THE TWINS: Have gone 3-1 through four games on their current six-game roadtrip, going 2-1 in Texas, followed by a win in Cleveland last night...tonight, the Twins will continue the trip with the second of three at Cleveland before finishing the series/trip tomorrow afternoon... after tomorrow's game, Minnesota will travel home to enjoy an off-day on Thursday, then begin their penultimate homestand of 2023 with three against the Mets this weekend, followed by three against the Rays next Monday-Wednesday...the Twins have gone 40-29 at home and 32-37 on the road.
Since the All-Star break, the Twins have gone 27-20, the fourth-most wins in the AL, trailing Seattle (32-16), Baltimore (32-16) and Houston (28-20).
A win tonight would make the Twins seven games over .500, which would be their high-water mark for 2023...the Twins have been six games over .500 six times this season...the last time they were seven games over was through games of August 19, 2022, when they finished the day 62-55.

TWINS FIND THE END ZONE THREE TIMES IN CLEVELAND: The Twins beat the Guardians last night at Progressive Field by a score of 20-6, their largest margin of victory since an 18-4 victory at Seattle on May 18, 2019...Pablo López (10-7) was the starter and winner, allowing one run on eight hits in 6.0 innings pitched...the offense set season-highs in runs, hits (20) and home runs (6)...Jorge Polanco, Royce Lewis and Matt Wallner each had three-hit games, as Lewis hit his third grand slam of the season...Polanco (12), Carlos Correa (17), Joey Gallo (21), Kyle Farmer (9) and Wallner (11) also all homered.
11 different Twins recorded hits, eight drove in at least one run and 12 scored a run...12 different players scoring tied for most in club history (4/27/80 vs. OAK, 8/1/70 vs. DET).
Marked the 10th time in club history that the Twins scored 20-plus runs, first since June 4, 2002, when the Twins won 23-2 over Cleveland at the Metrodome.

ALMOST 24 HOURS SINCE LEWIS HIT A GRAND SLAM...HE'S DUE: Royce Lewis' second inning grand slam last night was the fourth of his career and third in his last eight games...he became the fourth player (1st rookie) in AL/NL history to hit three grand slams in a span of eight games-or-fewer, joining Jim Northrup (1968 - 4-game span), Lou Gehrig (1931 - 5-game span) and Larry Parrish (1982 - 8-game span).
Four career grand slams already ties Lewis for 11th on Twins all-time list with Bob Allison, Rod Carew, Shane Mack and Eddie Rosario...Harmon Killebrew's 10 is the record.
Three grand slams this season ties a club single-season record, joining Bob Allison (1961), Rod Carew (1976), Kent Hrbek (1985), Kirby Puckett (1992) and Torii Hunter (2007).
Royce is the second player in AL/NL history with four grand slams within his first 13 career homers, joining Chris Taylor...Taylor's fourth slam was his 11th homer, so Lewis has the second fewest homers to reach four career grand slams.
Four grand slams in 56 career games is the fastest to that figure in AL/NL history, the next fastest being the Tigers' Rudy York, who did it in 132 games in 1938.

TWINS AND GUARDS: The Twins are playing the Guardians for the 12th of 13 times in 2023...the Twins are 5-6 vs. the Guardians this season, going 3-4 at Target Field and 2-2 at Progressive Field...the Twins have outscored the Guardians 50-39 this season.
Minnesota has homered 18 times against Cleveland pitching this season, the most in baseball against the Guardians (White Sox - 17).
The Twins have hit 122 home runs against Cleveland pitching since the start of 2019, their most against any opponent in that span...of those 122 home runs, 65 have been hit at Progressive Field, the Twins' most in any opposing ballpark in that stretch...65 homers are also the most for any opponent here since 2019 (next: Chicago-AL, Detroit and Kansas City - 41).
Carlos Correa is hitting .301 (28-for-93) with seven home runs, a .363 on-base percentage, a .538 slugging percentage and a .900 OPS in 24 games against the Guardians since the start of last season.
Max Kepler has 45 hits, 16 home runs, 32 runs scored and 35 RBI at Progressive Field (51 career games), all his most in any opposing ballpark.

