- ☞ Making his 20th start and appearance of 2023, as well as his 12th road start...also his 189th career appearance and 155th start.
- ☞ Facing Cincinnati for the second time as a Twin and sixth time in his career...is 2-1, 4.62 ERA (25.1 IP, 13 ER) with one save, seven walks and 30 strikeouts in five prior appearances (4 starts) vs. the Reds.
- ☞ Is in his fourth season with the Twins after being acquired in 2020, along with Jair Camargo, from Los Angeles-NL in exchange for Brusdar Graterol and Luke Raley.

LAST TIME OUT: Earned his second-straight win and his fifth overall victory of 2023 on September 14 at Chicago-AL, a 10-2 Twins' win...allowed two runs on four hits (1 HR) in a season-high-tying 7.0 innings pitched, with one walk and eight strikeouts...one shy of his season high (done thrice previously)...allowed just three singles through 6.0 innings pitched with seven strikeouts...issued a one-out walk to Yoán Moncada in the bottom of the seventh, then surrendered a two-run homer to Andrew Vaughn...was relieved by Josh Winder to start the bottom of the eighth with the Twins' leading 6-2; Winder and Brent Headrick each fired 1.0 scoreless inning as Minnesota won the four-game series opener.

- ☞ Won consecutive starts for the first time since August 8, 2021 at Houston and August 14, 2021 vs. Tampa Bay.
- ☞ Threw 105 pitches, breaking the century mark for the first time this season and marking his most pitches in a single game since he threw 100 pitches on August 8, 2021 at Houston.
- ☞ Has yielded at least one home run in 11-consecutive starts, the longest streak of his career and the longest such streak by a Twins pitcher since Rick Aguilera in 1996 (12-game streak).

TWO STARTS AGO: Snapped a five-start streak without a victory, earning the win on September 9 vs. New York-NL in the Twins' 8-4 victory at Target Field...pitched 5.1 innings and allowed two runs on five hits (1 HR), with one walk and two strikeouts...allowed a leadoff home run to Brandon Nimmo in the top of the first, the second leadoff homer he has allowed this year (also, April 20 at Boston - Alex Verdugo) and fifth of his career...fired 4.1 scoreless innings after yielding two runs in the first inning...was relieved by Kody Funderburk in the top of the sixth following a one-out walk to Daniel Vogelbach; Twins scored five runs off New York-NL's bullpen as Minnesota claimed the series victory.

- ☞ Earned the win despite striking out just two batters, doing so for the first time in his career as a starter.

RED ZONE: Facing Cincinnati for the sixth time in his career...is 2-1, 4.62 ERA (25.1 IP, 13 ER) with one save, seven walks and 30 strikeouts in five previous appearances (4 starts) vs. the Reds...last faced Cincinnati on August 3, 2021, his only appearance vs. the Reds with Minnesota...took a no-decision in the Twins' 7-5 victory at Great American Ball Park; pitched 5.0 innings and allowed five runs on seven hits (3 HR), with one walk and nine strikeouts...allowed at least three home runs for the fifth time in his career.

- ☞ Seeking his first win against the Reds since April 16, 2019; pitched 6.2 innings and allowed one run on four hits, with three walks and five strikeouts, in a 6-1 Dodgers' victory at Dodger Stadium.
- ☞ Earned his first career save on June 9, 2017 vs. Cincinnati, pitching the final 4.0 innings and allowing just one run in a 7-2 Dodgers' win at Dodger Stadium...one of six career saves.

NATIONAL NEWS: In five starts vs. National League opponents this year, Maeda is 2-2, 3.08 ERA (26.1 IP, 9 ER) with five walks, 28 strikeouts and a .202 (19-for-94) opponent batting average...took the loss on April 4 at Miami and June 28 at Atlanta, earned the win on August 5 vs. Arizona, took a no-decision on August 23 at Milwaukee and won on September 9 vs. New York-NL...owns a 1.12 WHIP in 128 career appearances (98 starts) vs. the NL, the 12th-best WHIP in baseball since 2016 (min. 500.0 IP).

- ☞ Is 9-9, 4.11 ERA (138.0 IP, 63 ER) with 43 walks and 149 strikeouts in 29 career interleague appearances (24 starts).
- ☞ In 28 career appearances (24 starts) vs. the NL Central, Maeda is 10-6 with a 4.11 ERA (140.0 IP, 64 ER), one save, 45 walks and 146 strikeouts.

ROAD TRIPPIN': Making his 12th road start of the season tonight...is 2-5 with a 3.31 ERA (54.1 IP, 20 ER), 17 walks and 64 strikeouts in 11 road starts this year...his 10.60 strikeouts-per-9.0 innings ratio on the road ranks eighth in the American League in 2023 (min. 50.0 IP)...Twins have gone 1-4 his last five road starts despite Maeda posting a 3.54 ERA (28.0 IP, 11 ER)...is 3-2, 6.05 ERA (41.2 IP, 28 ER) with eight walks and 40 strikeouts in eight starts at Target Field this season.

- ☞ Is 1-0, 5.40 ERA (10.0 IP, 6 ER) with two walks and 14 strikeouts in two career starts at Great American Ball Park.
- ☞ In 101 career road appearances (85 starts), he is 28-27, 4.54 ERA (442.0 IP, 223 ER) with 141 walks and 483 strikeouts...is 36-21, 3.31 ERA (416.0 IP, 153 ER) with 104 walks and 455 strikeouts in 87 career home appearances (69 starts).

