Russ Snyder of Baltimore is an old hand at breaking up no-hitters.

The left-handed hitting Orioles outfielder grounded a single to right field as the lead-off batter in the seventh inning to spoil the no-hit bid of the Twins' Dave Boswell at the Met.

"I don't remember ruining any no-hitters in the majors," Russ recalled, "but I can recall ending a no-hitter for Eddie Fisher in the Pacific Coast League."
