TOUGH-LUCK JAKE

On Monday night against the San Diego Padres at Citi Field, New York Mets ace Jacob deGrom posted his 20th start of the season, tossing 8.0 innings of two-run ball with 10 strikeouts. It was his third consecutive start, dating back to July 6th, in which he logged at least 8.0 innings with seven-or-more strikeouts while not permitting more than five hits. The 30-year-old is the first Major League hurler to post such a streak this season, and the first since Los Angeles Dodgers ace Clayton Kershaw (May 12-23, 2016).



deGrom, who was drafted by the Mets in the ninth round of the 2010 MLB Draft, enters play today with a 5-5 record to go along with 159 strikeouts, 35 walks, 95 hits allowed and a 1.71 ERA across over 131.1 innings pitched. According to the Elias Sports Bureau, the two-time NL All-Star is the first pitcher since at least 1912 to win fewer than seven games in his first 20 starts of a season with an ERA below 2.00.

In addition, the terrific outing on Monday was his 13th of the season in which he tossed at least 7.0 innings with seven punchouts, while not allowing more than three walks and seven hits. Since 1908, deGrom, who is expected to make his next start for the Mets on Saturday against the Pittsburgh Pirates, became just the fifth hurler since 1908 to post 13 such outings over his Club's first 97 games of a season, joining Hall of Famers Sandy Koufax (1965), Pedro Martinez (2000) and Randy Johnson (1999-2000, 2002), as well as Curt Schilling (2002). Below is a table illustrating each starter's cumulative statistics from their dominant outings. Each of the players listed below were awarded a Cy Young Award in that season, except for Schilling, who finished second in the 2002 NL Cy Young Award vote to his rotation-mate Johnson.

MORE HISTORY FOR TROUT

In Monday night's tilt against the Chicago White Sox, All-Star outfielder Mike Trout of the Los Angeles Angels made five plate appearances without recording an official at-bat, and logged an RBI, four walks and two stolen bases. The two-time MVP became the fifth player in the Majors this season to make at least two plate appearances, not record an at-bat and drive in at least one run, joining David Bote (July 1st) and Chris Gimenez (June 15th) of the Chicago Cubs, Zack Cozart (May 20th) of the Los Angeles Angels and Chance Sisco (April 28th) of the Baltimore Orioles.



Additionally, the 25th overall selection in the 2009 MLB Draft became just the fourth different player in Major League history (fifth time overall) to not tally a plate appearance, draw four walks and notch two stolen bases, joining Hall of Famer Rickey Henderson (1989, 2000), Dusty Baker (1974) and Burt Shotton (1915). Trout is joined by Baker as the only players in history to plate a run, as well. The table below depicts the five stat lines for each player's unique game.

The 26-year-old slugger became the first player in franchise history to record four walks in three games during a single season (also: May 1st and May 12th). Receiving a pair of free passes in the following game, Trout had posted 93 walks across the Angels' first 102 game of the 2018 campaign. Since 1940, his 93 walks were tied for 21st-most in the Majors over his Club's first 102 contests, and were the most since Barry Bonds posted 145 walks across San Francisco's first 102 games during his MVP Award-winning 2004 season.

Trout, who paces the Majors in walks and on-base percentage, enters play today with a .311/.460/.621 slash line and is the only player in Major League Baseball with at least 28 home runs and 80 walks on the season. In addition, Mike is on pace to become the eighth player since 1871, and the first since 1911, to slash at least .310/.450/.620 with 19-or-more stolen bases in a single season. He would become the first slugger in MLB history to also club at least 28 home runs.

A+ COMEBACK

On Tuesday against the Texas Rangers at Globe Life Park, the Oakland Athletics trailed 10-2 after the sixth inning before ultimately winning by a score of 13-10. According to the Elias Sports Bureau, the last game in which a Club won after trailing by eight runs entering the seventh inning was when the New York Yankees defeated the Boston Red Sox 15-9, after trailing 9-1, on April 21, 2012. Across the Majors, teams had won 1,684 consecutive games when owning such a lead in the seventh inning-or-later.

