LAST TIME OUT: Did not factor into the decision in his third-straight start on August 28 vs. Cleveland, a 10-6 Twins' win at Target Field...pitched 4.0 innings and allowed six runs on seven hits (1 HR), with one walk and three strikeouts, his lowest single-game strikeout total since April 26 vs. New York-AL doubles, one sacrifice fly (Will Brennan) and a two-run home run by Bo Naylor...allowed single runs in the third and fourth innings before being relieved by Kody Funderburk in the top of the fifth with the Twins leading 10-6; Funderburk earned the win in his MLB debut and Josh Winder earned his first career save as Minnesota won the three-game series opener.
$\Phi$ Snapped his 11 -start streak of allowing three-or-fewer runs; was third-longest such streak of his career (18 starts - August 10, 2019-April 14, 2021; 12 starts - July 23-September 27, 2016).玉 Has yielded at least one home run in eight-consecutive starts, the longest streak of his career... tied with Bailey Ober (still active) for the second-longest such streak by a Twin this season, behind Joe Ryan (9 games - still active).
TWO STARTS AGO: Took a no-decision in the Twins' 8-7, 10-inning loss on August 23 at Milwaukee in 97-degree heat at American Family Field...pitched 5.0 innings and allowed three runs on four hits ( 1 HR) with two walks and six strikeouts....allowed two runs on two singles, one walk and one hit-by-pitch liam Contreras in the third inning then retired eight of the final nine batters he faced was relieved by Emilio Pagán to start the sixth inning with Minnesota leading 6-3. Twins bullpen surrendered the lead, and the Brewers won on a walk-off infield single by Brice Turang to sweep the two-game series. $\boldsymbol{\Phi}$ Marked the fourth-highest gametime temperature in any start in his career and warmest since he started for Los Angeles-NL on July 6, 2018 at Los Angeles-AL with a gametime temperature of 108 degrees.
POWER RANGER: Facing Texas for the fifth time in his career...is 2-0, 2.70 ERA ( $16.2 \mathrm{IP}, 5 \mathrm{ER}$ ) with one save, eight walks and 14 strikeouts in four previous appearances (3 starts) vs. the Rangers...last faced Texas on June 20, 2021 at Globe Life Field, earning the win in the Twins $4-2$ victory; pitched 5.1 innings and allowed two runs on five hits ( 2 HR ), with one walk and four strikeouts...allowed back-to-back solo homers to Adolis García and current teammate Joey Gallo in the top of the sixth inning...owns a two-game win streak against the Rangers and his teams are 4-0 in his four career appearances vs. Texas.
$\Phi$ Has not factored into the decision in three starts vs. the American League West this year, posting a 3.45 ERA (15.2 IP, 6 ER) with six walks and 23 strikeouts; Twins are 3-0 in those starts (5-4 W on July 14 at Oakland, 6-3 W on July 19 at Seattle, 4-3 W on July 24 vs. Seattle).

TOUGH LUCK ON THE ROAD: Making his 10th road start of the year today...is 1-5 (.167) in nine previous road starts despite owning a 3.19 ERA (42.1 IP, 15 ER ) with 14 walks, 53 strikeouts, a 1.04 WHIP and a . 201 (30-for-149) opponent batting average...has received zero runs of support in four road outings and three-or-fewer runs of support in seven of nine road starts is one of two pitchers in baseball this season with a road ERA under 3.20 and a road winning percentage under . 200 (min. 5 road starts), joining CLE's Gavin Williams ( $0-2,1.96$ ERA in five road starts)...in seven starts at Target Field in 2023, Maeda is 2-2, 6.44 ERA (36.1 IP, 26 ER) with seven walks and 38 strikeouts.

- Missed entire 2022 season recovering from Tommy John surgery on right elbow. - Finished second in the 2020 American League Cy Young Award voting, accruing 92 total votes (Cleveland's Shane Bieber was the unanimous winner)
- Named Joseph W. Haynes Award winner for Twins Pitcher of the Year in 2020, voted on by the Twin Cities Chapter of the BBWAA...also named the starting pitcher on 2020 All-MLB Second Team.
- Pitched 8.0 no-hit innings on August 18, 2020 vs. MIL before bid was broken up in the ninth...longest no-hit bid of career, and set Twins record with eight-straight K's. - Is the third Japanese-born player in Twins franchise history, after Micheal Nakamura - (2003) and Tsuyoshi Norshioka (2011-12).
- Owns the fifth-most strikeouts in MLB history among Japanese-born pitchers. - His 16 wins in 2016 were the second-most wins ever by a Los Angeles-NL rookie behind only Rick Sutcliffe (17-10, 1979), and tied for the second-most ever in a single season by a Japanese pitcher.
- In 2016, led qualifying MLB rookie starting pitchers in starts (32), wins (16), opponents' batting average (.229), WHIP (1.14), innings pitched (175.2) and strikeout-to-walk ratio (3.58).
- Named to the 2016 Baseball America Major League All-Rookie Team, and finished
