HAVE I GOT A LITTLE STORY FOR YOU: After completing their seven-game homestand with a record of 4-3 (3-1 vs. Texas and 1-2 vs. Cleveland), the Twins began their six-game roadtrip with consecutive wins in Texas over the last two nights...today, the Twins will continue the trip with the three-game series finale at Globe Life Field...after today's game, Minnesota will travel to Cleveland to play the Guardians for three games at Progressive Field from Monday-Wednesday...the Twins have gone 40-29 at home and 31-36 on the road. A win today would make the Twins seven games over .500, which would be their high-water mark for 2023...the last time they were seven games over was through games of August 19, 2022, when they finished the day 62-55. Since the All-Star break, the Twins have gone 26-19, the fourth-most wins in the AL and tied for eighth most in baseball.

TWINS COME BACK ON RANGERS: The Twins beat the Rangers last night at Globe Life Field by a score of 9-7 in 10 innings, making them 12-7 in extras this season...it marked their 34th comeback win this season, tied for ninth most in baseball...Dallas Keuchel was the starter and first of a season-high nine pitchers used...Keuchel allowed five runs on five hits in 3.1 innings pitched, while the eight relievers combined for 6.2 innings with two runs allowed on just four hits...the offense recorded 13 hits, four on Donovan Solano, who tied his career high and marked his seventh career four-hit game...Solano also homered in the third inning, his fifth of the season...Minnesota went 5-for-10 with runners in scoring position and recorded six runs with two outs.

BETTER MAN: The Twins today returned utility player Willi Castro from his rehab assignment and reinstated him from the 10-day Injured List...Castro, who missed the last 18 games with a mild left oblique strain, played in three games on rehab assignment with Triple-A St. Paul, going 2-for-11 with one RBI and two walks...prior to landing on the Injured List, Castro played in 101 games for the Twins this season, hitting .241 (67-for-278) with 15 doubles, three triples, five home runs, 26 RBI, 42 runs scored, 24 walks, 29 stolen bases and a .322 on-base percentage...to make room for Castro on the 28-man roster, the Twins have placed outfielder Michael A. Taylor on the 10-day Injured List with a right hamstring strain.

VS.: The Twins and Rangers are playing each other tonight for the seventh and final time in 2023...the Twins have gone 5-1 against the Rangers this season, their most wins over Texas since going 6-1 in 2019...prior to that, their last five-win season vs. Texas was 2011, going 5-3. These two will meet in 2024 for seven games, three at Target Field from May 24-26 and four at Globe Life Field from August 15-18. Since the start of 2019, the Twins have scored 5.6 runs-per-game in 26 games against the Rangers...marks the second most against any AL club in that span, trailing Seattle (5.8). The Twins are 6-2 all-time at Globe Life Field, going 3-0 in 2021, 1-2 in 2023 and 2-0 this season...since the start of 2016, the Twins have a record of 16-6 at Globe Life Field and Globe Life Park combined, including a record of 10-2 in their last 12.

I'M STILL ALIVE: The Twins bullpen has gone 3-1, 1.88 ERA (28.2 IP, 6 ER) with Rangers hitters batting .158 with one home run and a .448 OPS through six games vs. Texas this season...the Rangers 'pen has gone 1-4, 7.18 ERA (26.1 IP, 21 ER) with Twins batters hitting .275, nine home runs and a .938 OPS vs. Minnesota this season...the Twins have scored 42 runs against the Rangers this season, 28 of which have come after the fifth inning.

EVENPOLO: Jorge Polanco has reached safely in 23 of his last 24 games...additionally, in his last 18 games, since August 11, he is hitting .319 (22-for-69) with five home runs, 18 RBI, 11 walks, a .410 on-base percentage, a .563 slugging percentage and a .975 OPS. Polanco has driven in nine runs in his last seven games. Polanco is hitting .320 (8-for-25) with two home runs, four RBI, three walks, a .393 on-base percentage, a .560 slugging percentage and a .953 OPS in six games vs. Texas this season.