Before the game, the Rangers were a perfect 471-0 when leading by at least eight runs in the seventh inning-or-later in franchise history, and 429-0 since moving to Texas. Entering action on Wednesday, the San Francisco Giants owned the longest streak in the Majors, spanning 1,342 games since June 2, 1883, when they were known as the New York Gothams. Below is a table detailing each Club's win streak when leading by at least eight runs in the seventh inning-or-later, per Elias.

HISTORY OF THE TRADE DEADLINE

The non-waiver Major League trading deadline has been July 31st since the 1986 season (with the exception of August 1st in 2016).

Prior to 1986, the non-waiver deadline for trades within each League was June 15th and there were also distinctions between when intraleague and interleague trades could be made. Waivers were necessary at all times for interleague trades, with the exception of two non-waiver interleague trading periods: February 15th – April 1st and five days after conclusion of World Series – the day before the last scheduled day of the Winter Meetings.

The first appearance of a trade deadline in the Major Leagues came when the National League established a deadline of August 20th in 1917. After that date, a player had to clear NL waivers before being traded. The American League followed suit in 1920, but with a deadline of July 1st. The following year, both the AL and NL agreed on a deadline of August 1st. On December 14, 1922, the deadline was changed to June 15th after gaining approval at the Joint Major League meetings held at the Hotel Commodore in New York. It would stay June 15th until after the 1985 season.

In 1953, the interleague trading rules were amended as to require waivers between June 15th and the conclusion of the championship season. The first non-waiver interleague trading period was created for the 1959 off-season and it was from November 21st – December 15th. In 1970, the start of the period was moved to begin five days after the World Series instead of November 21st. Seven years later, a second non-waiver interleague trading period was created, February 15th – March 15th. In 1981, that period was extended through April 1st and was in effect until all distinctions between interleague and intraleague trading were abolished prior to the 1986 season.

They Said It, and How! **(by MLB Official Historian John Thorn)**

Two weeks ago, the Dodgers. Last week, the Giants. Much as it pains me as a Brooklyn fan who lived through the glory days of baseball in New York, 1947–1957, this week I'll offer a tribute to the Yankees.

Give them their due: they won nine pennants in the eleven years of The Era, the last eight of them under Casey Stengel (right). He went on to capture two more, in 1958 and 1960, before management discovered that he was seventy years old (a birthday now in my own rear-view mirror). "I won't make that mistake again," Casey said in his final press conference with the Yankees.



RED SMITH: "Rooting for the New York Yankees is like rooting for U.S. Steel."

DORIS KEARNS GOODWIN: "On afternoons when both the Dodgers and the Yankees were playing an afternoon game, we set our dueling radios on opposite sides of the blanket, the warm voice of Red Barber issuing from one end of the blanket, the harsh, tinny voice of Mel Allen from the other."

SHIRLEY POVICH: "The million-to-one shot came in. Hell froze over. A month of Sundays hit the calendar. Don Larsen today pitched a no-hit, no run, no-man-reach-first game in a World Series.

"On the mound at Yankee Stadium, the same guy who was knocked out in two innings by the Dodgers on Friday came up today with one for the record books, posting it there in solo grandeur as the only Perfect Game in World Series history."

PHIL RIZZUTO: "I was born in Brooklyn and I always rooted for the Dodgers. I had a tryout with the Dodgers in 1937. Casey Stengel was managing. He took one look at me and he said 'Listen kid, you better go and get yourself a shoeshine box. That is the only way you'll make a living.' I was crushed. And then the Yankees called me up and they had a one-week tryout camp. It's a good thing I knew how to bunt and steal, although I did hit one in the seats."



WHITEY FORD: "You would be amazed how many important outs you can get by working the count down to where the hitter is sure you're going to throw to his weakness and then throw to his power instead."

