THE TWINS: Have gone 3-1 through four games of their final six-game homestand, taking two of three from the Angels over the weekend, followed by a win over the Athletics last night... tonight the Twins will host the A's for the second of three and complete the series tomorrow afternoon...after tomorrow's game, the Twins will travel to Colorado for a three-game series over the weekend to complete the 2023 regular season...the Twins have gone 46-33 at home and 38-40 on the road.

WALLNER, SOLANO, OBER, PADDACK, STEWART - A+: The Twins beat the A's last night at Target Field by a score of 11-3...Bailey Ober (8-6) was the starter and winner, pitching 5.0 shutout innings, with two hits allowed, no walks and eight strikeouts...Chris Paddack made his official return to the mound (Tommy John surgery), allowing three runs on four hits in 2.0 innings pitched, with four strikeouts — his first appearance on a big league mound in 507 days...Brock Stewart also returned (right elbow soreness) and pitched 1.0 scoreless inning, with two strikeouts...Matt Wallner hit his second career grand slam in the first inning, while Donovan Solano reached base five times, going 4-for-4 with a walk.

NOTE: Since his complete-game shutout on July 5 vs. Kansas City, Pablo has gone 7-3, 2.87 ERA (87.2 IP, 28 ER) in 14 starts...since that date, the Twins have expanded their AL Central division lead from 2.0 games over the Guardians to 10.0 games over the Tigers — as we sit today.

STRAIGHT A'S: The Twins and Athletics are playing the fifth of six scheduled meetings in 2023...Twins are 4-0 vs. the A's this season, sweeping a three-game series at the Coliseum from July 14-16, followed by a win last night.

Minnesota has gone 9-1 in their last 10 vs. the A's and have won five straight over Oakland, dating back to May 18, 2022...the last time they won five straight against the A's was July 12, 2007-April 22, 2008...the last time they won at least six straight was when they won eight-straight from May 21, 2003-July 20, 2003.

Max Kepler has reached safely in eight straight games against Oakland, dating back to May 7, 2022...he has an on-base percentage of .364 in that span.

Christian Vázquez has hit safely in six consecutive games against Oakland, including multiple hits three times...he is batting .435 (10-for-23) with two doubles, one home run, six RBI, a .458 on-base percentage, a .652 slugging percentage and a 1.111 OPS in those games.

SERIES STUFF: The Twins are seeking their 27th series victory this season...they are 26-19-5 in series play in 2023, going 14-8-3 at home and 12-11-2 on the road.

The Twins have gone 9-3-1 in series play since August 11...in that span, they are 4-2-1 in home series.

Twins are looking for their fourth-straight series win over Oakland, dating back to May of 2022.

EARN IT: Twins starters have not walked a batter in their last 20.0 innings, since a Jo Adell leadoff walk against Pablo López in the fifth inning on Friday night against Anaheim...overall, they have walked just eight batters in their last 55.0 innings.

THE KIDS ARE ALRIGHT: The Twins lead baseball with the most rookies to post an OPS+ of over 120 in Edouard Julien (126), Matt Wallner (137) and Royce Lewis (149), ahead of Oakland's two (Zack Gelof - 140 and Ryan Noda - 123)...the last team to have three rookies to post an OPS+ of at least 120 was the 1930 St. Louis Cardinals: George Fisher (138), Gus Mancuso (126) and George Watkins (141).

WALK IN THE PARK: Edouard Julien has reached base safely in 17-straight games...he's drawn 23 walks in his last 19 games, including seven walks in his last four...has posted a walk percentage of 15.9% (62 BB/389 PA), fifth best in baseball (minimum of 350 plate appearances), trailing Aaron Judge (18.9%), Juan Soto (18.5%) and Kyle Schwarber (17.6%)...his 62 walks are tied with Bernie Allen's 1962 total for sixth-most for a rookie in club history (since 1961), trailing Butch Wynegar (79 in 1976), Tim Lefel (76 in 1984), Rich Rollins (75 in 1962), Tom Brunansky (71 in 1982) and Jimmie Hall (63 in 1963).

THIS HOUSE HAS GOTTA LOTTA WALLS: After slashing .180/.342/.344 with 28 strikeouts in 76 plate appearances over 21 games from August 16-September 10, Matt Wallner is hitting .389 (14-for-36) with three doubles, two home runs, 10 RBI, seven walks, a .500 on-base percentage, a .639 slugging percentage and a 1.139 OPS in his last 13 games.

Wallner has an average home run distance of 424 feet this season, fourth highest in MLB (minimum of 100 batted ball events)...he also ranks eighth in the majors in barrels-per-batted ball event (17.5).
