THE TWINS: After completing their seven-game homestand with a record of 4-3 (3-1 vs. Texas and 1-2 vs. Cleveland), the Twins began their six-game roadtrip with a win over the Rangers last night...tonight, the Twins will continue the trip with the second of three at Globe Life Field...

TWINS GO DEEP IN THE HEART OF TEXAS, THREE TIMES: The Twins beat the Rangers last night at Globe Life Field by a score of 5-1. Joe Ryan (10-8) was the starter and winner, allowing one run on three hits (1 HR) in 6.0 innings pitched, with no walks and seven strikeouts...

RANGER THINGS: The Twins and Rangers are playing each other tonight for the sixth of seven meetings in 2023...these two met at Target Field last week from Thursday-Sunday (August 24-27) as the Twins won three of four, dropping just game three.

LIVING OUR BEST (GLOBE) LIFE: The Twins are 5-2 all-time at Globe Life Field, going 3-0 in 2021, 1-2 in 2023 and 1-0 this season...since the start of 2016, the Twins have a record of 15-6 at Globe Life Field and Globe Life Park combined, including a record of 9-2 in their last 11.

FASHIONABLY LATE: The Twins bullpen has gone 2-1, 2.05 ERA (22.0 IP, 5 ER) with Rangers hitters batting .153 with one home run and a .453 OPS through five games vs. Texas this season...the Rangers 'pen has gone 1-3, 8.55 ERA (20.0 IP, 19 ER) with Twins batters hitting .278, nine home runs and a 1.052 OPS vs. Minnesota this season...

GROUP PROJECT: Twins starters have allowed four earned runs in their last three games (19.0 IP) for an ERA of 1.89 in that span...on the season, Twins starters have combined to go 40-40, 3.84 ERA (756.2 IP, 323 ER) with 193 walks, 816 strikeouts and a .240 opponent batting average...below are other Twins starting pitching ranks among the AL teams: Table with columns: INNINGS, QS, BAA, BB/9.0, FIP, WHIP, K's, OPS.

SOME LOVE FOR THE LEFTIES: The Twins are 17-15 on the season when facing a lefty starter...below is a comparison of offensive numbers vs. lefties pre-All-Star break and after: Table with columns: AVG, OBP, SLG, OPS, BB%, K%.

UNLOCKING POLANCO: Jorge Polanco has reached safely in 22 of his last 23 games...additionally, in his last 17 games, since August 11, he is hitting .328 (21-for-64) with five home runs, 18 RBI, 11 walks, a .423 on-base percentage, a .594 slugging percentage and a 1.017 OPS.

TOP JEFF: Since the All-Star break, Ryan Jeffers is hitting .298 (28-for-94) with five doubles, six home runs, 19 RBI, 11 walks, a .394 on-base percentage, a .543 slugging percentage and a .937 OPS...he has raised his OPS 66 points since the break, going from .778 to .844.

ROYCE MAKING NOISE: After starting the season hitting .182 (6-for-33) with a .576 OPS in his first eight games, Royce Lewis has hit .339 (41-for-121) with four doubles, seven home runs, 22 RBI and a .939 OPS in his last 33 games.

LAST TIME OUT: Did not factor into the decision in his last appearance on August 27 vs. Texas in the Twins' 13-inning, 7-6 victory at Target Field...made his 12th career regular season relief appearance and first since October 2, 2021 vs. Detroit with Chicago-AL...pitched 5.0 scoreless innings and allowed five hits, two walks and two strikeouts...entered in relief of Bailey Ober in the fifth inning...the 5.0-inning outing was tied for the longest relief appearance of his career (also, 5.0 IP on June 26, 2021 vs. Seattle with Chicago-AL)...Jhoan Duran and Caleb Thielbar combined to pitch 2.0 scoreless innings (1.0 IP each)...Emilio Pagán entered in the 12th inning and yielded a sacrifice fly to Corey Seager...Dylan Floro pitched a scoreless 13th inning...the Twins walked off the Rangers in the 13th inning after a bases-loaded walk issued to Michael A. Taylor by Jonathan Hernández.

- ⚡ Marked his third career scoreless relief outing, first since April 16, 2013 at Oakland (3.0 IP, 0 R).
- ⚡ Became the first Twins reliever to throw 5.0-or-more scoreless innings since Kohl Stewart on September 25, 2018 vs. Detroit.

TWO APPEARANCES AGO: Earned his first on August 20 vs. Pittsburgh in Minnesota's 2-0 victory at Target Field; marked his first win since May 8, 2022 at Boston with Chicago-AL...pitched 6.1 shutout innings and allowed one hit with three strikeouts...worked 6.1 perfect innings before allowing a one-out double to Bryan Reynolds in the seventh inning...marked the longest perfect game bid in his career (previously 5.0 innings done twice on September 14, 2014 at Los Angeles-AL and June 15, 2015 at Colorado – both with Houston)...relieved by Griffin Jax after the double as he, Caleb Thielbar and Jhoan Duran combined to pitch 2.2 scoreless innings.

- ⚡ Over the last 50 seasons, only one southpaw has had a longer perfect game bid for the Twins than Keuchel (Eric Milton, 6.2 innings on April 9, 2000 at Kansas City).
- ⚡ Recorded his first strikeout of the season in the second inning off Endy Rodríguez...faced 41 batters before recording his first strikeout, the most in Twins' history (since 1961).

TEXAS ROADHOUSE: Facing Texas for the second time this season and for the 30th time in his career (29th start), his most appearances against any single opponent...is 10-10, 3.77 ERA (186.0 IP, 78 ER) with 43 walks and 165 strikeouts in 29 previous appearances (28 starts) against the Rangers...did not factor into his last start against the Rangers on May 24, 2021, a 2-1 White Sox victory at Guaranteed Rate Field; pitched 6.0 shutout innings and allowed seven hits with two strikeouts.

- ⚡ Pitched for the Rangers in two starts last season, going 0-2, 12.60 ERA (10.0 IP, 14 ER) with four walks and seven strikeouts in those games.
- ⚡ Owns the second-lowest ERA against the Rangers since 2012 (min. 25 GS), trailing only Justin Verlander (2.76).
- ⚡ In 98 career appearances (95 starts) against the American League West division, Keuchel is 39-29, 3.56 ERA (613.2 IP, 243 ER) with 163 walks and 482 strikeouts.

HIT THE ROAD: Making his second road start of 2023 tonight...took the loss in his last road start on August 11 at Philadelphia, an 11-2 Twins' defeat (1.2 IP, 6 H, 6 R/ER, 2 BB, 0 K)...went 1-5, 13.70 ERA (23.0 IP, 35 ER) with 12 walks and 18 strikeouts in six road starts in 2022...in 134 career road appearances (131 starts), he is 48-55, 4.68 ERA (771.0 IP, 401 ER) with 251 walks and 576 strikeouts...is 54-37, 3.32 ERA (835.0 IP, 308 ER) with 244 walks and 648 strikeouts in 138 home appearances (129 starts).

- ⚡ Is 5-5, 4.97 ERA (83.1 IP, 46 ER) with 20 walks and 71 strikeouts in 14 career road starts vs. Texas.

LEFT/RIGHT: Right-handed hitters are 13-for-52 (.250) with three doubles, five RBI and four walks off Keuchel this year...lefties are 7-for-17 (.412) with one double, two RBI and two walks...owns better splits against left-handed hitters than righties in his career, holding lefties to a .241 (.313-for-1299) batting average and a .642 OPS...righties are batting .266 (1299-for-4887) with a .738 OPS off Keuchel.

THE ARSENAL: Has used a four-pitch mix in his first four appearances of 2023, leaning mostly on his sinker...has used his cutter 25.4 percent of the time after utilizing the pitch only 15.3 percent of the time in 2022...also has recorded four of his six strikeouts of the season on his cutter.

GROUND GAME: Keuchel owns a career groundball percentage of 58.4, the highest in baseball since 2012 (min. 1,000.0 IP)...has a groundball-to-flyball ratio of 2.87, the highest in baseball in that span under those same parameters...has induced 197 double play groundballs in his career, the second most since 2012, trailing only former Twin and current Baltimore Oriole Kyle Gibson (199).

GOLDEN BOY: Has won five Rawlings Gold Glove Awards® in his career, earning the award in 2014-16 and 2018 with Houston and in 2021 with Chicago-AL...owns the second-most Gold Gloves among active pitchers, trailing only Kansas City's Zack Greinke (6)...totalled 54 defensive runs saved from 2012-22, the second most in baseball by a pitcher in that span (Greinke - 55).

ST. PAUL SENSATION: In six starts with the Saints this season, Keuchel went 1-0, 1.13 ERA (32.0 IP, 4 ER) with 12 walks and 28 strikeouts...recorded three consecutive quality starts in his last three outings with the Saints, including earning the win on July 28 vs. Toledo in his most recent start (6.0 IP, 6 H, 2 R/ER, 1 HR, 1 BB, 8 K)...was named International League Pitcher of the Month for July, becoming the first St. Paul pitcher to win the award; posted a 0.96 ERA with 24 strikeouts in 28.0 innings pitched.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP KENTA MAEDA (2023: 3-7, 4.69 ERA // CAREER: 62-48, 3.95 ERA)

Right-hander Kenta Maeda is set to start the three-game series finale against the Texas Rangers at Globe Life Field tomorrow...took a no-decision in his last start on August 28 vs. Cleveland, a 10-6 Twins' win; allowed six runs on seven hits (1 HR) in 4.0 innings pitched, with one walk and three strikeouts...has allowed a home run in eight-straight starts; tied with Bailey Ober for the second-longest such streak by a Twins pitcher this season (Joe Ryan - 9)...facing the Rangers for the fifth time in his career...is 2-0, 2.70 ERA (16.2 IP, 5 ER) with eight walks and 14 strikeouts in his four previous starts...last faced the Rangers on June 20, 2021 where he earned the 4-2 Twins' win after pitching 5.1 innings and allowing two runs on five hits (2 HR) with one walk and four strikeouts at Globe Life Field.