ELSTON HOWARD: "The only time wise guys were a personal trouble to me was traveling around the South in exhibition games when the rest of the club would go one way and I'd have to go to the other side of town to a colored hotel."

RON HERSHKOWITZ: "In 1952, we moved to a New York City housing project, five subway stops from Yankee Stadium. It was heaven. I lived the Yankees. I went to my first baseball game in 1950 with my father in my full Yankee uniform! I relished each World Series win during the '50s. When they lost to the Dodgers in 1955, I cried for two days. It was not supposed to happen."

CARL ERSKINE: "When the [World Series] games were in Yankee Stadium, the Dodgers provided two luxury buses—one for the team and one for the families. We would leave Ebbets Field to the cheers and hoopla of Dodger fans lining the streets as we passed. The police escort, with sirens blaring, announced to the world, 'Here come the Dodgers.' Soon we crossed the Brooklyn Bridge into lower Manhattan. The crowds thinned out a bit and were quite orderly, with fans just waving and smiling. Then we entered the Bronx—Yankee land. Now came the jeers, insulting signs, and a barrage of tomatoes, toilet paper, and eggs splattering the buses. The return trip held more of the same. We all knew what the Yankee buses were in for when the games moved to Ebbets Field. The war zone started when the Yankees crossed the Brooklyn Bridge."

JERRY COLEMAN: "People watched the Yankees and admired the pride of the Yankees, but unfortunately, they became so successful, people hated them for their success."

HIRO'S WELCOME: Yankees starting pitcher Masahiro Tanaka tossed a three-hit shutout on Tuesday at Tampa Bay, allowing only one walk and striking out nine. His 29 batters faced were tied for the fewest by a Yankee in a nine-inning complete game since 2002.

BEAST MODE IN FULL EFFECT: Despite going 0-for-1 in his lone at bat as a pinch-hitter on Tuesday night, Dodger All-Star outfielder Matt Kemp shows no signs of slowing down in the second-half of the season. Kemp, who has collected three multi-hit games in his last five contests, has gone 8-for-20 (.400) with five runs, one double, two home runs and four RBI in five games following the All-Star break.

GONE STREAKIN': Padres outfielder Manuel Margot is riding a seven-game hitting streak (longest active streak on the team), batting .456 (10-for-22) with two doubles and a triple. He also owns a nine-game hitting streak against the Mets since July 24, 2017 (19-for-36, .528). Margot has eight multi-hit games in those nine games.

REACHING ROOKIE RECORDS: Toronto Blue Jays rookie infielder Lourdes Gurriel Jr. singled twice on Tuesday, and tallied a single and a double on Wednesday to extend his multi-hit streak to eight games, surpassing Al Woods (1977) for the longest such streak all-time by a Blue Jays rookie.

ELECTRIC EDDIE: Mariners closer Edwin Díaz leads the Majors with 37 saves, while ranking second among all relievers with 85 strikeouts, trailing Milwaukee's Josh Hader (94). Of Díaz's 37 saves, 20 have come in 1-run games, which is the most in Major League Baseball.

PILING UP CROOKED NUMBERS: White Sox middle infielder Yoán Moncada has recorded 19 doubles, five triples, 13 home runs and 42 RBI in 92 games this season. He joins Javier Báez, Cody Bellinger, Andrew Benintendi, Corey Dickerson, Teoscar Hernández, Trevor Story and Chris Taylor as the only players in Major League Baseball to record at least 15 doubles, five triples, 10 homers and 40 RBI this season.

EXTRA! EXTRA!: Tuesday's 10th-inning rally by the Astros marked their most runs scored in an extra-inning (6) since scoring seven runs in the 10th inning on May 7, 2000 against the Dodgers. The Astros have won each of their last four extra-inning games.

DYNAMIC DUO: Indians infielder José Ramírez continues to lead Major League Baseball with 60 extra-base hits this season. His double-play mate Francisco Lindor ranks second in the Majors, collecting his 59th of the season with a double yesterday. The pair's 119 combined extra-base hits are the second-most by a duo in franchise history through 100 team games.