EDDIE ON LEAD VOCALS: Edouard Julien is leading off for the team-leading 35th time this afternoon...he has posted a .362 on-base percentage when hitting from the number one spot in the Twins lineup, fifth-highest among all AL players with a minimum of 150 plate appearances from that spot...additionally, he is hitting .299 (41-for-137) with 23 walks, a .401 on-base percentage and an .861 OPS in his last 44 games overall, since July 8...among all MLB rookies with a minimum of 300 plate appearances this season, he ranks second in on-base percentage (.373) and OPS+ (130.0), fifth in wOBA (.365), sixth in OPS (.834), and seventh in batting average (.279). Just two Twins rookies have finished a season with an on-base percentage higher than Julien's current .373 figure, Tom Brunansky — .377 in 1982 and Rich Rollins — .374 in 1962.

YEL-LEW LEDBETTER: After starting the season hitting .182 (6-for-33) with a .576 OPS in his first eight games, Royce Lewis has hit .328 (41-for-125) with four doubles, seven home runs, 22 RBI and a .915 OPS in his last 34 games. Among AL rookies with a minimum of 130 plate appearances, he ranks first in batting average (.297) and runs created-per-27 (6.99), second in OPS+ (131.2), third in slugging percentage (.500), wOBA (.366), and OPS (.847), and sixth in on-base percentage (.347).

GIVEN TO FLY: Willi Castro has a team-leading and career-high 29 stolen bases (33 attempts)...he has successfully stolen 10-straight bases since July 15...he is on pace to finish with 34 steals, which would be the most for a Twin since Ben Revere stole 40 in 2012...eight Twins all-time (since 1961) have recorded 30-plus stolen bases in a season (Chuck Knoblauch - 5x, Rod Carew - 4x, César Tovar - 2x, Ben Revere - 2x, Otis Nixon - 1x, Carlos Gómez - 1x, Larry Hisle - 1x and Luis Rivas - 1x).

TEN: The Twins have recorded double-digit hit totals 10 times in their last 18 games, since August 12, posting an .813 OPS and 5.6 runs-per-game in that span...in fact, since the All-Star break, the Twins rank third in baseball in home runs (76), sixth in OPS (.803) and slugging percentage (.464), tied for sixth in total bases (717), and seventh in on-base percentage (.339) and runs scored (237).

LAST KISS: The Twins are seeking their seventh sweep of the season today...their previous six sweeps were March 30-April 2 at Kansas City (3 games), June 13-14 vs. Milwaukee (2 games), July 3-5 vs. Kansas City (3 games), July 14-16 at Oakland (3 games), July 21-23 vs. Chicago-AL (3 games) and August 4-6 vs. Arizona (3 games)...last season, they swept opponents eight times, all in three games. The Twins last sweep of the Rangers came in three games at this ballpark from June 18-20, 2021...they have swept Rangers twice in their last three series in Texas, dating back to August of 2019. The Twins are 6-5 when entering the series finale with the opportunity to sweep.

I AM MINE-OR LEAGUE WEEKLY WINNERS: Triple-A St. Paul right-handed pitcher David Festa and Low-A Fort Myers outfielder Walker Jenkins have been named Twins minor league Pitcher and Player of the Week. Festa, 23, made his Triple-A debut on Wednesday night for the Saints against Columbus, allowing one run on four hits in 5.0 innings pitched, with one walk and seven strikeouts...the Verona, New Jersey native was selected by the Twins in the 13th round of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft out of Seton Hall University. Jenkins, 18, played in five games for the Mighty Mussels, hitting .500 (12-for-24) with two doubles, one home run, five RBI, one walk, a .708 slugging percentage and a 1.228 OPS...the Wilmington, North Carolina native was selected by the Twins fifth overall in the 2023 First-Year Player Draft out of Brunswick High School in Southport, North Carolina.

