BETTER CALL FALL: Major League Baseball yesterday announced the rosters and coaching staffs of the 2023 Arizona Fall League (AFL)...Twins farmhands will play for the Glendale Desert Dogs for the second-straight season...

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 1990, Gary Gaetti hit a grand slam off the Rangers' Charlie Hough for his 200th career home run, as the Twins won, 6-4; it came nine years and four days after his first major league homer...

- ☞ Facing Los Angeles-AL for the 16th time in his career and for the first time since May 26, 2018...is 5-4, 3.59 ERA (87.2 IP, 35 ER) with 27 walks and 79 strikeouts in his previous 15 appearances (14 starts).
- ☞ Acquired by the Twins on March 13, 2022 in a trade with the Cincinnati Reds, along with right-handed pitcher Francis Peguero, in exchange for right-handed pitcher Chase Petty.

LAST TIME OUT: Earned his eighth win of the season in his last start on September 17 at Chicago-AL...pitched 7.0 shutout innings and allowed five hits, with no walks and six strikeouts in a 4-0 Twins' victory...marked his third scoreless outing with 7.0-plus innings pitched; tied for the seventh most by an American League starter...relieved by Griffin Jax in the eighth inning, who combined with Emilio Pagan to pitch 2.0 scoreless innings (1.0 IP each)...The Twins scored all runs on two home runs (a three-run homer by Edouard Julien in the fifth and a solo shot by Jorge Polanco in the eighth).

☞ Marked his seventh scoreless start of the season...tied for the fourth-most shutout starts among American League pitchers, trailing TEX's Nathan Eovaldi (8), SEA's Luis Castillo (8) and TOR's Chris Bassitt (8).

TWO STARTS AGO: Took his seventh loss of the season on September 11 vs. Tampa Bay...pitched 4.0 innings and allowed two runs (1 earned) on six hits, with one walk and five strikeouts in a 7-4 Twins' defeat...allowed an RBI single to Josh Lowe in the first inning...allowed an unearned run in the top of the third when Randy Arozarena reached on an error (Carlos Correa) and scored on Jose Siri's RBI single...recorded his third pickoff of the year in the third (Siri, second base), tying his single-season career high (also 3 pickoffs in 2018 with New York-AL)...matched his single-game career high by hitting two batters (Luke Raley, first and third innings), last doing so on July 18, 2021 vs. Milwaukee with Cincinnati...relieved by Dylan Floro in the fifth inning, who surrendered a three-run home run to Taylor Walls...Brent Headrick entered in the sixth inning and yielded a solo home run to Yandy Diaz and an RBI groundout to Vidal Brujan.

☞ Snapped his nine-start streak of pitching 6.0-or-more innings, dating back to July 22...marked his longest streak since another nine-game stretch in 2017 with Oakland and New York (career long is 13 starts from May 29-August 7, 2015 with Oakland).

☞ Recorded his 1,500th career strikeout in the first inning (Taylor Walls), becoming the 24th active pitcher to reach the milestone.

HOMERS NOT FOUND: Has allowed just seven home runs through his 30 starts this season...owns the fewest homers in baseball among pitchers with at least 30 starts...also owns the lowest home runs-per-9.0 inning ratio in baseball (0.36)...is one of two pitchers in Twins history (since 1961) to allow seven-or-fewer home runs in his first 30 starts of the year, joining Francisco Liriano (6 HR through first 30 GS in 2010)...his home runs-per-9.0 inning ratio is the lowest by a qualified pitcher in a single season in Twins' history (1961-).

☞ Gray needs at least 6.0 homerless innings to join Pedro Martinez (2003), Chris Carpenter (2009) and Josh Johnson (2010) as the only pitchers since 2000 to pitch at least 180.0 innings and allow seven-or-fewer home runs.

ALEXA, PLAY HALO BY BEYONCÉ: Gray is facing the Los Angeles-AL for the 16th time in his career and for the first time since May 26, 2018...is 5-4, 3.59 (87.2 IP, 35 ER) with 27 walks and 79 strikeouts in his previous 15 career appearances (14 starts)...took the 11-4 Yankees' loss in his last start against the Angels; pitched 3.2 innings and allowed five runs on seven hits (1 HR) with three walks and seven strikeouts...allowed an RBI double to Mike Trout in the first inning...issued a bases-loaded walk to Shohei Ohtani and yielded a sacrifice fly to Andrelton Simmons in the third inning...surrendered a two-run home run to Trout before exiting the fourth inning with two outs.

☞ Looking to snap a three-game losing streak against the Angels, dating back to September 2, 2015...owns a 6.55 ERA (22.0 IP, 16 ER) with eight walks and 19 strikeouts in the five-game span.

☞ Making his fifth start against an American League West opponent this season...is 1-1, 3-51 ERA (25.2 IP, 10 ER) with eight walks and 25 strikeouts in his previous four starts...earned the win on August 25 vs. Texas and took the loss on July 17 at Seattle.

THE ARSENAL: Gray has used a six-pitch mix this season, per Baseball Savant...currently uses his four-seam fastball the most at 27.0 percent...recorded three of his six strikeouts using his sweeper in his last start on September 17 at Chicago-AL...primarily uses his curveball (301 pitches) and changeup (169 pitches) against lefties and his cutter (261 pitches), sinker (378 pitches) and sweeper (354 pitches) against righties...here's a look at his repertoire:

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP JOE RYAN (2023 SEASON: 10-10, 4.30 ERA // CAREER: 25-19, 3.90 ERA)

Right-hander Joe Ryan is slated to start the three-game series finale against the Los Angeles Angels tomorrow afternoon at Target Field...took his 10th loss of the season in his last start on September 18 at Cincinnati, a 7-3 Twins' defeat; pitched 5.0 innings and allowed four runs on five hits (1 HR), with a season-high-tying three walks and five strikeouts...facing the Angels for the third time in his career and second this season...is 0-0, 4.50 ERA (10.0 IP, 5 ER) with 4 walks and 14 strikeouts in his two previous starts against the Angels...last faced Los Angeles-AL on May 19 at Angel Stadium; did not factor into the decision after pitching 6.0 innings and allowing three runs (2 earned) on seven hits with one walk and nine strikeouts.

- Named to American League All-Star team in 2015 for Oakland and the National League squad in 2019 for Cincinnati (did not pitch in either).
- 2019 recipient of the Johnny Vander Meer Award as the Reds' Most Outstanding Pitcher and finished second to Atlanta's Josh Donaldson in voting for the MLBPA's National League Comeback Player of the Year Award.
- Named to *Baseball America's* 2019 major league All-Star second team...named American League Pitcher of the Month for April in 2014...in 2013 was the Athletics' Minor League Pitcher of the Year and a *Baseball America* Triple-A All-Star.
- Originally selected by Oakland in first round (18th overall) in 2011 First-Year Player Draft out of Vanderbilt University...led Vandy to its first NCAA College World Series berth in 2011.
- Is 0-2, 2.95 ERA (21.1 IP, 7 ER) with 12 walks, 18 strikeouts and a .189 opponent batting average in four career Postseason starts.