DEXTER INNING HOMERS: St. Louis outfielder Dexter Fowler provided the winning runs on Tuesday with his 2-run homer in the 11th inning, his second game-winning blast of the season in extra frames. Fowler has hit four of his eight home runs this season against the Reds, and for his career, has hit 12 round-trippers against the Redlegs, his most against any team.

ALWAYS BEST TO DO YOUR STREAKING ON THE ROAD: Diamondbacks first baseman Paul Goldschmidt owns a 25-game on-base streak on the road, the third longest active streak in the Majors behind Rangers outfielder/designated hitter Shin-Soo Choo (29) and Astros infielder Alex Bregman (28).

REACHING GAME 1,000: Cubs first baseman Anthony Rizzo is one game away from 1,000 career contests since making his Major League debut with the Padres in 2011. Rizzo is 18 hits away from 1,000 for his career and just one RBI from reaching 600. His 177 homers with Chicago rank 13th in franchise history behind Derrek Lee with 179 home runs.

RAKE BAUERS: Rays utility player Jake Bauers has 38 hits this season and 23 have gone for extra bases (60.5 pct.), the second-highest rate in the Majors behind Joey Gallo (62.9 pct.) of the Rangers.

THE ALL-STAR SHUTS THEM DOWN: The Twins beat the Blue Jays on Tuesday at Rogers Centre by a score of 5-0, their seventh shutout of an opponent this season. It was the fourth started by José Berríos, as the All-Star pitched 7.0 innings with four hits allowed, one walk and nine strikeouts.

EXTRA! EXTRA! Among all National League outfielders, Pittsburgh's Gregory Polanco ranks first with 43 extra-base hits, while Corey Dickerson is second with 41. Starling Marte is tied for eighth with 36.

JOSÉ BAUTISTA: Mets outfielder José Bautista slugged his 339th career homer yesterday, tying him for 99th on Major League Baseball's all-time home run list with Dave Parker, Boog Powell and Tino Martinez.

REMEMBER THE FIGHTINS: The Phillies have won 16 of 24 games and have posted a 25-14 record since June 10th. At 57-44 with a .564 winning percentage on the season, the Phils currently sport a 1.5 game lead over the Atlanta Braves (54-44, .551) in the National League East and their .564 winning percentage ranks second in the National League, trailing only the Cubs (.584).

CARRYING THE TORCH: Orioles second baseman Jonathan Schoop is hitting .367 (29-for-79) in 20 games in July. His 29 hits rank second-most in the Majors in July. Schoop homered for the fourth time since the All-Star break on Tuesday, and has six home runs this month, tied for third-most in the AL during the month. He hit the 100th home run of his career last Friday night at Toronto.

BOSTON'S BEST: The Red Sox' 71 wins are their most-ever through 103 games (previous: 70 in 1912 and 1946). The Red Sox are one of 24 teams since 1900 to win at least 71 of their first 103 games. The last American League Club to do so was the Mariners in 2001.

WHIT MERRIFIELD: The Royals infielder tripled in the ninth inning of Wednesday's game, and has reached safely in 21 of his last 22 games, posting a slash line of .367/.414/.511 (33-for-90). He's batting .329/.345/.527 (55-for-167) in 41 career games vs. Detroit, including a hit in 18 of his last 20 games since last July 25th, in which he has 19 runs.

V-MART GOES DEEP: Victor Martinez belted his fifth home run of the season on Tuesday, a three-run shot in the seventh inning off of Tim Hill. The homer was Martinez's first since May 19th at Seattle. Martinez now has 242 home runs in his career, which are the most among active switch hitters, 41 more than Kendrys Morales.

DOUBLES: The Braves hit six doubles on Monday, and another on Tuesday, giving them a National League-best 208 two-base hits this season. They trail only Boston (220) and Minnesota (212) for the Major League lead. The franchise record is 328 by the 2007 club; the 2018 team is on pace for 346.
