THE TWINS: After going 5-2 on their seven-game roadtrip (3-1 at Chicago-AL and 2-1 at Cincinnati), the Twins beat the Angels last night to secure the American League Central division title...today, they will continue their final homestand of the season with the second of three against Los Angeles-AL and wrap the series tomorrow afternoon...after an off-day on Monday, they will host the Athletics for three games from Tuesday-Thursday...the Twins have gone 44-32 at home and 38-40 on the road, winning 13 of their last 21 games at Target Field.

The Yesterday's win secured a winning season for the 29th time in Minnesota's history (since 1961) and fourth time in their last seven seasons.

CHAMPAGNE SHOWERS: The Twins beat the Angels last night at Target Field by a score of 8-6...Pablo López (11-8) was the starter and winner, allowing three runs on five hits in 6.0 innings pitched, with one walk and seven strikeouts...Jhoan Duran earned his 27th save (32nd opportunity), throwing 34 pitches, tied for third most in his career...the offense recorded seven hits, two from both Jorge Polanco and Kyle Farmer...Alex Kirilloff hit his 10th home run of the season and drove in three runs...Michael A. Taylor also had two RBI.

PARTY TIME, EXCELLENT: The Twins won the AL Central for the ninth time in their history last night and clinched a playoff berth for the 15th time...below are the results from previous postseasons (since 1961):

CALLING ALL ANGELS: Today marks the fifth of six meetings with the Angels this season... Minnesota went 1-2 at Angel Stadium from May 19-21 and won game one last night...Twins are just 6-11 vs. the Angels since the start of 2021, including 3-5 at Target Field.

◆If the Twins sweep, they will take the season series from the Halos for the first time since 2019 (5-1), after going 2-4 in 2022, 2-5 in 2021 and DNP in 2020 (pandemic).

10 SPOT: Alex Kirilloff hit his 10th home run of the season last night, giving the Twins 12 players with double-digit home run totals, which marks a club record...they previously had 11 players with 10-plus homers in 2016 and 2019...below are the 12 players with 10-plus:

SERIES CONVERSATIONS: The Twins are seeking their 26th series victory this season...they are 25-19-5 in series play in 2023, going 13-8-3 at home and 12-11-2 on the road.

◆ The Twins have gone 8-3-1 in series play since August 11...in that span, they have gone 4-2-1 in series play at Target Field.

◆ A win today would secure the series and mark their first over the Angels since sweeping them in three games in Anaheim from May 20-23, 2019...they are 0-4-1 against the Angels in series play since then

in series play since then.

DONNIE ON TARGET: Since August 1, Donovan Solano is hitting .316 (37-for-117) with five doubles, one triple, one home run, 15 RBI, a .360 on-base percentage and a .762 OPS in 34 games...Solano is batting .292 (56-for-192) in 67 games at Target Field this year.

HEY STEVE: Andrew Stevenson is getting his seventh start today, his sixth in centerfield and first from the leadoff spot...Stevenson signed a minor league contract with Minnesota on March 8 and spent most of the season with Triple-A St. Paul...he had his contract selected by Minnesota on September 1...prior to joining the Twins, Stevenson set single-season St. Paul records in hits (132), runs scored (91), total bases (217) and stolen bases (44), while tying the record in triples (7).

Stevenson will become the 13th different player to leadoff for the Twins this season, the most in baseball and second most in club history (14 in 1980).

TAYLOR MADE: Michael A. Taylor is hitting .318 (14-for-44) with one double, five home runs, 13 RBI, nine runs scored, five walks, a .388 on-base percentage, a .682 slugging percentage and a 1.070 OPS in his last 16 games, since August 15 (missed 14 games from 9/3-18 with a right hamstring strain)...Taylor has a career-high 20 home runs (19 with Washington in 2017)...all 20 of his homers have been hit as a centerfielder, sixth-most in baseball, trailing Luis Robert Jr. (37), Julio Rodríguez (31), Jose Siri (25), Jack Suwinski (23) and Brandon Nimmo (21).

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In **1990**, Gary Gaetti hit a grand slam off the Rangers' Charlie Hough for his 200th career home run, as the Twins won, 6-4; it came nine years and four days after his first major league homer, also off Hough...in **2003**, the Twins clinched the AL Central for the second-straight season; the 4-1 win over Cleveland marked the 10th win in an 11-game winning streak.

