the seasonthey need to go 5-0 to finish with a winning road record in 2023.

**RED FACED IN CINCY:** The Twins lost to the Reds last night at Great American Ball Park by a score of 7-3...Joey Ryan (10-10) was the starter and loser, allowing four runs on five hits in 5.0 innings pitched...Dallas Keuchel pitched 3.0 innings of relief, allowing three runs on four hits...the offense recorded five hits, walked once and went 0-for-4 with runners in scoring position...Max Kepler had two of the five hits, both singles...Royce Lewis (15) and Alex Kirilloff (9) each homered.

DIVISION SIGNS: Regardless of last night's defeat in Cincinnati, the Guardians lost to the Royals yesterday afternoon, reducing the Twins' magic number to five...Minnesota enters today at 79-72 with a 7.0-game lead on the Guardians, who sit at 72-79...below is a brief look at Minnesota and Cleveland:
