THE TWINS: After completing their six-game roadtrip with a record of 4-2 (2-1 at Texas and 2-1 at Cleveland), the Twins began their penultimate homestand of 2023 with a win over the Mets last night...this afternoon, they will play the second of three against the Metropolitan...

STEP RIGHT UP AND BEAT THE METS: The Twins beat the Mets last night at Target Field by a score of 5-2...Dallas Keuchel was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing two runs on three hits in 5.0 innings pitched, including a season-high six strikeouts...

TWINS AND METS: The Twins and Mets are playing each other for the 23rd, 24th and 25th times in their history this weekend...Minnesota is 9-14 all-time vs. the Mets, going 3-3 at Shea Stadium, 3-0 at the Metrodome, 2-6 at Citi Field, 1-5 at Target Field...Twins are just 2-10 vs. the Mets dating back to June of 2010.

THE NL GUYS: The Twins have gone 20-18 in Interleague Play this season, going 1-2 at Miami, 1-2 vs. Washington, 2-1 vs. San Diego, 2-1 vs. Chicago-NL, 1-2 at Los Angeles-NL, 1-2 vs. San Francisco, 2-0 vs. Milwaukee, 0-3 at Atlanta, 2-1 at St. Louis, 3-0 vs. Arizona, 2-1 at Philadelphia, 2-1 vs. Pittsburgh, 0-2 at Milwaukee and 1-0 vs. New York-NL...the Twins have gone 9-4 in their last 13 in IL Play and 13-8 in their last 21.

STARTER STRENGTH: Twins starters have combined to go 41-41, 3.88 ERA (786.0 IP, 339 ER) with 204 walks, 837 strikeouts and a .242 opponent batting average...below are Twins starting pitching ranks among all MLB teams:

SOME LOVE FOR THE LEFTIES: The Twins are 18-15 on the season when facing a lefty starter...below is a comparison of offensive numbers vs. lefties pre-All-Star break and after:

IN their last 13 games vs. left-handed pitching, the Twins have hit .293 (49-for-167) with 12 home runs, a .350 on-base percentage, a .539 slugging percentage and an .889 OPS.

Carlos Correa is hitting .314 (16-for-51) with four doubles, three home runs, 10 RBI, a .397 on-base percentage, a .569 slugging percentage and a .965 OPS in his last 30 games vs. left-handed pitching.

SOLANO SMOKING: Since August 1, Donovan Solano is hitting .372 (35-for-94) with five doubles, one triple, one home run, 13 RBI, a .404 on-base percentage and an .883 OPS in 26 games...in that span he has multiple hits 11 times, including six times in his last 10 games...since August 1, his .372 batting average ranks second best in baseball (minimum of 90 plate appearances), trailing only Mookie Betts (.423).

ROYCE OF SUMMER: After starting the season hitting .182 (6-for-33) with a .576 OPS in his first eight games, Royce Lewis has hit .352 (51-for-145) with six doubles, nine home runs, 34 RBI, a .409 on-base percentage, a .579 slugging percentage and a .988 OPS in his last 39 games...among all MLB rookies with a minimum of 175 plate appearances, Lewis ranks first in batting average (.320), wOBA (.393), OPS (.915), OPS+ (148.9) and slugging percentage (.545).

LAND OF 10,000 RAKES: Since the All-Star break, the Twins have hit 85 home runs, fifth most in baseball, trailing Atlanta (103), Houston (88), Philadelphia (88) and Seattle (86).

SERIES CONVERSATIONS: The Twins are seeking their 23rd series victory this season...they are 22-18-5 in series play in 2023, going 12-7-3 at home and 10-11-2 on the road.

POLANCO UNLOCKED: Jorge Polanco has reached safely in 15 of his last 16 games, hitting .321 (18-for-56) with three doubles, four home runs, 12 RBI, 12 walks, a .435 on-base percentage, a .589 slugging percentage and a 1.024 OPS in that span...additionally, he has driven in 12 runs in his last 12 games, since August 26.

FALL GUY: In seven games since September 1, Carlos Correa has hit .393 (11-for-28) with one double, two home runs, six RBI, two walks, a .452 on-base percentage, a .643 slugging percentage and a 1.094 OPS...last September/October, he hit .355 (44-for-124) with eight doubles, seven home runs, 19 RBI, a .412 on-base percentage, a .589 slugging percentage and a 1.000 OPS in 31 games.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 1976, Rod Carew hit a pinch-hit grand slam in the seventh for the Twins as Minnesota beat Texas, 6-0...it marked Carew's third grand slam of that year...it was the ninth pinch-hit grand slam in Twins history and one of 15 to date...the last to do it was Matt LeCroy on May 19, 2004 at Toronto.

- ☞ Making his 18th start and appearance of 2023, and his eighth home start...also his 187th career appearance and 153rd start.
- ☞ Facing New York-NL for the first time as a Twin and fifth time in his career...is 1-2, 5.25 ERA (12.0 IP, 7 ER) with one save, five walks and seven strikeouts in four previous appearances (2 GS) vs. the Mets.
- ☞ Is in his fourth season with the Twins after being acquired in 2020, along with Jair Camargo, from Los Angeles-NL in exchange for Brusdar Graterol and Luke Raley.

LAST TIME OUT: Took his fourth-consecutive no-decision on September 3 at Texas in a 6-5 Twins' loss at Globe Life Field...allowed three runs on nine hits (1 HR) in 5.0 innings, with two walks and three strikeouts...yielded a three-run home run to former Twin Mitch Garver in the first inning, then fired 4.0 scoreless innings to complete his start...failed to record a 1-2-3 inning but stranded seven runners on base, including two in the first, second and third innings...was relieved by Cole Sands to start the bottom of the sixth with the score tied 3-3; Twins bullpen allowed three earned runs in 3.0-plus innings pitched, and the Rangers won on a walk-off solo homer by Adolis Garcia.

- ☞ Has yielded at least one home run in nine-consecutive starts, the longest streak of his career... tied with Joe Ryan (June 27-September 1) for the longest such streak by a Twin this season.
- ☞ His four-start no-decision streak is tied for his career high as a starter; also took four-straight no-decisions from May 11-June 14, 2021...was handed a decision in 10 of his first 13 starts this season (3-7) before his current streak.

TWO STARTS AGO: Did not factor into the decision on August 28 vs. Cleveland, a 10-6 Twins' win at Target Field...pitched 4.0 innings and allowed six runs on seven hits (1 HR), with one walk and three strikeouts, his lowest single-game strikeout total since April 26 vs. New York-AL (2 K)...pitched a 1-2-3 first inning, then allowed four runs in the second inning on one single, two doubles, one sacrifice fly (Will Brennan) and a two-run home run by Bo Naylor...allowed single runs in the third and fourth innings before being relieved by Kody Funderburk in the top of the fifth with the Twins leading 10-6; Funderburk earned the win in his MLB debut and Josh Winder earned his first career save as Minnesota won the three-game series opener.

- ☞ Snapped his 11-start streak of allowing three-or-fewer runs; was third-longest such streak of his career (18 starts - August 10, 2019-April 14, 2021; 12 starts - July 23-September 27, 2016).

MAEDA VS. METS: Facing New York-NL for the fifth time in his career today...in four previous appearances (2 starts), Maeda is 1-2, 5.25 ERA (12.0 IP, 7 ER) with one save, five walks and seven strikeouts...earned the save in his last appearance vs. the Mets, recording the final two outs in Los Angeles-NL's 3-2 win on September 15, 2019 at Citi Field (1 BB, 1 K)...last started against New York-NL on May 28, 2016 at Citi Field, throwing 5.0 scoreless innings and earning the win in the Dodgers' 9-1 victory (2 H, 2 BB, 3 K)...is 1-1, 3.60 ERA (10.0 IP, 4 ER) with four walks and six strikeouts in two career starts vs. the Mets and 0-1-1, 13.50 ERA (2.0 IP, 3 ER) with one walk and one strikeout in two relief appearances.

SATURDAY TARGET RUN: Making his eighth start at Target Field this season...in his seven prior home starts, Maeda is 2-2, 6.44 ERA (36.1 IP, 26 ER) with seven walks and 38 strikeouts...in his last five home starts, he is 2-0, 3.95 ERA (27.1 IP, 12 ER) with five walks and 33 strikeouts; Twins have gone 4-1 in his last five starts at Target Field...is 7-4, 3.52 ERA (107.1 IP, 42 ER) with 23 walks and 117 strikeouts in 19 home starts since becoming a Twin in 2020...has gone 1-5 with a 3.42 ERA (47.1 IP, 18 ER), 16 walks and 56 strikeouts in 10 road starts in 2023.

- ☞ Is 35-21, 3.31 ERA (410.2 IP, 151 ER) with 103 walks and 453 strikeouts in 86 career home appearances (68 starts)...in 100 career road appearances (84 starts), he is 27-27, 4.57 ERA (435.0 IP, 221 ER) with 140 walks and 475 strikeouts.

THE ARSENAL: Has used a five-pitch mix this year, mostly using his slider, split finger and 4-seam fastball, throwing the trio 89.8 percent of the time...favors his split finger (259/424 - 61.1%) against lefties and mostly uses his slider (276/436 - 63.3%) and sinker (90/90 - 100%) against righties...allowed a single-game season-high four hits off his four-seam fastball in his last start on September 3 at Texas...here's a breakdown of his repertoire:

- ☞ Has averaged 91.4 mph on his four-seam fastball in his last six starts, a 0.8-mpg increase from his four-seam fastball average in his first 11 starts this season (90.6).
- ☞ His 34 strikeouts with his split finger are tied for the seventh most in the AL this year.

NATIONAL NEWS: In four starts vs. National League opponents this year, Maeda is 1-2, 3.00 ERA (21.0 IP, 7 ER) with four walks, 26 strikeouts and a .192 (14-for-73) opponent batting average...took the loss on April 4 at Miami and June 28 at Atlanta, earned the win on August 5 vs. Arizona and took a no-decision on August 23 at Milwaukee...owns a 1.12 WHIP in 127 career appearances (97 starts) vs. the NL, the 15th-best WHIP in baseball since 2016 (min. 500.0 IP).

- ☞ Is 8-9, 4.14 ERA (132.2 IP, 61 ER) with 42 walks and 147 strikeouts in 28 career Interleague appearances (24 starts).
- ☞ In 23 career appearances (20 starts) vs. the NL East, Maeda is 9-7 with a 3.07 ERA (111.1 IP, 38 ER), 28 walks, 113 strikeouts and a .201 (82-for-407) opponent batting average...his 3.07 ERA and .201 opponent batting average vs. the NL East are his best numbers against any division in his career.

JAPANESE RANKS: Maeda is one win away from tying Hisashi Iwakuma for the fifth-most victories by a Japanese-born pitcher in American League/National League history (1901-)...here are his career numbers and how they rank among Japanese-born hurlers in MLB (min. 500.0 IP):

CAREER NOTES

- Missed entire 2022 season recovering from Tommy John surgery on right elbow.
- Finished second in the 2020 American League Cy Young Award voting, accruing 92 total votes (Cleveland's Shane Bieber was the unanimous winner).
- Named Joseph W. Haynes Award winner for Twins Pitcher of the Year in 2020, voted on by the Twin Cities Chapter of the BBWAA...also named the starting pitcher on 2020 All-MLB Second Team.
- Pitched 8.0 no-hit innings on August 18, 2020 vs. MIL before bid was broken up in the ninth...longest no-hit bid of career, and set Twins record with eight-straight K's.
- Is the third Japanese-born player in Twins franchise history, after Micheal Nakamura (2003) and Tsuyoshi Nishioka (2011-12).
- Owns the fifth-most strikeouts in MLB history among Japanese-born pitchers.
- His 16 wins in 2016 were the second-most wins ever by a Los Angeles-NL rookie, behind only Rick Sutcliffe (17-10, 1979), and tied for the second-most ever in a single season by a Japanese pitcher.
- In 2016, led qualifying MLB rookie starting pitchers in starts (32), wins (16), opponents' batting average (.229), WHIP (1.14), innings pitched (175.2) and strikeout-to-walk ratio (3.58).
- Named to the 2016 *Baseball America* Major League All-Rookie Team, and finished third in the NL Rookie of the Year voting.
