LAST TIME OUT: Recorded his 14th guality start of 2023 and earned the win on September 24 vs. Los Angeles-AL, a 9-3 Twins' victory at Target Field...pitched 6.0 innings and allowed three runs on seven hits, with no walks and a season-high-tying 10 strikeouts...allowed a two-run double to Brandon Drury in the top of the third and an RBI double to Zach Neto in the fifth...pitched a scoreless sixth inning to complete his outing; Twins took the lead in the bottom half of the inning to give him the victory...the win was his 11th of the season; is tied with Pablo López for the team lead this year.
Φ Recorded 10 strikeouts for the sixth time this year (also, April 8 vs. Houston, April 13 at New York-AL, May 13 vs. Chicago-NL, July 9 vs. Baltimore and July 21 vs. Chicago-AL), one short of his career high of 11 on September 22, 2021 at Chicago-NL.

**TWO STARTS AGO**: Took the loss on September 18 at Cincinnati in the Twins' 7-3 defeat...pitched 5.0 innings and allowed four runs on five hits (1 HR), with three walks and five strikeouts...allowed two runs in the second inning on two singles, one walk and a sacrifice fly by Will Benson...issued a two-out walk to Noelvi Marte in the fourth inning, then yielded a two-run homer to Benson...worked around a one-out double in the fifth, posting a scoreless inning to complete his outing...was relieved by Dallas Keuchel to start the sixth inning with Minnesota trailing 4-1...Twins fell in the series opener.

**SPECIAL K**: Has recorded 372 career strikeouts through his first 60 games, the most in Twins' history (1961-) through a pitcher's first 60 career games...would also hold the record through a pitcher's first 68 career games, four ahead of Hall of Famer Bert Blyleven (368 from 1970-72)...his 10.14 strikeouts-per-9.0 innings ratio in his career is the fourth best in Twins' history, and his 4.38 strikeout-to-walk

per-3.0 minings ratio in this career is the routin best in rwins instory, and ins 4.36 strikeout-to-wark ratio ranks eighth (min. 200.0 IP).
 Ts nine strikeouts away from 200 this season...paired with Pablo López (234 K), would mark second time the Twins have had multiple pitchers with 200-or-more strikeouts in the same season, after Dean Chance (220), Jim Kaat (211) and Dave Boswell (204) each surpassed the 200 mark in 1967.

- In 2022, his first full major-league season, was runs opening by stated and led both the club and all AL rookies in wins (13), innings pitched (147.0) and strikeouts (151).
  Made his major league debut for the Twins on September 1, 2021 vs. Chicago-NL (L, 5.0 IP, 3 H, 3 R/3 ER, 1 HR, 1 BB, 5 K).
  Helped Team USA win the silver medal in baseball at the 2020 Tokyo Olympics... went 1-0, 1.74 ERA (10.1 IP, 2 ER), one walk and eight strikeouts in two starts.
  Acquired by the Twins on July 22, 2021 from the Tampa Bay Rays, alongside right-handed pitcher Drew Strotman, in exchange for designated hitter Nelson Cruz... learned about the trade while in Japan with Team USA.
  In 2020, was part of the Rays 60-man player pool and spent the summer at the alternate training site in Port Charlotte, Florida...ranked by Baseball America as the No. 12 prospect in the Rays system following the season.
  In 2019, was named Rays minor league Pitcher of the Year after going 9-4, 1.96 ERA (12.3.2 IP, 27 ER) in his first full professional season...divided the year between Low-A Bowling Green (6 starts), High-A Charlotte (15 games, 13 starts) and Double-A Montgomery (3 starts).
