$\boldsymbol{\$}$ Marked his seventh scoreless start of the season...tied for the fourth-most shutout starts among American League pitchers, trailing TEX's Nathan Eovaldi (8), SEA's Luis Castillo (8) and TOR's Chris Bassitt (8).
