THE TWINS: Went 5-2 on their seven-game roadtrip, winning three of four at Chicago-AL last weekend and two of three games in Cincy earlier this week...tonight, the Twins will begin their final homestand of 2023 with the first of three games against the Angels over the weekend...after an off-day on Monday, they will host the Athletics for three games from Tuesday-Thursday...the Twins have gone 43-32 at home and 38-40 on the road, winning 12 of their last 20 games at Target Field.
The Twins are a season-high nine games over .500, reaching their high-water mark of 2023 following their win in Cincinnati on Wednesday...a win today would make them 10 games over for the first time since July 5, 2022 (47-37).

COMEBACK IN CINCY: The Twins scored five runs in the final three innings on Wednesday to defeat the Reds by a score of 5-3 at Great American Ball Park, securing the series victory and marking Minnesota's 39th comeback win of the season...Bailey Ober started and took a no-decision, allowing two runs on three hits in 5.0 innings pitched, with three walks and three strikeouts...the offense recorded nine hits, including two hits from Willi Castro and Christian Vázquez...six of the Twins' nine hits came off the Cincinnati bullpen after Reds starter Hunter Greene struck out a career-high 14 batters in 7.0 innings pitched...Castro hit his ninth home run of the season, hitting homers in back-to-back games for the third time in his career...Jorge Polanco's two-run, tie-breaking single in the top of the ninth proved to be the game-winning hit...Twins improved to 5-61 when trailing after eight innings.

ONE WAY OR ANOTHER: Minnesota enters tonight at 81-72 with an 8.5-game lead over Cleveland (73-81) and a 9.0-game lead on Detroit (73-81)...the Twins' magic number to win the American League Central is one; either a Minnesota victory tonight or losses by Cleveland (at BAL) and Detroit (at OAK) will clinch the division title...below is a brief look at the Twins, Guardians and Tigers.

LEWIS OUT, LU IN: The Twins have placed infielder Royce Lewis on the 10-day Injured List with a left hamstring strain...Lewis left Tuesday night's game at Cincinnati after experiencing pain in his left hamstring during an at-bat in the eighth inning...in his last 26 games, since August 23, Lewis hit 11 home runs with 35 RBI and a 1.051 OPS...to replace Lewis on the 28-man roster, the Twins have recalled outfielder/first baseman Jordan Luplow.

CALLING ALL ANGELS: Tonight marks the fourth of six meetings with the Angels this season...Los Angeles-AL took two of three from the Twins in Anaheim from May 19-21, winning the series opener and series finale...Twins are just 5-11 vs. the Angels since the start of 2021, including 2-5 at Target Field.
Max Kepler owns an .876 OPS in 34 career games against Los Angeles-AL, hitting .279 (31-for-111) with five doubles, six home runs, 12 RBI, 17 walks, 21 runs scored and a .486 slugging percentage.
Willi Castro has hit safely in his last 12 games vs. the Angels since August 17, 2021, batting .298 (14-for-47) with three doubles, three home runs, six RBI, six runs scored and an .893 OPS in that span.

CLOSE PERSONAL FRIENDS: The Angels have several former Twins on their current 28-man roster, Injured List and coaching staff.
Eduardo Escobar spent parts of seven seasons with Minnesota from 2012-18...batted .258 (575-for-2,228) with 138 doubles, 63 home runs and 284 RBI in 671 games for the Twins...became the first switch hitter in Twins history (1961-) to hit 30 doubles in consecutive seasons (35 in 2014, 31 in 2015).
C.J. Cron hit 25 homers for the Bomba Squad in 2019, his only season in Minnesota...also hit 24 doubles and drove in 78 runs.
Gio Urshela spent the 2022 season with the Twins, tying for the team lead in games played with 144 (also, Luis Arraez)...hit .285 (143-for-501) with 13 home runs and 64 RBI...currently on 60-day Injured List (left pelvis fracture).
Drew Butera made his major league debut with the Twins in 2010 and played in four seasons for Minnesota...caught Francisco Liriano's no-hitter on May 3, 2011...currently serving as Los Angeles-AL's catching coach.

