THE TWINS: After going 5-2 on their seven-game roadtrip (3-1 at Chicago-AL and 2-1 at Cincinnati), the Twins split the first two games against the Angels with a win Friday night and a loss yesterday afternoon...today, they will continue their final homestand of the three-game series finale against Los Angeles-AL...they will enjoy their final off-day of the regular season tomorrow, then will host the Athletics for three games from Tuesday-Thursday...the Twins have gone 44-33 at home and 38-40 on the road.
Friday night's win secured a winning season for the 29th time in Minnesota's history (since 1961) and fourth time in their last seven seasons.
Minnesota is looking to win their 10th rubber game of the season today (9-9).

ADELL ROLLING IN THE DEEP: The Twins lost to the Angels yesterday afternoon by a score of 1-0 at Target Field...Sonny Gray (8-8) was the starter and loser, allowing one run on four hits in 6.0 innings pitched, with no walks and eight strikeouts...the only difference in the game was a Jo Adell solo home run in the fourth inning off Sonny...the offense recorded five hits, walked twice, struck out 10 times and did not record an extra-base hit...the 10 strikeouts gave them 1.596 on the season, tying the major league record, set by the Cubs in 2021...Kyle Farmer and Christian Vazquez each had two of Minnesota's five hits.

WELCOME BACK, SHERIFF: The Twins have returned right-handed pitcher Chris Paddack from his rehab assignment and reinstated him from the 60-day Injured List...Paddack has been recovering from Tommy John surgery on his right elbow, a procedure he had done on May 18, 2022...the 27-year-old pitched at three levels of the Twins organization during his rehab assignment, going 0-1, 3.72 ERA (9.2 IP, 4 ER), three walks, 15 strikeouts and a .222 (8-for-36) opponent batting average in three games (2 starts) between Low-A Fort Myers, Double-A Wichita and Triple-A St. Paul...he most recently pitched 3.0 scoreless innings on Tuesday for St. Paul, allowing two hits with one walk and five strikeouts, while topping out at 98.2 mph in velocity...in five starts for the Twins from April 13-May 8, 2022, he went 1-2, 4.03 ERA (22.1 IP, 10 ER), two walks and 20 strikeouts prior to experiencing right elbow inflammation...to make room for Paddack on the 28-man roster, the Twins have optioned right-handed pitcher Josh Winder to St. Paul...to make room for Paddack on the 40-man roster, the Twins have recalled left-handed pitcher Jovani Moran from St. Paul and have placed him on the 60-day Injured List...Moran has been on St. Paul's seven-day Injured List with a left forearm strain since August 31.

PARTY TIME, EXCELLENT: The Twins won the AL Central for the ninth time in their history on Friday night and clinched a playoff berth for the 15th time...below are the results from previous Postseasons (since 1961):

TWINS AND HALOS: Today marks the sixth and final meeting with the Angels this season...Minnesota went 1-2 at Angel Stadium from May 19-21 and 1-1 at Target Field this weekend...Twins are just 6-12 vs. the Angels since the start of 2021, including 3-6 at Target Field.

- These two will meet in 2024 for six games, including three at Angel Stadium from April 26-28 and three games at Target Field from September 9-11.
Max Kepler owns an .852 OPS in 35 career games against Los Angeles-AL, hitting .270 (31-for-115) with five doubles, six home runs, 12 RBI, 18 walks, 23 runs scored and a .470 slugging percentage.
Willi Castro has hit safely in his last 13 games vs. the Angels since August 17, 2021, batting .294 (15-for-51) with three doubles, three home runs, six RBI, eight runs scored and a .914 OPS in that span.
Kyle Farmer is hitting .455 (10-for-22) with two walks, a .520 on-base percentage and a 1.020 OPS in six career games vs. the Angels...he is 10-for-19 (.526) this season.

SERIES CONVERSATIONS: The Twins are seeking their 26th series victory this season...they are 25-19-5 in series play in 2023, going 13-8-3 at home and 12-11-2 on the road.
The Twins have gone 8-3-1 in series play since August 11...in that span, they have gone 4-2-1 in series play at Target Field.
A win today would secure the series and mark their first over the Angels since sweeping them in three games in Anaheim from May 20-23, 2019...they are 0-4-1 against the Angels in series play since then.

TWINS MINOR LEAGUE WEEKLYS: High-A Cedar Rapids right-handed pitcher Andrew Morris and outfielder Emmanuel Rodriguez have been named the final minor league Pitcher and Player of the Week for the Twins organization in 2023...both players helped lead the Kernels to their first Midwest League Championship since 1994 with a win over Great Lakes on Wednesday night.
Morris started Game 2, allowing one run on three hits in 5.0 innings pitched, with no walks and seven strikeouts.
Rodriguez hit a second-inning grand slam in the deciding Game 3, finishing the evening 1-for-2 with two walks and two runs scored.

HAPPY EARLY: Manager Rocco Baldelli will be celebrating his 42nd birthday tomorrow during the team's off day...the Twins clinched the AL Central title on Rocco's 39th birthday in 2019 at Comerica Park.

ON THIS DAY IN DAZZLE HISTORY: In 1984, the original Ironman, Dan Gladden, played both games of a doubleheader while playing for San Francisco, hosting San Diego, leading off and playing centerfield...Gladden had four hits in eight at-bats on the day, with one RBI, two runs scored, two walks, one strikeout and one stolen base...Gladden played 349 career games in centerfield, 243rd most all-time among right-handed-throwing players born in the U.S., trailing Tony Gwynn, Jr. (350) and ahead of Hersh Martin (346); 38 more games and he would have tied Peanuts Lowrey (387) for 231st...17 more games and he would have tied good ol' Wally Westlake (366).