THE ARSENAL: Has used a five-pitch mix this year, mostly using his slider, split finger and 4-seam fastball, throwing the trio 90.1 percent of the time...favors his split finger (295/490 - 60.2%) against lefties and mostly uses his slider (297/484 - 61.4%) and sinker (98/99 - 99.0%) against righties...recorded six strikeouts with his split finger in his last start on September 14 at Chicago-AL, tied with three other outings for his single-game career high...here's a breakdown of his repertoire:

- ☞ Has averaged 91.3 mph on his four-seam fastball in his last eight starts, a 0.7-mpg increase from his four-seam fastball average in his first 11 starts this season (90.6).

JAPANESE RANKS: Maeda surpassed Hisashi Iwakuma for the fifth-most victories by a Japanese-born pitcher in American League/National League history (1901-) with a win in his last start on September 14 at Chicago-AL...only Hideo Nomo (123), Yu Darvish (103), Hiroki Kuroda (79) and Masahiro Tanaka (78) have earned more victories than Maeda in MLB among Japanese-born pitchers...here are his career numbers and how they rank among Japanese-born hurlers in MLB (min. 500.0 IP):

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP BAILEY OBER (2023: 7-6, 3.67 ERA // CAREER: 12-12, 3.75 ERA)

Right-hander Bailey Ober is scheduled to start the three-game series finale against Cincinnati tomorrow afternoon at Great American Ball Park...earned his seventh victory of 2023 in his last start on September 15 at Chicago-AL, a 10-2 Twins' win; pitched 5.0 innings and allowed two runs on five hits (1 HR), with no walks and six strikeouts in his first start since being recalled from Triple-A St. Paul...facing the Reds for the second time in his career; took a no-decision in his only previous start vs. Cincinnati on June 22, 2021 at Target Field (4.1 IP, 6 H, 4 R/ER, 1 HR, 2 BB, 2 K)...was his fifth career start and first career interleague start...is 3-1, 3.49 ERA (38.2 IP, 15 ER) with 11 walks and 31 strikeouts in seven IL starts this year...owns a 1.19 WHIP in nine career IL starts.

CAREER NOTES

- Missed entire 2022 season recovering from Tommy John surgery on right elbow.
- Finished second in the 2020 American League Cy Young Award voting, accruing 92 total votes (Cleveland's Shane Bieber was the unanimous winner).
- Named Joseph W. Haynes Award winner for Twins Pitcher of the Year in 2020, voted on by the Twin Cities Chapter of the BBWAA...also named the starting pitcher on 2020 All-MLB Second Team.
- Pitched 8.0 no-hit innings on August 18, 2020 vs. MIL before bid was broken up in the ninth...longest no-hit bid of career, and set Twins record with eight-straight K's.
- Is the third Japanese-born player in Twins franchise history, after Micheal Nakamura (2003) and Tsuyoshi Nishioka (2011-12).
- Owns the fifth-most strikeouts in MLB history among Japanese-born pitchers.
- His 16 wins in 2016 were the second-most wins ever by a Los Angeles-NL rookie, behind only Rick Sutcliffe (17-10, 1979), and tied for the second-most ever in a single season by a Japanese pitcher.
- In 2016, led qualifying MLB rookie starting pitchers in starts (32), wins (16), opponents' batting average (.229), WHIP (1.14), innings pitched (175.2) and strikeout-to-walk ratio (3.58).
- Named to the 2016 *Baseball America* Major League All-Rookie Team, and finished third in the NL Rookie of the Year voting.

DOUBLE PLAY DANDY: Maeda has induced 10 groundball double plays this season, tied with Pablo Lopez for the second most on the Twins pitching staff (Sonny Gray - 13)...has averaged 0.94 groundball double plays-per-9.0 innings this year, the highest single-season double play rate by a Twins pitcher (min. 15 GS) since Kyle Gibson in 2019 (0.96).

SHARP IN SEPTEMBER: In 38 career appearances in September (15 starts), Maeda is 10-4 with a 3.48 ERA (106.0 IP, 41 ER), 23 walks and 124 strikeouts...also has earned four of his six career saves in September...as a twin, he is 4-0 with a 3.27 ERA (41.1 IP, 15 ER), seven walks and 45 strikeouts in seven September starts...his 3.27 ERA in September with Minnesota is his second-best ERA in any month since 2020 (2.61 ERA in 11 July starts with Twins).

SPLIT, THE DIFFERENCE: Has accumulated a run value of seven on his split finger this year, the fifth-highest run value on a splitter in the American League and eighth highest in baseball this season...opposing hitters have an expected slugging percentage of .299 and an xwOBA of .253 off Maeda's splitter this year...also owns a 34.1 percent whiff rate on his splitter in 2023, his highest whiff rate on the pitch since 2020 (45.6%).

- ☞ His 42 strikeouts with his split finger are the sixth most in the AL this year.

LEFT/RIGHT: Left-handed hitters are slashing .253/.314/.391 with 46 strikeouts and a .705 OPS against Maeda this year...right-handed hitters are slashing .249/.289/.492 with 58 strikeouts and a .781 OPS...in his last start on September 14 at Chicago-AL, lefties went 2-for-8 with one walk and two strikeouts off him; righties went 2-for-17 with one home run (A. Vaughn) and six strikeouts.

- ☞ Righties are batting just .209 (345-for-1652) with a .624 OPS and 557 strikeouts vs. Maeda in his career...owns the third-lowest opponent batting average vs. righties since 2016 (min 750.0 IP), trailing only Max Scherzer (.182) and Jacob deGrom (.203); also ranks seventh in opponent OPS vs. right-handed hitters in that span.
- ☞ Lefties are hitting .250 (393-for-1570) with a .740 OPS and 381 strikeouts off Maeda in his career.

- 'Pen finished 2-1, 2.70 ERA (20.0 IP, 6 ER) w/ 15 H, 10 BB, 20 K and 1 SV in 4 G vs. CIN in 2021 season.
