<b>THE TWINS:</b> Have gone 2-1 through three games on their current six-game roadtrip, winning the first two in Texas, followed by a loss at Globe Life Field yesterday afternoontonight, the Twins will continue the trip with the first of three at Cleveland and finish the series/trip on Wednesday afternoonthe Twins have gone 40-29 at home and 31-37 on the road. \$\Pi\$ Since the All-Star break, the Twins have gone 26-20, the fourth-most wins in the AL, trailing Seattle (32-15), Baltimore (31-16) and Houston (27-20).

**TEXAS TWO-STEP WALK-OFF:** The Twins lost to the Rangers yesterday afternoon at Globe Life Field by a score of 6-5 in walk-off fashion, as Adolis García homered (solo) off Josh Winder in the bottom of the ninth...Kenta Maeda was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing three runs on nine hits in 5.0 innings pitched...the offense recorded 11 hits, three from both Carlos Correa and Royce Lewis...Lewis drove in four runs on the day, including the game-tying home run in the fifth inning and the game-tying RBI single in the eighth inning.

ROSTER MOVE: The Twins have recalled right-handed pitcher Louie Varland from Triple-A St Paul... Varland has gone 5-1, 3.92 ERA (66,2 IP, 29 ER), 22 walks, 63 strikeouts and a .265 (69-for-260) opponent batting average in 13 games (12 starts) for the Saints since June 23... this is his third stint with the Twins this season...to make room for Varland on the 28-man roster, the Twins have optioned right-handed pitcher Cole Sands to the Saints.

Take the saints of the Saints on Thursday vs. Columbus, allowing one run on three hits in 4.0 innings pitched...it marked his first appearance in relief this season.

TWINS AND GUARDS: The Twins are playing the Guardians for the 11th of 13 times in 2023... the Twins are 4-6 vs. the Guards this season, going 3-4 at Target Field and 1-2 at Progressive Field... these two last met August 28-30 as the Twins won game one and the Guards won games two and three... these two last met at Progressive From May 5-7.

The Twins have homered 12 times against Cleveland pitching this season, second most in baseball, trailing only Chicago-AL (17).

The Twins have hit 116 home runs against Cleveland pitching since the start of 2019, tied for their most against any opponent in that span (also 116 vs. Chicago-AL and Detroit)... of those 116 home runs, 59 have been that Progressive Field, the Twins most in any opposing ballpark since... 59 homers are also the most for any opponent here since 2019 (next: Chicago-AL, Detroit and Kansas City - 41).

Carlos Correa is hitting .292 (26-for-89) with six home runs, a .357 on-base percentage, a .506 slugging percentage and an .863 OPS in 23 games against the Guardians since the start of last season.

**POLO ON THE MARK:** Jorge Polanco has reached safely in a season-long 12-straight games, hitting .310 (13-for-42) with two doubles, three home runs, nine RBI, 10 walks, a .442 on-base percentage, a .571 slugging percentage and a 1.014 OPS in that span...his career-high for an on-base streak is 37, done from May 13-June 25, 2019.

LAST TIME OUT: Recorded a quality start but took the loss on August 29 vs. Cleveland, a 4-2 Twins' defeat at Target Field...allowed three runs on eight hits (1 HR) in 6.0 innings pitched, with three walks and five strikeouts...allowed one run in the second, third and fourth innings, including yielding a solo home run to Bo Naylor in the second...threw two wild pitches for the first time in his career, the first of which allowed José Ramirez to score from third base in the third inning...departed after 6.0 innings with Minnesota trailing 3-1; Twins went 0-for-9 with runners in scoring position and dropped the middle game of the three-game series.

Thus recorded a quality start in nine of his last 12 outings (2.89 ERA) and has posted 17 quality starts this season, the most of the Twins' staff and tied with four other pitchers for the second most in the American League this season (NYY's Gerrit Cole leads with 20)...his 17 quality starts are the most by a Twin since José Berríos had 21 in 2019.

TWO STARTS AGO: Did not factor into the decision on August 24 vs. Texas, a 7-5 Twins' win at Target Field...allowed five runs on a season-high 10 hits (season-high-tying 3 HR) in 5.0 innings pitched, with one walk and four strikeouts...snapped his career-high 19.0-inning scoreless streak by allowing a leadoff homer to Marcus Semien in the top of the first, the first time he has yielded a leadoff homer thisyear (6th of career)...surrendered solo homers to Corey Seager in the third inning and Leody Taveras in the fourth...was lifted after 5.0 innings for the first time since July 20 at Seattle...Twins bullpen tossed 4.0 scoreless innings, and Minnesota came from behind to take the four-game series opener.

Allowed three home runs for the second time this season, also doing so on May 15 at Los Angeles-NL...also allowed 10-or-more hits for the the fourth time in his career and first time since September 10, 2022 vs. New York-NL.

STRIKEOUT SAVANT: Ranks second in the American League with 196 strikeouts this year (TOR's Kevin Gausman - 207)...owns a 10.71 strikeouts-per-9.0-innings ratio in 2023, the third-highest single-season ratio in Twins history (1961-) among qualified pitchers (Joe Ryan, 2023 - 10.91; Kenta Maeda, 2020 - 10.80)...is four strikeouts away from 200 this season; would become the eighth Venezuelan-born pitcher in American League/National League history to strike out 200 batters in a season, joining former Twin Johan Santana (2004-08), Carlos Zambrano (2005-06), Félix Hernández (2009-14), Anibal Sánchez (2011, 2013), Carlos Carrasco (2015, 2017-18), Germán Márquez (2018) and Eduardo Rodriguez (2019)...would also become the first Twins pitcher with at least 200 strikeouts in a single season since José Berríos in 2018 (202 K).

**ON GUARD:** Facing Cleveland for the second-straight start, third time this season and fourth time in his career...is 1-1, 4.50 ERA (18.0 IP, 9 ER) with six walks and 16 strikeouts in three previous starts vs. the Guardians...suffered the loss in his last start on August 29 vs. Cleveland at Target Field (see "LAST TIME OUT" above)...also took a no-decision against the Guardians on June 1 at Target Field, a 7-6 Twins' win; pitched 5.2 innings and allowed six runs on eight hits (7 singles), with one walk and five strikeouts...three of the six singles he allowed in a five-run sixth inning had an exit velocity under 95.0 mph and Will Brennan's single had an expected batting average of .090, according to Statcast.

**DIVISIONAL DOMINANCE:** López is 4-2, 3.32 ERA (59.2 IP, 22 ER) with 11 walks and 73 strikeouts in nine starts against the American League Central division this year...has recorded a quality start in six of those nine outings, and the Twins have gone 7-2 in those nine games...over his career, he is 5-3, 2.99 ERA (72.1 IP, 24 ER) with 13 walks and 85 strikeouts in 11 starts vs. the AL Central...his career 1.02 WHIP against the AL Central ranks 12th in baseball since 2019 (min. 10 GS), while his 10.58 strikeouts-per-9.0 innings ranks 14th in that span.

ROAD WARRIOR: Has recorded 10 quality starts in his 14 road outings this season, going 5-4, 2.87 ERA (84.2 IP, 27 ER) with 20 walks and 100 strikeouts away from Target Field this year... Twins are 7-7 in his 14 road starts... is 19-20, 4.08 ERA (310.2 IP, 141 ER) with 83 walks and 321 strikeouts in 58 career road starts... in 63 home starts, he is 18-18, 3.71 ERA (364.0 IP, 150 ER) with 102 walks and 364 strikeouts.