ONCE UPON A TIME: Hall of Famer Paul Molitor is on the call for the Treasure Island Baseball Network for the final time of 2023 today...did you know that in 201 career games against the Rangers, Molitor hit .310 (254-for-820) with 38 doubles, 14 triples, 17 home runs, 96 RBI, 139 runs scored, a .375 on-base percentage and an .827 OPS...the 14 triples were his second most against any opponent (15 vs. Minnesota)...his 254 career hits are the fifth most in baseball history vs. Texas, trailing Carl Yastrzemski (333), Ichiro Suzuki (317), George Brett (291) and Brooks Robinson (268).

- ☞ Facing Texas for the fifth time in his career; is 2-0, 2.70 ERA (16.2 IP, 5 ER) with one save, eight walks and 14 strikeouts in four previous appearances (3 starts) vs. the Rangers.
- ☞ Is in his fourth season with the Twins after being acquired in 2020, along with Jair Camargo, from Los Angeles-NL in exchange for Brusdar Graterol and Luke Raley.

LAST TIME OUT: Did not factor into the decision in his third-straight start on August 28 vs. Cleveland, a 10-6 Twins' win at Target Field...pitched 4.0 innings and allowed six runs on seven hits (1 HR), with one walk and three strikeouts, his lowest single-game strikeout total since April 26 vs. New York-AL (2 K)...pitched a 1-2-3 first inning, then allowed four runs in the second inning on one single, two doubles, one sacrifice fly (Will Brennan) and a two-run home run by Bo Naylor...allowed single runs in the third and fourth innings before being relieved by Kody Funderburk in the top of the fifth with the Twins leading 10-6; Funderburk earned the win in his MLB debut and Josh Winder earned his first career save as Minnesota won the three-game series opener.

- ☞ Snapped his 11-start streak of allowing three-or-fewer runs; was third-longest such streak of his career (18 starts - August 10, 2019-April 14, 2021; 12 starts - July 23-September 27, 2016).
- ☞ Has yielded at least one home run in eight-consecutive starts, the longest streak of his career... tied with Bailey Ober (still active) for the second-longest such streak by a Twin this season, behind Joe Ryan (9 games - still active).

TWO STARTS AGO: Took a no-decision in the Twins' 8-7, 10-inning loss on August 23 at Milwaukee in 97-degree heat at American Family Field...pitched 5.0 innings and allowed three runs on four hits (1 HR) with two walks and six strikeouts...allowed two runs on two singles, one walk and one hit-by-pitch in the first inning, yielding a two-run single to Andruw Monasterio...surrendered a solo homer to William Contreras in the third inning, then retired eight of the final nine batters he faced...was relieved by Emilio Pagan to start the sixth inning with Minnesota leading 6-3; Twins bullpen surrendered the lead, and the Brewers won on a walk-off infield single by Brice Turang to sweep the two-game series.

- ☞ Marked the fourth-highest gametime temperature in any start in his career and warmest since he started for Los Angeles-NL on July 6, 2018 at Los Angeles-AL with a gametime temperature of 108 degrees.

POWER RANGER: Facing Texas for the fifth time in his career...is 2-0, 2.70 ERA (16.2 IP, 5 ER) with one save, eight walks and 14 strikeouts in four previous appearances (3 starts) vs. the Rangers...last faced Texas on June 20, 2021 at Globe Life Field, earning the win in the Twins' 4-2 victory; pitched 5.1 innings and allowed two runs on five hits (2 HR), with one walk and four strikeouts...allowed back-to-back solo homers to Adolis Garcia and current teammate Joey Gallo in the top of the sixth inning...owns a two-game win streak against the Rangers and his teams are 4-0 in his four career appearances vs. Texas.

- ☞ Has not factored into the decision in three starts vs. the American League West this year, posting a 3.45 ERA (15.2 IP, 6 ER) with six walks and 23 strikeouts; Twins are 3-0 in those starts (5-4 W on July 14 at Oakland, 6-3 W on July 19 at Seattle, 4-3 W on July 24 vs. Seattle).