**LAST TIME OUT:** Took the loss on September 18 at Cincinnati in the Twins' 7-3 defeat...pitched 5.0 innings and allowed four runs on five hits (1 HR), with three walks and five strikeouts...allowed two runs in the second inning on two singles, one walk and a sacrifice fly by Will Benson...issued a two-out walk to Noelvi Marte in the fourth inning, then yielded a two-run homer to Benson...worked around a one-out double in the fifth, posting a scoreless inning to complete his outing...was relieved by Dallas Keuchel to start the sixth inning with Minnesota trailing 4-1...Twins fell in the series opener.

☞ Marked his 27th start of the season, matching his 2022 total for the most in his major league career.

**TWO STARTS AGO:** Did not factor into the decision in his first career start against Tampa Bay, his former organization, on September 12 at Target Field, a 3-2 Twins' win...pitched 4.2 innings and allowed two runs on five hits (1 HR), with two walks and seven strikeouts...held the Rays hitless through 3.0 innings, then allowed one run on three hits in the top of the fourth, including an RBI single by Josh Lowe...yielded a one-out solo home run to René Pinto in the fifth; issued a two-out walk and allowed a single to Randy Arozarena later in the inning before being relieved by Louie Varland...Varland stranded both inherited runners...Willi Castro's two-run homer in the seventh inning gave Minnesota the come-from-behind win in the middle game of the three-game series.

☞ Threw 102 pitches, his most in a start since returning from the 15-day Injured List on August 26 and the eighth time he has eclipsed 100 pitches in 2023, which ranks second on the Twins (Pablo López - 9).

**AGAINST THE ANGELS:** Facing Los Angeles-AL for the third time in his career...took a no-decision against the Angels on May 19 at Angel Stadium in a 5-4 Twins' loss...recorded a quality start, pitching 6.0 innings and allowing three runs (2 earned) on seven hits, with one walk and nine strikeouts...allowed a sacrifice fly to Taylor Ward in the third inning and an RBI double to Brandon Drury in the fourth...also took a no-decision vs. Los Angeles-AL on September 24, 2022 at Target Field (4.0 IP, 4 H, 3 R/ER, 3 BB, 5 K).

☞ Is making his eighth start against the American League West today...is 2-2, 5.00 ERA (36.0 IP, 20 ER) with 12 walks and 53 strikeouts in seven previous starts vs. the AL West.

**TARGET PRACTICE:** Making his 14th home start of the season today...is 6-4, 3.77 ERA (76.1 IP, 32 ER) with 15 walks and 101 strikeouts in 13 starts at Target Field this year...in his last five home starts since July 9, he is 1-2, 6.08 ERA (23.2 IP, 16 ER) after posting a 2.73 ERA (52.2 IP, 16 ER) in his first eight home outings of 2023...is 4-6, 4.84 ERA (74.1 IP, 40 ER) with 18 walks and 80 strikeouts in 14 road starts this season.

☞ In 31 career home starts, he is 13-9, 3.62 ERA (174.0 IP, 70 ER) with 48 walks and 206 strikeouts...is 12-10, 4.31 ERA (150.1 IP, 72 ER) with 37 walks and 156 strikeouts in 28 career road starts.

**LEFT/RIGHT:** Left-handed hitters are batting .219 (60-for-274) with a .644 OPS and 72 strikeouts against Ryan this year, going 2-for-11 with one home run (W. Benson), three RBI and three strikeouts against him in his last start on September 18 at Cincinnati...right-handed hitters are batting .261 (80-for-306) with a .796 OPS and 109 strikeouts against Ryan in 2023, going 3-for-8 with one double, one RBI, three walks and two strikeouts against him in his last outing.

☞ Over his career, lefties are batting .206 (121-for-588) with a .637 OPS against him...righties are hitting .237 (150-for-633) with a .729 OPS off Ryan in his career.

**THE ARSENAL:** Has utilized a four-pitch mix in his first 27 starts of the 2023 season...has leaned on his four-seam fastball and split finger, combining to throw the two pitches 84.9 percent of the time this year...ranks third in the American League in strikeouts with his four-seam fastball (106), trailing only NYY's Gerrit Cole (119) and TOR's Kevin Gausman (107)...here's a look at Ryan's repertoire, per Baseball Savant:

**X MARKS THE SPOT:** Ryan owns a .271 xOBP in 2023, ranking in the 95th percentile in baseball...also has a 3.46 xERA this season, 0.84 less than his 4.30 ERA; the difference is the third largest by a Twin this year, trailing only Dylan Floro (1.46 - 3.39 xERA/4.85 ERA) and Griffin Jax (1.11 - 2.89 xERA/4.00 ERA).

TUESDAY'S STARTER - RHP KENTA MAEDA (2023: 6-7, 4.28 ERA // CAREER: 65-48, 3.92 ERA)

Kenta Maeda is scheduled to start the three-game series opener against the Oakland Athletics on Tuesday night at Target Field...earned his third-straight win in his last start on September 19 at Cincinnati, pitching 5.0 shutout innings in the Twins' 7-0 victory; allowed one hit, issued one walk and struck out eight batters for the second-straight start...owns a 2.08 ERA (17.1 IP, 4 ER) with three walks and 18 strikeouts on his three-game win streak...facing Oakland for the second time this season and fourth time in his career...did not factor into the decision on July 14 at Oakland Coliseum in the Twins' 5-4 win; pitched 3.0 innings and allowed three runs on four hits, with a season-high four walks and six strikeouts...is 0-0, 11.70 ERA (10.0 IP, 13 ER) in three career starts vs. the A's.