LET'S PARTY LIKE IT'S 2010: The Twins are looking to secure a playoff berth for the 15th time in club history (since 1961)...below are the final results from previous postseasons:

NOTE: If the Twins clinch during this homestand, it will mark the first time they have secured a playoff berth in front of their home crowd since 2010...in 2017, the Twins lost 2-4 in Cleveland but hung around the Progressive Field visiting clubhouse waiting for the White Sox to defeat the Angels...in 2019, the Twins defeated Detroit 5-1 but waited in the Comerica Park visiting clubhouse for the White Sox to defeat Cleveland...in 2020, the Twins lost to the Reds 3-5 as the White Sox also lost to the Cubs, but considering the Pandemic, there were no fans in attendance.

CASTRO CRUSHING: Willi Castro hit his ninth home run of the season on Wednesday, tying his single-season career high (9 in 2021)...has set career highs in walks (27) and stolen bases (32), and his 18 doubles are tied for his single-season career high (18 in 2022)...is the first Twins hitter since Chuck Knoblauch in 1997 (9 HR, 62 SB) with at least nine home runs and 30 steals in a season...only Castro, Knoblauch (thrice), Rod Carew (twice), Cesar Tovar (twice) and Larry Hise (once) have recorded seasons with at least nine homers and 30 steals with Minnesota...Castro is hitting .310 (18-for-58) with three doubles, one triple, four home runs, eight RBI, a .349 on-base percentage, a .603 slugging percentage and a .953 OPS in his last 15 games.

RAPID REWARDS: High-A Cedar Rapids won the Midwest League Championship Series on Wednesday night, defeating the Great Lakes (LAD) Loons two games to none in the best-of-three series...it marked the Kernels first MWL Championship since 1994...Emmanuel Rodriguez, the Twins' No. 3 prospect, hit a grand slam in the bottom of the second inning of Game 2, and John Stankiewicz earned the save to clinch the title.
Minor League Baseball also announced the end-of-season awards for High-A on Wednesday...outfielder Kala'i Rosario was named most valuable player of the Midwest League, posting an .831 OPS and leading the league in home runs (21) and RBI (94)...Rosario, infielder Tanner Schobel, designated hitter Emmanuel Rodriguez, relief pitcher Miguel Rodriguez and manager Brian Dinkelman were all selected to the MWL All-Star team.

LAST TIME OUT: Took the loss on September 16 at Chicago-AL in the Twins' 7-6 defeat...allowed five runs on eight hits (2 HR) in 5.0 innings pitched, with no walks and eight strikeouts...yielded all five runs in the first inning on three singles, a two-run homer by Eloy Jiménez and a three-run homer by Gavin Sheets...retired 11 of the final 12 batters he faced from the second through the fifth with six strikeouts...relieved by Josh Winder in the sixth inning with Minnesota trailing 5-1; Twins rallied for five runs in the last two innings but fell short in the third game of the four-game series.

- ☞ Allowed multiple homers for the sixth time this year and first since July 25 vs. Seattle (also 2 HR).
- ☞ The five-run first inning was the most runs he has allowed in a single inning since he yielded five runs to Cleveland in the sixth inning on June 1 at Target Field.
- ☞ Has 22 strikeouts without issuing a walk in his last two starts...only ARI's Zac Gallen (23, April 21-26) has recorded more strikeouts without walking a batter in a two-game span this year.

TWO STARTS AGO: Struck out a career-high 14 batters but did not factor into the decision on September 10 vs. New York-NL, a 2-0 Twins' loss at Target Field...pitched 8.0 scoreless innings, allowed just two hits and did not issue a walk on a season-high 106 pitches...recorded his 200th strikeout of 2023 in the first inning (F. Lindor), becoming the eighth Venezuelan-born pitcher in American League/National League history (1901-) to achieve the feat...allowed a leadoff single to Brandon Nimmo in the first and a one-out single to Francisco Alvarez in the third; retired 17 of the final 19 batters he faced after the Alvarez single...Mets scored twice off Griffin Jax in the top of the ninth to take the series finale.