TOUGH LUCK ON THE ROAD: Making his 10th road start of the year today...is 1-5 (.167) in nine previous road starts despite owning a 3.19 ERA (42.1 IP, 15 ER) with 14 walks, 53 strikeouts, a 1.04 WHIP and a .201 (30-for-149) opponent batting average...has received zero runs of support in four road outings and three-or-fewer runs of support in seven of nine road starts...is one of two pitchers in baseball this season with a road ERA under 3.20 and a road winning percentage under .200 (min. 5 road starts), joining CLE's Gavin Williams (0-2, 1.96 ERA in five road starts)...in seven starts at Target Field in 2023, Maeda is 2-2, 6.44 ERA (36.1 IP, 26 ER) with seven walks and 38 strikeouts.

- ☞ Has allowed three-or-fewer runs in each of his nine road starts this year...his current streak is his second longest of his career (10-start streak from August 16, 2019-April 7, 2021 with Los Angeles-NL and Minnesota) and is the longest by a Twins starter since José Berrios' 10-start streak from August 26, 2020-May 31, 2021.
- ☞ Is 1-0, 4.26 ERA (6.1 IP, 3 ER) with one save, three walks and five strikeouts in two career appearances at Texas (1 start)...earned the save on August 29, 2018 at Globe Life Park in a 3-1 Dodgers' win and earned the win on June 20, 2021 at Globe Life Field in a 4-2 Twins' victory.
- ☞ In 99 career road appearances (83 starts), he is 27-27, 4.56 ERA (430.0 IP, 218 ER) with 138 walks and 472 strikeouts...is 35-21, 3.31 ERA (410.2 IP, 151 ER) with 103 walks and 453 strikeouts in 86 career home appearances (68 starts).

THE ARSENAL: Has used a five-pitch mix this year, mostly using his slider, split finger and 4-seam fastball, throwing the trio 90.0 percent of the time...favors his split finger (236/391 - 60.4%) against lefties and mostly uses his slider (268/423 - 63.4%) and sinker (84/84 - 100%) against righties...opposing hitters went 0-for-7 with two strikeouts off his splitter in his last start on August 28 vs. Cleveland...here's a breakdown of his repertoire:

- ☞ Averaged 91.4 mph on his four-seam fastball in five August starts, a 0.8-mph increase from his four-seam fastball average in his first 11 starts this season (90.6).
- ☞ His 34 strikeouts with his split finger are tied for the seventh most in the AL this year.

JAPANESE RANKS: Maeda is one win away from tying Hisashi Iwakuma for the fifth-most victories by a Japanese-born pitcher in American League/National League history (1901)...here are his career numbers and how they rank among Japanese-born hurlers in MLB (min. 500.0 IP):

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP PABLO LÓPEZ (2023: 9-7, 3.72 ERA // CAREER: 37-38, 3.88 ERA)

Right-hander Pablo López is slated to start the three-game series opener against the Cleveland Guardians tomorrow night at Progressive Field...lost to the Guardians despite recording a quality start in his last outing on August 29 at Target Field, a 4-2 Twins' defeat; pitched 6.0 innings and allowed three runs on eight hits (1 HR), with three walks and five strikeouts...took a no-decision in his only other start vs. Cleveland this year on June 1 at Target Field in a 7-6 Twins' win; allowed six runs on eight hits (eight singles) in 5.2 innings pitched, with one walk and five strikeouts...seeking his first victory against the Guardians since earning the win on April 23, 2019 at Progressive Field in a 3-1 Marlins' victory (6.1 IP, 2 H, 1 R, 0 ER, 2 BB, 6 K)...is 4-2, 3.32 ERA (59.2 IP, 22 ER) with 11 walks and 73 strikeouts in nine starts vs. the American League Central this season...is also 5-4 with a 2.87 ERA (84.2 IP, 27 ER) with 20 walks and 100 strikeouts in 14 road starts in 2023.