SERIES CONVERSATIONS: The Twins are seeking their 22nd series victory this season...they are 21-18-5 in series play in 2023, going 12-7-3 at home and 9-11-2 on the road...they are looking to win their second-straight road series and third in their last four chances away from Target Field (2-1 at PHI — 8/11-13, 0-2 at MIL — 8/22-23, 2-1 at TEX — 9/1-3).
Minnesota is looking to win their first series against Cleveland since these two first met in 2022, when the Twins took two of three at Target Field from May 13-15...Twins have gone 0-6-1 in series play against the Guardians since that series.
The Twins' last series win in Cleveland came September 6-9, 2021, when the Twins took three of four.

LEWIS - *TURNS ON PS5, SELECTS BEGINNER MODE*: After starting the season hitting .182 (6-for-33) with a .576 OPS in his first eight games, Royce Lewis has hit .351 (47-for-134) with four doubles, nine home runs, 32 RBI, a .404 on-base percentage, a .582 slugging percentage and a .986 OPS in his last 36 games, including nine three-plus-hit games... among all MLB rookies with a minimum of 175 plate appearances, Lewis ranks first in batting average (.317), runs created-per-27 (8.42), OPS+ (147.0), slugging percentage (.545), OPS (.908), and wOBA (.389).
Lewis has the most RBI (44), second-most homers (13), and second-most total bases (113) in Twins history through 56 career games.

POLO ON THE MARK: Jorge Polanco has reached safely in a season-long 13-straight games, hitting .356 (16-for-45) with two doubles, four home runs, 11 RBI, 11 walks, a .482 on-base percentage, a .667 slugging percentage and a 1.149 OPS in that span...his career high for an on-base streak is 37, done from May 13-June 25, 2019.
Polanco has reached base seven times in his last eight plate appearances.

C4 IGNITING: Carlos Correa has multiple hits in three-straight games, including at least one RBI in all three...in his last 36 road games, since June 8, Correa is hitting .292 (42-for-144) with nine doubles, eight home runs, 21 RBI, 12 walks, a .352 on-base percentage, a .521 slugging percentage and an .873 OPS.
He has reached safely in 13-straight road games, posting a .436 OBP in that span with 11 RBI.

COWBOY UP(DATE): Right-handed pitcher Chris Paddock is scheduled to start in a rehab game with Low-A Fort Myers tomorrow night vs. Bradenton...he will throw three innings or 50 pitches...Paddock underwent Tommy John surgery on his right elbow on May 18, 2022.

WALKER WINS THE WEEK: Low-A Fort Myers outfielder Walker Jenkins has been named Florida State League Player of the Week...in four games for the Mighty Mussels, the 2023 fifth overall pick hit .529 (9-for-17) with one double, one triple, one home run, three RBI, no strikeouts, a .556 on-base percentage and an .882 slugging percentage.

LAST TIME OUT: Did not factor into the decision despite recording his 14th quality start of the year in his start on August 30 vs. Cleveland...pitched a season-high-tying 7.0 shutout innings and allowed just three hits, with zero walks and five strikeouts in a 10-inning 5-2 Twins' defeat...allowed a leadoff double to Steven Kwan, then retired 20 of the next 23 batters he faced...relieved Griffin Jax in the eighth inning and allowed one double...Caleb Thielbar replaced Jax and yielded an RBI single to Kwan...Jhoan Duran entered in the ninth inning and allowed Andrés Giménez to score on a wild pitch to tie the game...Kody Funderburk surrendered a go-ahead three-run home run to Kole Calhoun in the 10th inning.

⚡ Has pitched at least 6.0 innings in eight-straight starts, dating back to July 22...is 3-2, 2.44 ERA (51.2 IP, 14 ER) with eight walks and 50 strikeouts in those games...marks his longest since a nine-start streak from June 25-August 15, 2017 with Oakland and New York-AL (career high is 13 in 2015 with Oakland).

⚡ Marked the first time he has pitched 7.0-or-more innings in back-to-back starts since July 3-12, 2019 as a member of the Cincinnati Reds (8.0 IP – July 3 vs. Milwaukee, 7.0 IP – July 12 at Colorado).

