THE TWINS: After completing their six-game homestand with a record of 4-2 (2-1 vs. the Angels and 2-1 vs. the Athletics), the Twins began their final roadtrip of 2023 with a win in Colorado last night...tonight, Minnesota will play the second of three at Coors Field and conclude the 2023 regular season tomorrow afternoon...the Twins have gone 47-34 at home and 39-40 on the road. The Twins are seeking their 28th series victory this season...they are 27-19-5 in series play in 2023, going 15-8-3 at home and 12-11-2 on the road...they have gone 10-3-1 in series play since August 11...in that span, they are 5-1-0 in road series.

ROCKY MOUNTAIN HIGH: The Twins beat the Rockies last night at Coors Field by a score of 7-6...Joe Ryan was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing six runs on eight hits in 5.0 innings pitched, with one walk and six strikeouts...Emilio Pagán earned his first save of the season and 32nd of his career with a scoreless ninth...the offense recorded 13 hits, led by Ryan Jeffers, who went 3-for-4 with a walk and a home run...for Jeffers, it marked his 14th homer, tying his single-season career high, previously done in 2021 — Twins are now 13-0 when Jeffers homers...Trevor Larnach (7) added a pinch-hit home run and Michael A. Taylor (21) also homered, hitting a 468-foot shot, the second longest of his career (493 ft - 8/20/15) and longest by a Twin this season.

ADDITIONAL NOTE: Last night's win marked the 17th of the month, Minnesota's most for the season, passing their April total of 16 (1 in March)...a win tonight would be their most in a single month since going 18-12 in May of 2022.

AND I WAS ALL LIKE, EMILIOOOO!: Emilio Pagán will start for Minnesota tonight and will be the second time they have used an Opener this season, the previous being José De León on June 17 vs. Detroit...De León pitched 2.0 innings and led the club to a 2-0 victory in which the Twins used five relievers after him...today marks Pagán's first career start at the major league level...he started one minor league game in his career, coming on April 6, 2019 for Triple-A Durham (Tampa Bay) and pitching 1.2 scoreless innings.

STARTING WHAT YOU FINISHED: Tonight, Emilio Pagán will become the first Twin in club history (since 1961) to start a game immediately following a save in the previous game (credit Elias)...four Twins pitchers previously have finished a game, then started the next one but none ever earned a save in game one...below are the previous four times:

NOTE: Among all MLB pitchers, the last one to finish a game then start the next one was Tampa Bay's Javy Guerra from May 6 & 7, 2023 against New York-AL...the last to earn a save then start the next game was Tampa Bay's John Curtiss from September 25 & 26, 2020 against Philadelphia.

TWINS AND ROX: The Twins and Rockies are playing each other for the 19th, 20th and 21st time in their history this weekend...the Twins have gone 11-8 all-time against Colorado, going 2-1 at the Metrodome (2003), 4-3 at Coors Field (2008, '14 & '23) and 5-4 at Target Field (2010, '17, '22).

The Twins are looking to win their fourth straight against the Rockies (dating back to June 25, 2022), which would mark their best over Colorado since winning three straight, a streak that spanned from June 11, 2003-May 16, 2008.

Minnesota is 4-2 in series play all-time against Colorado...1-1 at Coors Field, their other series win here coming July 11-13, 2014 (2 of 3).

The Twins have hit just 13 home runs against the Rockies in their history, the fewest against any opponent...seven of those home runs have come in Denver...the next fewest against any opponent is 14 vs. Los Angeles-NL.

NATIONAL ATTENTION: The Twins have gone 24-20 in Interleague Play this season, going 1-2 at Miami, 1-2 vs. Washington, 2-1 vs. San Diego, 2-1 vs. Chicago-NL, 1-2 at Los Angeles-NL, 1-2 vs. San Francisco, 2-0 vs. Milwaukee, 0-3 at Atlanta, 2-1 at St. Louis, 3-0 vs. Arizona, 2-1 at Philadelphia, 2-1 vs. Pittsburgh, 0-2 at Milwaukee, 2-1 vs. New York-NL, 2-1 at Cincinnati and 1-0 at Colorado...the Twins have gone 13-6 in their last 19 Interleague games and 17-10 in their last 27.

Max Kepler has 21 career Interleague home runs, tied with Justin Morneau for fourth most in club history, trailing Torii Hunter (33), Eddie Rosario (23) and Joe Mauer (22).

Humphrey Metrodome in downtown Minneapolis for the next 28 seasons (through 2009)...in 2008, the Twins and White Sox played a one-game tiebreaker for the AL Central title as the Sox won 1-0 on a Jim Thome seventh-inning home run off Nick Blackburn...the Twins recorded two hits, a Brendan Harris single and a Michael Cuddyer double...in 2018, Joe Mauer played his final major league game, going 1-for-4 and doubling in his final at-bat...he came on to play catcher one final time in the top of the ninth inning at Target Field, catching one pitch from Matt Belisle.
