THE TWINS: Have gone 4-1 through five games on their current six-game roadtrip, going 2-1 in Texas, followed by consecutive wins in Cleveland over the last two nights...today, the Iwins will complete the trip with the three-game series finale at Progressive Field...after today's game, Minnesota will travel home to enjoy an off-day tomorrow, then begin their penultimate homestand of 2023 with three against the Mets this weekend, followed by three against the Rays next Monday-Wednesday...the Twins have gone 40-29 at home and 33-37 on the road.
♣ Since the All-Star break, the Twins have gone 28-20, the fourth-most wins in the AL, trailing Baltimore (33-16), Seattle (32-17) and Houston (29-20).

♣ The Twins are now seven games over .500, their high-water mark for 2023...the last time they were seven games over was through games of August 19, 2022, when they finished the day 62-55...the last time they were eight games over was July 24, 2022 (52-44).

DONNIE TURNS THE LIGHTS OFF AT PROGRESSIVE: The Twins beat the Guardians last night at Progressive Field by a score of 8-3...Sonny Gray was the starter but did not factor into the decision for the 15th time in 28 starts...Gray allowed three runs on six hits (1 HR) in 6.0 innings pitched, with two walks and four strikeouts...the offense recorded 11 hits and was led by Donovan Solano, who went 2-for-5 with a single, a triple and three RBI...Christian Vázquez added a home run, his sixth of the season...the win secured the Twins' first series victory over Cleveland since May 13-15, 2022 (0-6-1 since).

TWINS AND GUARDS: The Twins are playing the Guardians for the 13th and final time in 2023...the Twins are 6-6 vs. the Guards this season, going 3-4 at Target Field and 3-2 at Progressive Field...the Twins have outscored the Guards 58-42 this season...they have outscored Cleveland 28-9 in this series.
 ♣ These two will meet 13 times in 2024, their first coming in the Twins' Home Opener, a three-game, four-day series from April 4-7...the first series at Progressive will be three games from May 17-19.
 ♣ A win today would give the Twins the season-series victory for the first time since going 11-8 in 2021...they went 6-13 vs. Cleveland in 2022.
 ♠ Minnesota has homered 19 times against Cleveland pitching this season, the most in baseball against the Guardians (White Sox - 17).
 ♠ The Iwins have hit 123 home runs against Cleveland pitching since the start of 2019, their most against any opponent in that span...of those 123 home runs, 66 have been hit at Progressive Field, the Iwins' most in any opposing ballpark in that stretch...66 homers are also the most for any opponent here since 2019 (next: Chicago-AL, Detroit and Kansas City - 41).
 ♠ Carlos Correa is hitting 302 (29-for-96) with seven home runs, a 374 on-base percentage, a .531 slugging percentage and a .905 OPS in 25 games against the Guardians since the start of last season.
 ♠ Max Kepler has 46 hits, 16 home runs, 34 runs scored and 36 RBI at Progressive Field (52 career games), all his most in any opposing ballpark.
 TWINS ON LEAD VOCALS: The Twins enter today with a 7.0 game lead on the Guardians in the

TWINS ON LEAD VOCALS: The Twins enter today with a 7.0 game lead on the Guardians in the AL Central, their biggest lead this season...through games of July 30 (37 days ago), the Twins had a 0.5 game lead on the Guardians, when Minnesota was 54-53 and Cleveland was 53-53.

ROYCE ROCKS: After starting the season hitting .182 (6-for-33) with a .576 OPS in his first eight games, Royce Lewis has hit .350 (48-for-137) with four doubles, nine home runs, 32 RBI, a .411 on-base percentage, a .577 slugging percentage and a .987 OPS in his last 37 games, including nine three-plus-hit games...among all MLB rookies with a minimum of 175 plate appearances, Lewis ranks first in batting average (.318), runs created-per-27 (8.73), OPS+ (148.0), slugging percentage (.541), OPS (.911), and wOBA (.391).

POLANCO UNLOCKED: Jorge Polanco has reached safely in a season-long 14-straight games, hitting .347 (17-for-49) with three doubles, four home runs, 12 RBI, 11 walks, a .459 on-base percentage, a .653 slugging percentage and a 1.112 OPS in that span...his career high for an on-base streak is 37, done from May 13-June 25, 2019.

C4 IGNITING: Carlos Correa has hit safely in five-straight games and has nine hits in 21 at-bats in that span...in his last 37 road games, since June 8, Correa is hitting .293 (43-for-147) with nine doubles, eight home runs, 22 RBI, 13 walks, a .360 on-base percentage, a .517 slugging percentage and an .877 OPS.

The has reached safely in 14-straight road games, posting a .450 OBP in that span with 12 RBI.

MR. BARRELS: Since August 1, Donovan Solano is hitting .372 (35-for-94) with five doubles, one triple, one home run, 13 RBI, a .404 on-base percentage and an .883 OPS in 26 games... in that span he has multiple hits 11 times, including six times in his last 10 games...since August 1, his .372 batting average ranks third best in baseball (minimum of 90 plate appearances), trailing only Mookie Betts (.429) and Julio Rodríguez (.398).

LAND OF 10,000 RAKES: The Twins have hit 31 home runs since August 22, tied with New York-AL for the most in baseball since that date...since the All-Star break, they have hit 84 home runs, second most in baseball, trailing Atlanta's 94.

♣ One more home run today and the Twins will reach 200 for the season.