- ☞ His 14 strikeouts were the most by a Twins pitcher since Francisco Liriano struck out 15 on July 13, 2012 vs. Oakland.
- ☞ Became third pitcher in Twins history (1961-) to strike out at least 14 batters without issuing a walk, joining Bert Blyleven (14 K on September 24, 1986 vs. Kansas City) and Johan Santana (14 K on September 19, 2004 vs. Baltimore; franchise-high 17 K on August 19, 2007 vs. Texas).

REELIN' IN THE STRIKEOUTS: Ranks second in the American League with 221 strikeouts this year (TOR's Kevin Gausman - 232)...owns the highest single-season strikeout total by a Twin since Johan Santana struck out 235 in 2007...tied with Camilo Pascual's 1961 season for the 11th-most strikeouts by a Twin in club history (since 1961); next up is a trio of Bert Blyleven seasons (10th - 224 in 1971; 9th - 228 in 1972; 8th - 233 in 1975)...has a 10.83 strikeouts-per-9.0-innings ratio in 2023, the highest single-season ratio in Twins history (1961-) among qualified pitchers.

LÓPEZ vs. LAA: Facing the Angels for the second time this season...recorded a quality start but took the loss on May 21 at Angel Stadium in the Twins' 4-2 defeat; pitched 6.0 innings and allowed two runs on five hits, with three walks and nine strikeouts...held Los Angeles-AL to one run through 6.0 innings, then allowed a tie-breaking two-run double to Mickey Moniak in the bottom of the seventh...marked his first career start vs. the Angels.

- ☞ Seeking his first win against an American League West opponent this year...is 0-2, 5.65 ERA (28.2 IP, 18 ER) in five starts vs. the AL West in 2023, with the Twins going 2-3 in those starts.

FINDING HIS TARGET: Making his fifth home start in his last seven outings today...is 4-3, 4.09 ERA (88.0 IP, 40 ER) with 23 walks and 110 strikeouts in 14 home starts in 2023...Twins are 9-5 in his 14 starts at Target Field...here are his numbers in his last eight home starts compared to his first six:

PITCH BREAKDOWN: Has used a five-pitch mix in 2023, per Baseball Savant...has primarily used his sweeper and sinker against right-handed hitters, favoring his changeup and curveball against left-handed hitters...opposing hitters went 0-for-6 with three strikeouts against his sweeper in his last start on September 16 at Chicago-AL...here is a look at his 2023 arsenal:

CUTTING TO THE CHASE: Owns a career-high 34.3 chase percentage in 2023, placing him in the 95th percentile in baseball, per Baseball Savant...his chase rate ranks first on the Twins staff and 18th in MLB.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP SONNY GRAY (2023: 8-7, 2.84 ERA // CAREER: 98-84, 3.48 ERA)

Sonny Gray is set to start the middle game of the three-game series against the Angels tomorrow afternoon at Target Field...earned the win in his last start on September 17 at Chicago-AL, tossing 7.0 shutout innings with five hits allowed and six strikeouts in the Twins' 4-0 victory...owns a 2.36 ERA (68.2 IP, 18 ER) with nine quality starts in his last 11 outings...facing Los Angeles-AL for the first time as a Twin and 16th time in his career...is 5-4, 3.59 ERA (87.2 IP, 35 ER) with 27 walks and 79 strikeouts in 15 previous games (14 starts) vs. the Angels...last faced Los Angeles-AL on May 26, 2018 at Yankee Stadium, taking the loss in an 11-4 Yankees' defeat (3.2 IP, 7 H, 5 R/ER, 1 HR, 3 BB, 1 HBP, 7 K)...his 15 career appearances vs. the Angels are tied for his third most against any team in his career.