LAST TIME OUT: Earned his eighth win of the season in his last start on September 17 at Chicago-AL. pitched 7.0 shutout innings and allowed five hits, with no walks and six strikeouts in a 4-0 Twins' victory... marked his third scoreless outing with 7.0-plus innings pitched; tied for the seventh most by an American League starter...relieved by Griffin Jax in the eighth inning, who combined with Emilio Pagán to pitch 2.0 scoreless innings (1.0 IP each)...The Twins scored all runs on two home runs (a three-run homer by Edouard Julien in the fifth and a solo shot by Jorge Polanco in the eighth).

Marked his seventh scoreless start of the season...tied for the fourth-most shutout starts among

American League pitchers, trailing TEX's Nathan Eovaldi (8), SEA's Luis Castillo (8) and TOR's Chris Bassitt (8).

TWO STARTS AGO: Took his seventh loss of the season on September 11 vs. Tampa Bay...pitched 4.0 innings and allowed two runs (1 earned) on six hits, with one walk and five strikeouts in a 7-4 Twins' defeat...allowed an RBI single to Josh Lowe in the first inning...allowed an unearned run in the top of the third when Randy Arozarena reached on an error (Carlos Correa) and scored on Jose Siri's RBI single...recorded his third pickoff of the year in the third (Siri, second base), tying his single-season career high (also 3 pickoffs in 2018 with New York-AL)...matched his single-game career high by hitting two batters (Luke Raley, first and third innings), last doing so on July 18, 2021 vs. Milwaukee with Cincinnati...relieved by Dylan Floro in the fifth inning, who surrendered a three-run home run to Taylor Walls...Brent Headrick entered in the sixth

a mining, who surferiode a three-run home run to raybo wars....breit headrick entered in the sixth hing and yielded a solo home run to Yandy Díaz and an RBI groundout to Vidal Bruján.
 ★ Snapped his nine-start streak of pitching 6.0-or-more innings, dating back to July 22...marked his longest streak since another nine-game stretch in 2017 with Oakland and New York (career long is 13 starts from May 29-August 7, 2015 with Oakland).
 ★ Recorded his 1,500th career strikeout in the first inning (Taylor Walls), becoming the 24th active

pitcher to reach the milestone.

HOMERS NOT FOUND: Has allowed just seven home runs through his 30 starts this season...owns the fewest homers in baseball among pitchers with at least 30 starts...also owns the lowest home runs-per-9.0 inning ratio in baseball (0.36)...is one of two pitchers in Twins history (since 1961) to allow seven-or-fewer home runs in his first 30 starts of the year, joining Francisco Liriano (6 HR through first 30 GS in 2010)...his home runs-per-9.0 inning ratio is the lowest by a qualified pitcher in a single season in Twins' history (1961).

Gray needs at least 6.0 homerless innings to join Pedro Martinez (2003), Chris Carpenter (2009) and lock lohners (2010) as the only nitchers since 2000 to give the steast 18.0 0 innings and allow

and Josh Johnson (2010) as the only pitchers since 2000 to pitch at least 180.0 innings and allow

ALEXA, PLAY HALO BY BEYONCÉ: Gray is facing the Los Angeles-AL for the 16th time in his career and for the first time since May 26, 2018...is 5-4, 3.59 (87.2 IP, 35 ER) with 27 walks and 79 strikeouts in his previous 15 career appearances (14 starts)...took the 11-4 Yankees' loss in his last start against the Angels; pitched 3.2 innings and allowed five runs on seven hits (1 HR) with three walks and seven strikeouts... allowed an RBI double to Mike Trout in the first inning...issued a bases-loaded walk to Shohei Ohtani and yielded a sacrifice fly to Andrelton Simmons in the third inning...surrendered a two-run home run to Trout before exiting the fourth inning with two outs.

THE ARSENAL: Gray has used a six-pitch mix this season, per Baseball Savant...currently uses his four-seam fastball the most at 27.0 percent...recorded three of his six strikeouts using his sweeper in his last start on September 17 at Chicago-AL...primarily uses his curveball (301 pitches) and changeup (169 pitches) against lefties and his cutter (261 pitches), sinker (378 pitches) and sweeper (354 pitches) against righties...here's a look at his repertoire:
