THE TWINS: The Twins have gone 2-2 through four games on their current homestand going THE TWINS: The Twins have gone 2-2 through four games on their current homestand, going
2-0 vs. Detroit and 0-2 vs. Toronto...tonight the Twins will play the third of four games with Toronto...following tomorrow afternoon's game, the Twins will travel to Baltimore for three vs. the Orioles over the weekend, followed by three in Houston from Monday-Wednesday.

NO CANADA: The Twins lost to the Blue Jays last night by a score of 6-5, dropping consecutive games for the first time this season...Kyle Gibson made his third start of the season, allowing four runs on four hits in 5.1 innings pitched...Trevor May was issued the loss, allowing two runs in the seventh inning...the offense recorded six hits, three being home runs from Jorge Polanco, Eddie Rosario and Marwin Gonzalez.

TWINS-JAYS: The Twins are playing the third of seven games vs. the Blue Jays this season... they will travel to Canada for three at Rogers Centre May 6-8...the Twins have gone just 22-41 vs. the Jays since 2010, for a winning percentage of . 349 , their second lowest vs. any AL opponent since then (New York - .311).
क Eddie Rosario is hitting . 347 (17-for-49) with six home runs, 10 RBI, 10 runs scored and a 1.131 OPS in his last 12 games vs. the Blue Jays.
玉 Byron Buxton is hitting . 417 (15-for-36) with five home runs, 10 RBI and a 1.364 OPS in nine career games vs. the Jays.
क Twins have hit at least one home run vs. the Jays in 14 straight games (since August 26, 2017), their longest active streak vs. an opponent, next being Baltimore (6)...they have homered 25 times in those 14.
历 Nelson Cruz has a .579 slugging percentage in 91 career games against the Blue Jays... that mark ranks fourth all-time among players with at least 300 plate appearances against Toronto, trailing only Ken Griffey Jr. (.600), Jose Canseco (.595) and Albert Belle (.593).

HIP HIP JORGE!: Jorge Polanco is hitting . 415 (22-for-53) with three doubles, three triples, three home runs, five RBI and a 1.221 OPS in 14 games this season...in fact, since September 5,2018 he is hitting .360 (54-for-150) with a .412 on-base percentage in 36 games...below are the AL leaders in a few categories this season:

FOR STARTERS: Twins starters have combined to post a 4.00 ERA (74.1 IP, 33 ER) with a WHIP of 1.12 and an opponent batting average of .213...both their WHIP and BAA rank fourth in all of baseball...additionally, Twins starters have held opponents to three-runs-or fewer in 11 of 14 starts.

MAD MAX: Max Kepler went 0 -for-2 with two walks last night, snapping his hitting streak at

a career-high 10 games...however, he extended his on-base streak to 11 , tied for third longest of his career, his longest being 19 done July 5-27, 2018...during the current streak, he is hitting . 304 (14-for-46) with a .385 on-base percentage.

HOMER HAPPY: The Twins have hit 20 home runs so far through 14 games, their most in club history through their first 14 ...the next most came last season when they hit 18 ...their most in club history through 15 is 23 , done in 1964 ...they rank tied for 19 th in baseball in homers, the leader being Seattle with 42.

JUMP ON 'EM EARLY: The Twins have seen 3.66 pitches-per-plate appearance this season, the lowest ratio in baseball; the highest in baseball is Washington at 4.14...they have also seen the lowest number of pitches at 1,938, the next closest being Cincinnati with 2,164...Jonathan Schoop leads the Twins and ranks ninth in baseball in fewest pitches-per-PA with 3.29...the next five are: Byron Buxton (3.44), Max Kepler (3.50), Eddie Rosario (3.76), Marwin Gonzalez (3.78) and Jason Castro (3.82).
$\Phi$ The Twins have struck out 103 times this season, only the Angels (97) have struck out fewer.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2018, the Twins played host to the Indians in San Juan, Puerto Rico at Hiram Birthorn Stadium...the Twins lost by a score of 6-1...Jake Odorizzi was the starter and loser, allowing four runs in 5.0 innings pitched, including a home run to Puerto Rico native Francisco Lindor...the game was played in front of 19,516 fans.

$\Phi$ Jake Odorizzi has not allowed a hit to any of the last 29 batters he's faced after reaching two strikes. -- Domingo Germán has the longest active streak at 30
$\Phi$ Willians Astudillo has not struck out in his last 100 PA's against a RHP dating back to June 30, 2018 -- this is the longest active streak $\Phi 15.9 \%$ of Twins's hitters plate appearances have lasted only one pitch ( $83 / 521$ PAs) this season -- highest in MLB; League Avg: $10.7 \%$. $\Phi$ Jorge Polanco is batting .543 (19-for-35) with the bases empty this season -- best in MLB; League Avg: . 248

## JAKE ODORIZZI

- He is making his fourth start and appearance of the season.
- He is making his 162nd career start and 165th career appearance.


VERY GOOD, THEN...: Odorizzi's last start, a week ago tonight at New York-NL, was a microcosm of his brief season-to-date...Odo yielded only a walk through 4.0-hitless innings, taking a 1-0 lead over Noah Syndergaard into the fifth; then, after a one-out single snapped the no-hit bid, the wheels fell off...he walked three straight hitters (including Syndergaard to re-load the bases with two outs after a runner was thrown out trying to advance on a would-be wild pitch) and departed....Mets ended up scoring six times in the frame en route to a 9-6 win.

- As noted, Odorizzi's start at Citi Field in many ways mirrored his 2019 thus far... his first start of the season was a gem, as he matched his career high with 11 strikeouts during 6.0 innings of one-hit, one-run ball on March 30 vs. Cleveland.
- However, his second start came April 5 at Philadelphia, a cold and wet night in which Odorizzi couldn't get a feel of the baseball...the result was his shortest career outing, recording just two outs and suffering a $10-4$ loss ( $2 \mathrm{H}, 5 \mathrm{R}, 4 \mathrm{ER}, 3 \mathrm{BB}, 1 \mathrm{SO}$ ).

SPECIAL K: With his 11 -strikeout performance March 30 vs. Cleveland, Odorizzi teamed with José Berríos ( 10 Ks on Opening Day against the Indians) to become just the second pair of pitchers in baseball history (since 1893 - when the mound was placed at its current distance to home plate) to start a team's season with consecutive double-digit strikeout totals...the only others to ever do it were Hall of Famer Randy Johnson, along with Curt Schilling, for the 2001 Arizona Diamondbacks.

LEFT IS RIGHT: Odorizzi has been the toughest starting pitcher in baseball for a left-handed batter to hit in 2019, yielding just one hit in 26 at-bats (.038), with three walks and 14 strikeouts....lefties were 0 -for-25 prior to Jeff McNeil's fifth-inning single April 10 at New York-NL, snapping Odorizzi's no-hit bid.

TOUGH TO HIT: Overall, Odorizzi has held opponents to a paltry . 111 average (4-for-36) with one double, a home run and a .511 OPS....however, he has struggled with command in his last two starts, issuing seven walks in just 5.1 innings (nine in 11.1 innings overall this season).

AGAINST THE BLUE JAYS: Odorizzi is $5-3$ with a 3.21 ERA (89.2 IP, 32 ER) in 15 career starts and appearances against Toronto, all coming with Tampa Bay...has not faced the Blue Jays since Aug. 4, 2017 at Rogers Centre...suffered a 2-1 loss in that start, despite allowing just two runs on three hits over 6.0 innings.

ON TARGET AT HOME: Over his first 16 home starts with the Twins, 0dorizzi is $5-4$ with a 4.69 ERA ( $80.2 \mathrm{IP}, 42 \mathrm{ER}$ ) and a .258 opponents batting average ( 81 -for-314)...the Twins are 10-6 when he takes the mound at Target Field ( $0-1$ in 2019, after a 2-1 loss to Cleveland on March 30).

- By contrast, Odorizzi is 2-8 with a 4.75 ERA (89.0 IP, 47 ER) in 18 road starts since 2018, while the Twins are 5-13 (0-2 in 2019)...however, he has held hitters to a .223 mark ( 73 -for-328) on the road

TURN OUT THE LIGHTS: In 21 night starts since joining the Twins, Odorizzi is $4-8$ with a 5.55 ERA ( $107.0 \mathrm{IP}, 66 \mathrm{ER}$ ) and a .258 opponents batting average (107-for-414).

- By contrast, Odorizzi has held opponents to a . 194 batting average (48-for-247) in 13 day starts with the Twins, the fifth-best mark in baseball among pitchers with at least 10 day starts since 2018...he is $3-4$ with a 3.15 ERA ( 68.2 IP, 24 ER) under the sun.

DON'T LEAVE ME HANGING: Odorizzi is tied for the American League lead with 16 no-decisions since Opening Day 2018 (in 36 starts), matching the White Sox' Reynaldo López...only Arizona's Robbie Ray (19) and Washington's Patrick Corbin (18) have more in baseball during that span.

CONSISTENCY IS KEY: Odorizzi, who has made at least 28 starts in five-straight seasons (including a trio of 30 -start campaigns), is fourth in the American League with 155 starts since 2014 (teammate Kyle Gibson is tied for fifth with 152).... he is also fifth in that span with a 234 opponents batting average.

- Only Corey Kluber (164), Rick Porcello (161) and Justin Verlander (157) have made more starts than Odorizzi over the last $5+$ seasons.
- Chris Sale (.215), Kluber (.222), Verlander (.226) and Marco Estrada (.234) are the four with lower opponent averages in that same span.


## 2018 RECAP:

- Twins 2018 Opening Day starter finished with 32 starts; along with Kyle Gibson (32) and José Berríos (32), they became the first trio of Twins with 30-plus starts in the same season since 2007 (Johan Santana - 33, Carlos Silva - 33, and Boof Bonser -30 ).
- Ranked tied for first on Twins staff in starts (32), and third in innings pitched (164.1) and strikeouts (162).
- Finished with a strikeout-per-9.0 innings pitched ratio of 8.87 , the second highest of career (9.32-2014).
