29-August 7, 2015 with Oakland).
- ☞ Recorded his 1,500th career strikeout in the first inning (Taylor Walls), becoming the 24th active pitcher to reach the milestone.

TWO STARTS AGO: Did not factor into the decision despite recording his 15th quality start of the year on September 5 at Cleveland...pitched 6.0 innings and allowed three runs on six hits (1 HR), with two walks and four strikeouts in an 8-3 Twins' victory...pitched 1-2-3 first and second innings before surrendering a two-run home run to Bo Naylor in the third...yielded a go-ahead sacrifice fly to Myles Straw in the fifth inning...relieved in the seventh inning by Griffin Jax as the bullpen combined to pitch 3.0 scoreless innings...the Twins took the lead in the eighth inning after a sacrifice fly by Jorge Polanco, Carlos Correa scored on a wild pitch and Donovan Solano hit a bases-clearing triple.

HOMERS NOT FOUND: Has allowed just seven home runs through his 29 starts this season...owns the fewest homers in baseball among pitchers with at least 20 starts...also owns the lowest home runs-per-9.0 inning ratio in baseball (0.38)...is one of two pitchers in Twins' history (since 1961) to allow six-or-fewer home runs in his first 27 starts of the year, joining Francisco Liriano (4 HR through first 28 GS in 2010)...his home runs-per-9.0 inning ratio is the lowest by a qualified pitcher in a single season in Twins' history (1961-).

CHICAGO FREESTYLE: Gray is facing the White Sox for the 13th time in his career and the third time this season...is 1-0, 1.64 ERA (11.0 IP, 2 ER) with three walks and nine strikeouts in his two previous starts this season...is 5-2, 3.98 (63.1 IP, 28 ER) with 24 walks and 57 strikeouts in his previous 12 career appearances (11 starts)...worked around a pair of singles to Andrew Benintendi and Eloy Jiménez, and a walk to Yasmani Grandal to complete a scoreless first inning...tossed a 1-2-3 second before running into trouble in the third...in that frame, allowed one-out singles to Tim Anderson and Luis Robert Jr., who then executed a double steal of home and second to get the White Sox on the board; Grandal then singled home Robert Jr. for the second run.

☞ Is 1-1, 4.82 ERA (18.2 IP, 10 ER) with five walks and 14 strikeouts in four starts against the White Sox since joining the Twins...is his third-highest ERA against any team since the start of 2022, trailing Pittsburgh (5.40) and Los Angeles-NL (5.19).

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: Gray is making his 15th road start of the season; is 3-3, 3.18 ERA (79.1 IP, 28 ER) with 30 walks and 77 strikeouts in his 14 prior road outings...has allowed three-or-fewer earned runs in 13 of his 14 road starts this season, with his start on July 17 at Seattle (5.2 IP, 5 R/ER) being his lone blemish...also has eight quality starts on the road this year...is 7-6, 3.36 ERA (121.1 IP, 49 ER) with 41 walks and 116 strikeouts in 25 starts on the road since becoming a Twin.

- ☞ Owns the fifth-lowest ERA on the road this season among qualified American League pitchers.
- ☞ Making his first start at Guaranteed Rate Field since September 2, 2022...is 2-1, 5.34 ERA (28.2 IP, 17 ER) with 12 walks and 27 strikeouts in six appearances on the South Side (including 5 starts).

THE ARSENAL: Gray has used a six-pitch mix this season, per Baseball Savant...currently uses his four-seam fastball the most at 26.8 percent...recorded three of his five strikeouts using his fastball in his last start on September 11 vs. Tampa Bay...primarily uses his curveball (299 pitches) and changeup (166 pitches) against lefties and his cutter (258 pitches), sinker (352 pitches) and sweeper (346 pitches) against righties...here's a look at his repertoire:

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP JOE RYAN (2023 SEASON: 10-9, 4.20 ERA // CAREER: 25-18, 3.89 ERA)

Right-hander Joe Ryan is slated to start the three-game series opener against the Cincinnati Reds tomorrow night at Great American Ball Park...did not factor into the decision in his last start on September 12 vs. Tampa Bay, a 3-2 Twins' win, pitched 4.2 innings and allowed two runs on five hits (1 HR), with two walks and seven strikeouts in his first career start against his former organization...facing the Reds for the first time in his career; Cincinnati will be the 23rd team he has faced in the majors...is 5-9, 5.71 ERA (108.2 IP, 69 ER) with 42 walks and 103 strikeouts in 21 previous starts when facing a new opponent...is 2-2, 7.00 ERA (18.0 IP, 14 ER), with four walks and 23 strikeouts in four Interleague starts this season.