- Pitched 6.1 perfect innings in his start on August 21, 2023 vs. Pittsburgh...marked the longest perfect game bid of his career.
- Signed as a minor league free agent by Minnesota on June 22, 2023...made six starts for Triple-A St. Paul, posting a 1-0 record with a 1.13 ERA (32.0 IP, 4 ER), 12 walks and 28 strikeouts...named International League Pitcher of the Month for July, going 1-0, 0.96 ERA (28.0 IP, 3 ER), 3x, last 8/27 vs. TEX, 24 strikeouts and a 1.29 WHIP.
- In 2022, pitched in 14 major league games for three different clubs, starting eight games for Chicago-AL, four for Arizona and two for Texas...went 2-9, 9.20 ERA (60.2 IP, 62 ER) with 31 walks and 45 strikeouts...was one of nine players to pitch in the majors for three different teams in 2022.
- Won his fifth career AL Rawlings Gold Glove Award® with Chicago-AL in 2021...led all MLB pitchers with 41 assists and a 2.67 range factor per 9.0 IP, and limited opponents to just two stolen bases in six attempts.
- Ranked third in MLB in 2020 with a 1.99 ERA (63.1 IP, 14 ER) in his first season with Chicago-AL...allowed three runs-or-less in all 11 of his starts, including one run four times and no runs twice...started Game 2 of the AL Wild Card Series at Oakland.
- In 2019, went 8-8 with a 3.75 ERA (112.2 IP, 47 ER) and 91 strikeouts over 19 starts in his only season with Atlanta...limited left-handers to a .189 (14-for-74) average...started Games 1 and 4 of the NLDS vs. St. Louis, posting a pair of no-decisions.
- Tied for the AL lead in starts (career-high 34) and won his fourth Rawlings Gold Glove Award® in 2018 with Houston...surpassed 1,000.0 IP in his career on April 16 at Seattle in a complete-game loss (8.0 IP).
- In 2017, won the World Series with Houston and went 14-5 with a 2.90 ERA (145.2 IP, 47 ER) in 23 starts...was named to his second career AL All-Star Team...posted single-season career highs in groundball rate (67.3 percent) and GB/FB ratio (4.41), leading the majors in both categories (min. 140.0 IP)...made five starts in the postseason, going 2-2 with a 3.58 ERA (27.2 IP, 11 ER) and 32 strikeouts for the World Champion Astros.
- In 2016, won his third-straight AL Rawlings Gold Glove Award® after tying for the AL lead in defensive runs saved among pitchers (7)...made 26 starts before his season was cut short in late August due to left shoulder inflammation.
- Won the AL Cy Young Award in 2015 and finished fifth in the AL Most Valuable Player voting after going 20-8 with a 2.48 ERA (232.0 IP, 64 ER) and 216 strikeouts over 33 starts with Houston...also won the Rawlings Gold Glove Award®, MLBPA Players Choice Award for AL Most Outstanding Pitcher, Fielding Bible Award (given to the best fielding pitcher in the majors) and three AL Pitcher of the Month Awards (April, May, August)...went 2-0 with a 2.57 ERA (14.0 IP, 4 ER) over three games (two starts) in the Postseason.
- Made his first career Opening Day roster in 2014...became the first Astros pitcher to win a Rawlings Gold Glove Award®...ranked among the AL leaders in complete games (1st, 5), groundball percentage (1st, 64.4), opponent GDP (1st, 36) and ERA (7th, 2.93).
- Pitched in 31 games in 2013 for Houston, making 22 starts...posted a 6-8 record and a 4.90 ERA (132.1 IP, 72 ER) as a starter.
- In 2012, made 16 starts with Houston across three stints in what was his first career major league action, going 3-8 with a 5.27 ERA (85.1 IP, 50 ER)...made his major league debut on June 17 at Texas, where he allowed just one run on four hits in 5.0 innings of work.
- Went a combined 10-8 with a 4.12 ERA (163.2 IP, 65 ER) and 91 strikeouts in 27 starts between Double-A Corpus Christi (20 GS) and Triple-A Oklahoma City (7 GS) in 2011.
- In 2010, posted a 7-14 record with a 3.77 ERA (174.1 IP, 73 ER) and 133 strikeouts in 28 games (27 starts) between Double-A Corpus Christi (9 GS) and High-A Lancaster (19 GS).
