THE TWINS: After completing their seven-game roadtrip with a record of 4-3 (2-0 in Kansas City, 1-2 in Philadelphia and 1-1 in New York-NL), the Twins began their six-game homestand with a two-game sweep over the Tigers this past weekend...today they will play the first of four games with Toronto at Target Field.

TALKING TIGER ON A SUNDAY: The Twins beat the Tigers yesterday afternoon by a score of 6-4 sweeping an opponent for the second time this season...José Berríos (2-1) was the starter and winner, allowing two runs on four hits in 6.2 innings pitched with one walk and seven strikeouts...Trevor Hildenberger left the bases loaded in the ninth inning, striking out his only two batters faced to earn his first save of the season...the offense recorded 14 hits, seven going for extra-base hits, including homers from C.J. Cron and Eddie Rosario.

TWINS-JAYS: The Twins are playing the first of seven games vs. the Blue Jays this season... they will travel to Canada for three at Rogers Centre May 6-8...the Twins went 4-2 vs. the Jays in 2018, going 1-2 at Target Field from April 30-May 2 and 3-0 at Rogers Centre from July 23-25...the Twins have gone just 22-39 vs. the Jays since 2010, for a winning percentage of .361, their second lowest vs. any AL opponent since then (New York - .311).
क Eddie Rosario is hitting .381 (16-for-42) with five home runs, seven RBI, eight runs scored and a 1.184 OPS in his last 10 games vs. the Blue Jays.
क Byron Buxton is hitting . 483 (14-for-29) with five home runs, 10 RBI and a 1.566 OPS in seven career games vs. the Jays...he hit three home runs at Rogers Centre August 27, 2017. $\Phi$ Nelson Cruz is hitting . 300 ( 102 -for-340) with 18 doubles, 25 home runs, 86 RBl and a .943 OPS in 91 career games vs. Toronto.

HIP HIP JORGE: Jorge Polanco is hitting . 383 ( 18 -for-47) with three doubles, three triples, two home runs, four RBI and a 1.125 OPS in 12 games this season....he leads all shortstops in baseball in OPS and ranks third in batting average...in fact, since September 5, 2018 he is hitting .347 ( 50 -for-144) with a 395 on-base percentage in 35 games.

THE BUCK STARTS HERE: Byron Buxton has hit safely in eight of 11 games this season, hitting . 324 (11-for-34) with six doubles, one triple, five RBI and a . 937 OPS.... he leads the team in doubles and is one of nine players in the AL with at least six doubles this season.

A HARD KNOCK LIFE: The Twins crushed the ball all over the yard in yesterday's $6-4$ win over the Tigers as they connected for 11 balls hit over 100.0 MPH , already their second game this season with $10+$ hits over 100.0 MPH ( 13 on March 31 vs . CLE)...in 2018, the Twins only notched four games of $10+100$ MPH hits, ( 10 on April 4 at PIT, 10 on April 7 vs. SEA, 10 on June 5 vs. CWS and 13 on Sept. 16 at KC)....as a group in 2019, they have registered 76 balls hit over 100 MPH with Max Kepler (12) and Byron Buxton (10) leading the way...C.J. Cron registered the Twins hardest hit ball of 2019 yesterday with a two-run, 113.5 MPH shot to lefffield off Jordan Zimmermann.

MINNESOTA WINS: The Twins have gone 19-7 in their last 26 games, dating back to September 16, giving them a winning percentage of .731, the best in baseball...during that time, they are 6-2-1 in series play...in that span, they rank first in baseball in batting average (.287), second in OBP (.356) and OPS (.824), and fourth in runs-per-game (5.96).

DO YOU SMELL WHAT THE ROC' IS COOKIN'?: Rocco Baldelli became the 14th manager of the Twins on October 25 after spending parts of six years with the Tampa Bay Rays as a player and splitting eight seasons between their front office and coaching staff, most recently as their Major League Field Coordinator...he and Blue Jays Manager Charlie Montoyo coached for the Rays from 2015-18.

GET HERE EARLY: During the months of April, May (prior to Memorial Day) and September, the Twins have moved weekday (Monday-Thursday) night games to a 6:40 pm start...the Twins traditionally would have started home night games during the week at 7:10 pm.

JACKIE ROBINSON DAY: As has been tradition each April 15th since 2004, the Twins will join all of Major League Baseball in commemorating Jackie Robinson Day...all players will again wear the iconic Number ' 42 ' to honor the anniversary of Robinson's historic debut, while the Twins' centennial celebration of Robinson's birth will also feature several on-field elements:
$\Phi$ Through the club's "Reading is Powerful" program, the Twins are inviting select kids, nominated by their teachers as embodying Jackie Robinson's Nine Values, to take part in on-field ceremonies and be recognized during the game. क St. Paul Mayor Melvin Carter - the city's first African-American mayor - will throw out the ceremonial first pitch. $\Phi$ The varsity baseball teams from north Minneapolis' Patrick Henry High School and North Community High School will stand on the field with their major league counterparts during the playing of the Star-Spangled Banner.

BACK TO THE START: Pérez is making his first start of the 2019 campaign tonight in the series opener against the Toronto Blue Jays after beginning the season in the bullpen due to a Major League-high five off-days through April 11...made three relief appearances, pitched to a 7.56 ERA ( $8.2 \mathrm{IP}, 7 \mathrm{ER}$ ) on 11 hits, nine walks and 12 strikeouts...recorded the win in relief March 31 vs. CLE (his Twins debut) after allowing three runs over 3.2 IP in relief of starter Michael Pineda in a pre-arranged outing for the duo.

ON JACKIE ROBINSON DAY: April 15 is an annual celebration of American history as a remembrance of the day that Jackie Robinson made his big league debut for the Brooklyn Dodgers in 1947 against the Boston Braves, officially breaking the color barrier in Major League Baseball...since his debut in 2012, Pérez has made just one start on Jackie Robinson Day, coming in 2016 against Baltimore, tossing 6.0 innings of three-run ball, striking out six in a no-decision.

AGAINST TORONTO: In four starts against our brethren from the North, Pérez owns a 3.38 ERA (21.1 IP, 8 ER )...as the "home" starter, he boasts a career line of 1-1, 2.92 ERA (12.1 IP, 4 ER), with his last home start against the Blue Jays coming on June 22, 2017, as a member of the Texas Rangers....he faced the Jays once last season, allowing four runs on a career-high tying three home runs over 4.0 innings pitched, April 29 at Rogers Centre.

APRIL SHOWERS: Pérez has allowed 71 ER in 131.1 IP (4.87 ERA) and owns an 8-10 record in April games over the course of his career... 24 of those runs came last season as Pérez struggled to a 2-3 record and a 9.67 ERA (24 ER in 22.1 IP), raising his career ERA in April by more than a full run....has already surrendered seven earned runs this April.

CABALLO ZURDO: Pérez has thrown 477.1 innings since the beginning of 2016, ranking him seventh among left-handed pitchers in the American League. Below is a list of AL lefties with at least 475.0 IP since 2016:

CHANGING THINGS UP: According to Inside Edge, opponents had a groundball rate of 67.3 percent (37/55) against Pérez's changeup in 2018, the highest in Major League Baseball (min. 80.0 IP ).

- Led the Rangers in wins (13-career high), starts (32) and innings (185.0) in 2017, while setting a career-best in strikeouts (115).
- His career-high 198.2 IP in 2016 were the sixth-most by a Texas pitcher age 25-or-younger and the most since José Guzmán in 1988.
- Went $10-6$ with a 3.62 ERA ( 50 ER in 124.1 IP) in 2013, ranking tied for first among American League rookies in wins, second in ERA and third in both starts (20) and quality starts (11).
- Was named Rangers Nolan Ryan Minor League Pitcher of the Year after combining to go 6-8,
2.90 ERA (37 ER in 114.2 IP) with 119 strikeouts in 27 games (19 starts).
- Entered 2008 as the youngest player in the Northwest League and was rated by Baseball America as the second-best prospect in the NWL, fifth-best in the Rangers' organization.

Gibson will be making his third start of the season tomorrow evening in the second game of this four-game set against Toronto...in his last start, Gibson could not qualify for the victory after throwing only 4.2 IP, allowing three runs on six hits at New York-NL...this will be his eighth career start against the Blue Jays after making one start last year here on May 1, allowing two runs over 5.0 innings pitched...owns a career record of $3-1$ with a 4.79 ERA (41.1 IP, 22 ER) with 19 walks and 33 strikeouts against the Northerners, and is looking for his first win against the Jays since September 17, 2017.... has a lifetime ERA of 5.02 ( $217.0 \mathrm{IP}, 121 \mathrm{ER}$ ) in 38 starts against the American League East.
