**THE TWINS:** Have gone 3-1 through four games of their final six-game homestand, taking two of three from the Angels over the weekend, followed by a win over the Athletics last night... tonight the Twins will host the A's for the second of three and complete the series tomorrow afternoon...after tomorrow's game, the Twins will travel to Colorado for a three-game series over the weekend to complete the 2023 regular season...the Twins have gone 46-33 at home and 38-40 on the road.

WALLNER, SOLANO, OBER, PADDACK, STEWART - A+: The Twins beat the A's last night at Target Field by a score of 11-3...Bailey Ober (8-6) was the starter and winner, pitching 5.0 shutout innings, with two hits allowed, no walks and eight strikeouts...Chris Paddack made his official return to the mound (Tommy John surgery), allowing three runs on four hits in 2.0 innings pitched, with four strikeouts.— his first appearance on a big league mound in 507 days...Brock Stewart also returned (right elbow soreness) and pitched 1.0 scoreless inning, with two strikeouts...Matt Wallner hit his second career grand slam in the first inning, while Donovan Solano reached base five times, going 4-for-4 with a walk.

SERIES STUFF: The Twins are seeking their 27th series victory this season...they are 26-19-5 in series play in 2023, going 14-8-3 at home and 12-11-2 on the road.

♣ The Twins have gone 9-3-1 in series play since August 11...in that span, they are 4-2-1 in home series.

♣ Twins are looking for their fourth-straight series win over Oakland, dating back to May of 2022.

**EARN IT:** Twins starters have not walked a batter in their last 20.0 innings, since a Jo Adell leadoff walk against Pablo López in the fifth inning on Friday night against Anaheim...overall, they have walked just eight batters in their last 55.0 innings.

**THE KIDS ARE ALRIGHT**: The Twins lead baseball with the most rookies to post an OPS+ of over 120 in Edouard Julien (126), Matt Wallner (137) and Royce Lewis (149), ahead of Oakland's two (Zack Gelof - 140 and Ryan Noda - 123)...the last team to have three rookies to post an OPS+ of at least 120 was the 1930 St. Louis Cardinals: George Fisher (138), Gus Mancuso (126) and George Watkins (141).

WALK IN THE PARK: Edouard Julien has reached base safely in 17-straight games...he's drawn 23 walks in his last 19 games, including seven walks in his last four...has posted a walk percentage of 15.9% (62 BB/389 PA), fifth best in baseball (minimum of 350 plate appearances), trailing Aaron Judge (18.9%), Juan Soto (18.5%) and Kyle Schwarber (17.6%)...his 62 walks are tied with Bernie Allen's 1962 total for sixth-most for a rookie in club history (since 1961), trailing Butch Wynegar (79 in 1976), Tim Teufel (76 in 1984), Rich Rollins (75 in 1962), Tom Brunansky (71 in 1982) and Jimmie Hall (63 in 1963).

THIS HOUSE HAS GOTTA LOTTA WALLS: After slashing .180/.342/.344 with 28 strikeouts in 76 plate appearances over 21 games from August 16-September 10, Matt Wallner is hitting .389 (14-for-36) with three doubles, two home runs, 10 RBI, seven walks, a .500 on-base percentage, a .639 slugging percentage and a 1.139 OPS in his last 13 games.

◆ Wallner has an average home run distance of 424 feet this season, fourth highest in MLB (minimum of 100 batted ball events)...he also ranks eighth in the majors in barrels-per-batted ball event (17.5).

LAST TIME OUT: Earned his 11th win of the year, setting a new single-season career high, in the Twins' 8-6 victory vs. Los Angeles-AL on September 22 at Target Field; Minnesota clinched the American League Central division title with the win...recorded his 20th quality start of the year; pitched 6.0 innings and allowed three runs on five hits (1 HR), with one walk and seven strikeouts...yielded all three runs in the fifth inning after retiring 12 of the first 13 batters he faced...allowed a two-run home run to Jared Walsh and an RBI single to Nolan Schanuel...retired the side in order in the sixth to complete his outing...Alex Kirilloff's tie-breaking solo homer in the bottom of the sixth proved to be the game-winning hit as the Twins held on to win the series opener and clinch the division.

The López's 29 strikeouts in his last three starts are the most in any three-game span in his career.

TWO STARTS AGO: Took the loss on September 16 at Chicago-AL in the Twins' 7-6 defeat...allowed five runs on eight hits (2 HR) in 5.0 innings pitched, with no walks and eight strikeouts...yielded all five runs in the first inning on three singles, a two-run homer by Eloy Jiménez and a three-run homer by Gavin Sheets...retired 11 of the final 12 batters he faced from the second through the fifth with six strikeouts...relieved by Josh Winder in the sixth inning with Minnesota trailing 5-1; Twins rallied for five runs in the last two innings but fell short in the third game of the four-game series.

The five-run first inning was the most runs he has allowed in a single inning since he yielded five runs to Cleveland in the sixth inning on June 1 at Target Field.

**REELIN' IN THE STRIKEOUTS:** Ranks second in the American League with a career-high 228 strikeouts this year (TOR's Kevin Gausman - 237)...**owns the highest single-season strikeout total by a Twin since Johan Santana struck out 235 in 2007...tied with Bert Blyleven's** 1972 season for the ninthmost strikeouts by a Twin in club history (since 1961); next up is Blyleven's 1975 season (8th - 233) and Dean Chance's 1975 season (7th - 234)...has a 10.82 strikeouts-per-9.0-innings ratio in 2023, the highest single-season ratio in Twins history (1961-) among qualified pitchers.

FEELING ATHLETIC: Facing Oakland for the second time this season...took a no-decision on July 15 at Oakland Coliseum in the Twins' 10-7 win; pitched 5.2 innings and allowed a season-high seven runs on eight hits (2 HR), with three walks and seven strikeouts...allowed two home runs in the fourth inning, a solo shot by Ryan Noda and a two-run blast by Seth Brown...was removed with two outs in the bottom of the sixth after throwing a season-high-tying 106 pitches...Twins scored a single run in each of the final three innings to secure the win...Lopez won his only other career start vs. Oakland on August 23, 2022 in a 5-3 Marlins' victory at Oakland Coliseum (6.0 IP, 4 H, 0 R, 2 BB, 5 K).

◆ Is 1-2, 5.45 ERA (34.2 IP, 21 ER) with 11 walks and 42 strikeouts in six starts vs. the AL West in 2023, with the Twins going 3-3 in those starts.

HITTING THE TARGET: Making his sixth home start in his last eight outings tonight...is 5-3, 4.12 ERA (94.0 IP, 43 ER) with 24 walks and 117 strikeouts in 15 home starts in 2023...Twins are 10-5 in his 15 starts at Target Field...here are his numbers in his last nine home starts compared to his first six:

**DAZZLING DOZEN:** López is 6-3 with a 2.59 ERA (73.0 IP, 21 ER), 14 walks, 83 strikeouts, a 1.18 WHIP and a .694 opponent OPS in his last 12 starts, since July 20...has recorded nine quality starts in that span and has pitched 6.0-or-more innings in 10 of the 12 starts...
