Reardon arrested as armed robbery suspect

Former Twins pitcher **Jeff Reardon** was arrested in Florida on Monday on suspicion of committing armed robbery.

A news release from the Palm Beach Gardens police department said a 50-year-old man who police identified as Reardon entered a jewelry store and handed a clerk a note saying he had a gun and demanding money. The clerk filled a bag with an undisclosed amount of cash.

The man left the store with the cash and was followed by the store manager. Police were called, and they arrested Reardon without incident outside a restaurant. The money was recovered.

Reardon played for the Twins (including their 1987 World Series championship team), Expos, Red Sox, Reds and Yankees.
