Kernels' Lewis enjoys big day at plate

Royce Lewis has thrived since being selected with the No. 1 overall Draft pick last year, and he's noticed that his success comes when he's having fun on the field. If that sentiment holds true, Friday's doubleheader at Community Field must have been a heck of a time.

The top Twins prospect collected five hits, including four doubles, scored three times and drove in a pair of runs as Class A Cedar Rapids swept a twinbill from Burlington.

"I'm always looking to play in every game, whether it's two in one day, three in one day or one each and every day," Lewis said. "I'm just looking forward to playing at a high level each and every day and working as hard as I can. And today just happened to be a good one."

During the Kernels' 7-4 win in the opener, MLB.com's No. 12 overall prospect went 2-for-2 with four productive plate appearances. He extended Cedar Rapids' lead to 2-0 before an out was recorded on a first-inning sacrifice fly to right field.

Lewis picked up another RBI with one out in the second, bouncing a single through the right side, and walked to start the fourth before scoring on Robby Rinn's double to right. His first double of the day came with one out in the sixth on a fly ball to center, and he came home again when second baseman Julio Garcia misplayed a grounder off the bat of Jose Miranda.

"Same approach as usual ... just get a pitch I can drive like I normally do," Lewis said. "Just had some pitches up today and I was able to connect multiple times and it was a lot of fun for me."

The three doubles during the Kernels' 6-3 victory in the nightcap were a career high for the Aliso Viejo, California, native. He flied to center fielder Torii Hunter Jr. in his first at-bat but went to right, center and left for each of his extra-base hits in the third, fifth and seventh innings, respectively.

The performance boosted his average to .314, which is second behind Bowling Green's Taylor Walls (.332) among active players in the Midwest League.

Lewis has played both games in all but two of Cedar Rapids' seven doubleheaders. He's on pace to bat over .300 in each of his first four months on the Class A circuit and has recorded multiple hits in 24 of 62 games this season. He's also hit safely in 12 of his last 13 games.

"Just keeping your mindset, your goals, in place and just working as hard as you can and having as much fun as possible for me," the 19-year-old said. "I know, for sure, when I have fun the game just comes a lot easier, no matter how I'm feeling that day or if I'm tired or I'm super-amped and energized."

Listed at 6-foot-2, 188 pounds before the season, Lewis said he believes he's recently finished growing physically and that he's gotten used to moving with his new body while following the same approach that's made him a successful professional.

"I was definitely built for this game and playing all year round," he said. "It's definitely a grind, but I love this grind and, obviously, the numbers show how much I love this game."

Twins No. 10 prospect Akil Baddoo also collected five hits in the doubleheader, including a double in the opener and his eighth homer of the season in the nightcap. Jordan Gore contributed a pair of singles in each game.

After his goodbye blast in 2008, Garrett Jones says hello to Red Wings Hall of Fame

During four seasons playing for the Rochester Red Wings, first baseman/outfielder Garrett Jones hit a lot of home runs.

Eighty-one, to be exact.

That places the Illinois-born slugger, one of baseball's all-time good guys, seventh on the club's all-time list. That's saying something, considering the Red Wings have been around for 133 years.

Jones' most memorable blast? That's easy.

"My best one was my last one," said Jones of his walk-off, three-run homer in the bottom of the ninth on Sept. 1, 2008 in the season finale at Frontier Field, his round-tripper beating the Buffalo Bisons 9-6. "It literally was my last at-bat as a Red Wing, a positive way to end a good career in Rochester for sure."

Not a "good" career. Try a legendary one.

The ever-popular Jones, who led Rochester to the 2006 Governors' Cup championship series, will be inducted into the Red Wings Hall of Fame along with early 1900s star Joe "Poison" Brown before Saturday's game against Lehigh Valley. First pitch is 7:05 p.m.

He'll want to take in all the sights, sounds — and smells — of a place he fondly called his "home away from home."

"Rochester was a second family for me," Jones said. "The Silvers made it real comfortable to play there and I just enjoyed coming to the ballpark every day.

"It's a great park to play in, you get an old-school feel," Jones went on. "It's not one of the smaller parks around, you don't get too many cheapies there, but it wasn't a graveyard by any stretch. I loved playing there. You always got the hops smell from the (Genesee) brewery. One of my strong senses is smell, and I can remember that and all the good crowds. I just remember it being a good baseball town."

Made more enjoyable playing for the fun-loving Cliburn brothers, Stan and Stu.

"I swear they could talk to each other telepathically," Jones said. "They were fun guys, just great 'players' coaches."

While Red Wings fans recall Jones as one of the team's great power hitters and leaders — he never complained about being "stuck" in the minors and always had time for people — Twins fans recall him as "the one that got away."

Despite his tremendous production over three seasons and a 31-game call-up in 2007 (he hit just .208 but collected 16 hits), Jones was placed on waivers during 2008 spring training.

When he wasn't claimed, he came back to Rochester for a fourth season and let his bat do his talking.

He pounded out 147 hits, 23 home runs and 92 RBI, sending a goodbye kiss to Twins management with his final at-bat heroics that fine September day before 11,000 fans.

Jones became a free agent, signed with Pittsburgh, and launched a seven-year major league career that saw him hit 120 homers with 335 RBI for the Pirates, Marlins and Yankees.

"If you have to go out, I guess that's the way to go out," said Jones of his Roy Hobbs' moment.

"You couldn't script it better," Stan Cliburn said. "It was fate."

Jones' flare for the dramatic carried on in Pittsburgh.

In 2009, he was called up from Indianapolis July 1 and made a run at National League Rookie of the Year, hitting 10 homers in his first month and 21 total.

During his five-year Pittsburgh career (100 homers, 325 RBI), Jones hit the 10,000th home run in Pirates' history and on June 2, 2013, became the first Pirate to hit a home run on the fly out of then 13-year-old PNC Park and into the Allegheny River. That shot measured 440 feet.

"I'll never forget the sound and feel of that one for sure," Jones said.

Nor will he forget the years of working and dreaming. Rookie ball. Single A, AA, AAA. The Arizona Fall League. The Venezuela Winter League.

The years when he paid his dues, a journey that began at age 18 as a 14th-round draft pick of the Atlanta Braves.

Jones, 37, who most recently played in Japan and whose bat is still for hire, wasn't just blessed with a sweet swing. He was blessed with perseverance.

“I mean, that’s the thing,” he said. “I played with guys who never got an opportunity, you have to hope someone sees you, whether it’s your team or another team that will want you. And I enjoyed playing the game, that was the main thing. Triple-A, wherever, I enjoyed competing, that wasn’t an issue.

“As you get older, financially you want to have a family and a good career, especially when you come out of high school without a college degree. You get nervous. But I stayed focused and had great family support and coaches who believed in me. They kept my confidence up and I kept plugging along.”

The hottest team in the Midwest League came into Community Field and didn’t cool off on a steamy night.

Cedar Rapids pushed its second-half record to 8-1 with a doubleheader sweep of the Burlington Bees on Friday night.

The Kernels took the first game 7-4, and the second game 6-3.

The Bees fell to 1-8 to start the second half.

But the Kernels added a run in the sixth when Royce Lewis doubled and scored on an error.

Bailey Ober (4-1) was the winning pitcher, with Melvi Acosta getting his second save.

Cedar Rapids kept the offense going in the second game. Akil Baddoo, who led off the first game with a double, led off the second game with a home run off Bees starter Luis Madero on the first pitch of the game.