TWO STARTS AGO: Earned his seventh win of the season in his start on August 25 vs. Texas...pitched a season-high-tying 7.0 innings and allowed one run on six hits (1 HR), with zero walks and four strikeouts in a 12-2 Twins' victory; marked the Twins' largest margin of victory over the Rangers since a 15-5 win on July 10, 2016 in Texas...allowed his lone run on a solo home run to Mitch Garver to lead off the second inning...retired 17 of the final 22 batters he faced after the homer...relieved by Cole Sands who pitched 2.0 innings and allowed one run (unearned run) with one strikeout...allowed a single to Corey Seager in the eighth inning, Seager advanced to second on a passed ball...permitted an RBI single to Nathaniel Lowe to score Seager.

HINDERING HOMERS: Has allowed just six home runs through his 27 starts this season...has allowed the fewest homers in baseball among pitchers with at least 15 starts...is one of two pitchers in Twins' history (since 1961) to allow six-or-fewer home runs in his first 27 starts of the year, joining Francisco Liriano (4 HR through first 27 GS in 2010)...his 0.34 home runs-per-9.0 inning ratio is the lowest by a qualified pitcher in Twins' history (1961-).

ROCK HALL: Gray is facing the Guardians for the 19th time in his career and for the fourth time this season...is 0-1, 2.89 ERA (18.2 IP, 6 ER) with four walks and 13 strikeouts in his three previous starts this season...is 6-5, 3.41 ERA (100.1 IP, 38 ER) with 35 walks and 96 strikeouts in his 18 career starts against the Guardians.

⚡ Is 1-2, 3.75 ERA (36.0 IP, 15 ER) with 10 walks and 29 strikeouts in seven starts against the Guardians since joining the Twins...1-1, 4.50 ERA (14.0 IP, 7 ER) with five walks and 10 strikeouts in three starts at Progressive Field.

⚡ Is looking for his first win against the Guardians since June 27, 2022 when he led the Twins to an 11-1 win at Progressive Field (7.0 IP, 3 H, 0 R/ER, 1 BB, 3 K)...also has not earned a win at home against the Guardians since August 3, 2020 with Cincinnati (6.0 IP, 4 H, 2 R, 1 ER, 1 HR, 2 BB, 8 K).

⚡ Owns the third-most strikeouts against the Guardians since 2014 (min. 15 GS), trailing Carlos Rodón (124) and Justin Verlander (115)...also owns the third-lowest opponent batting average (.231), trailing Rodón (.214) and José Berríos (.224).

THE ARSENAL: Gray has used a six-pitch mix this season, per Baseball Savant...currently uses his four-seam fastball the most at 26.0 percent...recorded all five of his strikeouts using his sweeper in his last start on August 30 vs. Cleveland...primarily uses his curveball (286 pitches) and changeup (151 pitches) against lefties and his cutter (250 pitches), sinker (342 pitches) and sweeper (334 pitches) against righties...here's a look at his repertoire so far:

- Twins are fourth organization (Oakland 2011-17, New York-AL 2017-18 and Cincinnati 2019-21).
- Acquired by Minnesota on March 13, 2022 in a trade with the Reds, along with right-handed pitcher Francis Peguero, in exchange for right-handed pitcher Chase Petty.
- Has made eight Opening Day rosters with the Athletics (2014-2016), Yankees (2018), Reds (2019-2020) and Twins (2022-2023).
- Named to American League All-Star team in 2015 for Oakland and the National League squad in 2019 for Cincinnati (did not pitch in either).
- 2019 recipient of the Johnny Vander Meer Award as the Reds' Most Outstanding Pitcher and finished second to Atlanta's Josh Donaldson in voting for the MLBPA's National League Comeback Player of the Year Award.
- Named to *Baseball America's* 2019 major league All-Star second team...named American League Pitcher of the Month for April in 2014...in 2013 was the Athletics' Minor League Pitcher of the Year and a *Baseball America* Triple-A All-Star.
- Originally selected by Oakland in first round (18th overall) in 2011 First-Year Player Draft out of Vanderbilt University...led Vandy to its first NCAA College World Series berth in 2011.