OHL BABY!: Double-A Wichita right-hander Pierson Ohl yesterday was named Texas League Pitcher of the Month for August...Ohl went 5-0 with a 1.17 ERA in five starts...he held opponents to a league-best .179 average as he scattered 19 hits and four earned runs over 30.2 innings...Ohl's 0.72 WHIP also led the league...he worked a career-high 8.0 innings on August 8 at Northwest Arkansas...Ohl, 23, was selected by Minnesota in the 14th round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of Grand Canyon University.

LAST TIME OUT: Earned his 10th win of the season in the Twins' 5-1 victory on September 1 at Texas... recorded his 13th quality start of 2023, pitching 6.0 innings and allowing one run on three hits (1 HR), with no walks and seven strikeouts on a season-low 74 pitches...held the Rangers to one hit through 3.0 innings before yielding a solo homer to Corey Seager to lead off the fourth; after the homer, Ryan retired eight of the final 10 batters he faced...was relieved by Griffin Jax to begin the bottom of the seventh after the Twins rallied for three runs in the top half of the inning; Minnesota tacked on two insurance runs in the eighth and won the three-game series opener.

**Elecame first Twins pitcher to win 10 games in back-to-back seasons since José Berríos and Kyle Gibson both did it from 2018-19.

**Has allowed at least one home run in nine-straight starts (19 HR total), the longest streak of his career and tied with Kenta Maeda (also active streak) for the longest by a Twin this year.

TWO STARTS AGO: Took a no-decision in his return from the 15-day Injured List on August 26 vs. Texas in a 6-2 Twins' defeat...allowed one run on five hits (1 HR) in 5.0 innings pitched, with two walks and seven strikeouts...his lone blemish was a solo homer by former Twin Mitch Garver in the top of the second inning...stranded two runners in scoring position in the second inning, inducing an inning-ending groundout from Leody Taveras...exited after 5.0 innings with the score tied 1-1; Griffin Jax allowed four runs in the ninth and Minnesota fell in the third game of the four-game series.

SEPTEMBER STAR: Making his 12th career start in September today, his most in any month in his career...is 6-2, 2.93 ERA (61.1 IP, 20 ER) with 17 walks, 67 strikeouts and a .160 (34-for-213) opponent batting average in 11 previous September starts...his .160 opponent batting average in September is his best in any month of his career and is the lowest in baseball since 2021 (min. 10 September GS).

RYAN'S LAND: Facing Cleveland for the third time this season and eighth time in his career...is 3-2, 1.83 ERA (44.1 IP, 9 ER) with five walks and 34 strikeouts in seven career starts vs. the Guardians, recording a quality start in six of those seven outings...has suffered the loss in both of his starts against Cleveland this year despite recording two quality starts...lost on May 7 at Cleveland in a 2-0 Twins' defeat (6.0 IP, 8 H, 2 R/ER, 0 BB, 4 K) and lost on June 4 vs. Cleveland in a 2-1 Twins' defeat (6.2 IP, 2 H, 2 R/ER, 1 BB, 4 K)...pitched 6.2 scoreless innings in his last outing against the Guardians before being chased after allowing a two-out walk to José Ramírez and an RBI double to Josh Naylor.

CENTRAL HEATING: In 22 career starts vs. the American League Central, Ryan is 13-3 with a 2.39 ERA (131.2 IP, 35 ER), 25 walks, 140 strikeouts and a .188 (89-for-474) opponent batting average...his 2.39 ERA is his lowest against any division in his career...among pitchers who have started at least 20 games against the AL Central, he owns the lowest opponent batting average and third-lowest ERA (Hisashi lwakuma - 1.99, Pedro Martinez - 2.09) in baseball since the division was formed in 1994.

WRAPPING UP THE ROADTRIP: Making his 13th road start of the season in the finale of the Twins' six-game roadtrip...is 4-4 with a 4.68 ERA (65.1 IP, 34 ER), 14 walks and 72 strikeouts in 12 road starts in 2023...earned his first road win since April 19 at Boston in his last start on September 1 at Texas...has recorded eight quality starts on the road this season, with the Twins going 5-3 in those games (1-3 in his other road starts)...has posted better numbers at home this year, going 6-4, 3.77 ERA (71.2 IP, 30 ER) with 13 walks and 94 strikeouts in 12 starts at Target Field in 2023.

◆ Has allowed two earned runs in 20.2 career innings pitched (0.87 ERA) at Progressive Field.

◆ Is 12-8, 4.20 ERA (141.1 IP, 66 ER) with 33 walks and 148 strikeouts in 26 career road starts...in 30 career home starts, he is 13-9, 3.61 ERA (169.1 IP, 68 ER) with 46 walks and 199 strikeouts.

LEFT OUT: Left-handed hitters are batting just .213 (52-for-244) with a .629 OPS and 64 strikeouts against Ryan this year...his .629 opponent OPS against left-handed hitters is the 12th lowest in the American League this season (min. 20 GS)...right-handed hitters are batting .262 (74-for-282) with a .798 OPS and 102 strikeouts against Ryan in 2023. **◆** Over his career, lefties are batting .203 (113-for-558) with a .630 OPS against him...his .630 career opponent OPS vs. lefties is the 11th lowest in the AL since his debut (min. 250 at-bats)... righties are hitting .237 (144-for-609) with a .727 OPS off Ryan in his career.

THE ARSENAL: Has utilized a four-pitch mix in his first 24 starts of the 2023 season...has leaned on his four-seam fastball and split finger, combining to throw the two pitches 85.1 percent of the time this year...recorded five of his seven strikeouts with his four-seam fastball in his last start on September 1 at Texas...here's a look at Ryan's repertoire, per Baseball Savant:
