THE TWINS: The Twins are 3-2 through five games on their current homestand, going 2-0 vs. Detroit and 1-2 vs. Toronto...this afternoon the Twins will play the four-game series finale with Toronto...following today's game, the Twins will travel to Baltimore for three vs. the Orioles over the weekend, followed by three in Houston from Monday-Wednesday...the Twins are scheduled to play 20 games in their next 21 days (including today).

ODORIZZI MAKES IT LOOK EASY: The Twins beat the Blue Jays last night at Target Field by a score of 4-1...Jake Odorizzi (1-2) was the starter and winner, allowing one run on six hits in 5.2 innings pitched, one walk and six strikeouts...the bullpen combined for 3.1 scoreless innings, including a perfect ninth from Blake Parker, who earned his team-leading fourth save...the offense recorded nine hits as Marwin Gonzalez, Jorge Polanco and Nelson Cruz each went 2-for-3 with a walk.

TWINS-JAYS: The Twins are playing the fourth of seven games vs. the Blue Jays this season...they will travel to Canada for three at Rogers Centre May 6-8...the Twins have gone just 23-41 vs. the Jays since 2010, but have gone 5-2 in their last seven, dating back to May 2018.
⌘ Eddie Rosario is hitting .321 (17-for-53) with six home runs, 10 RBI, 10 runs scored and a 1.048 OPS in his last 13 games vs. the Blue Jays.
⌘ Byron Buxton is hitting .385 (15-for-39) with five home runs, 10 RBI and a 1.262 OPS in 10 career games vs. the Jays.
⌘ Nelson Cruz has a .576 slugging percentage in 94 career games against the Blue Jays...that mark ranks fourth all-time among players with at least 300 plate appearances against Toronto, trailing only Ken Griffey Jr. (.600), Jose Canseco (.595) and Albert Belle (.593).
⌘ Twins have hit 25 home runs off Jays pitching since the start of 2017, their most vs. any non-divisional opponent.

HIP HIP JORGE! Jorge Polanco is hitting .514 (18-for-35) with two doubles, two triples, three home runs, five RBI and a 1.493 OPS in his last 10 games; only Tim Anderson (21) and Domingo Santana (19) have more hits among AL players in that span...in fact, since September 5, 2018 he is hitting .366 (56-for-153) with a .420 on-base percentage in 38 games...below are the AL leaders in a few categories this season:

FOR STARTERS: Twins starters have combined to post a 3.83 ERA (80.0 IP, 34 ER) with a WHIP of 1.12 and an opponent batting average of .217...their BAA ranks fourth in all of baseball and their WHIP ranks fifth...additionally, Twins starters have held opponents to three-runs-or fewer in 12 of 15 starts.

MAD MAX: Max Kepler went 1-for-4 last night, extending his on-base streak to 12, the fourth longest of his career, his longest being 19 done July 5-27, 2018...during the current streak, he is hitting .300 (15-for-50) with a .375 on-base percentage.

HOMER HAPPY: The Twins have hit 20 home runs so far through 15 games, their second most in club history through their first 15...their most in club history through 16 games is 27, done in 1964.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2018, the Twins played the second of a two-game series vs. the Indians at Hiram Birthorn Stadium in San Juan, Puerto Rico...the Bayamón, Puerto Rico native José Berríos made the start for the Twins pitching 7.0 shutout innings with three hits allowed, no walks and five strikeouts...the game went 16 innings and lasted 5 hours and 13 minutes...the Guayama, Puerto Rico native Eddie Rosario started the bottom of the 16th with a single then came around to score on a Ryan LaMarre walk-off single.
⌘ Prior to that game, former Twins infielder and current Arizona Diamondback Eduardo Escobar introduced himself to actor Nicholas Cage who was having lunch on the patio at the team hotel; Cage was on the island filming an upcoming movie...Escobar told Cage that he was a fan and watches several of his movies to help him learn English...Cage then put his hands together, bowed and exclaimed, "Thank You, Escobar"...some of Escy's favorites were/are The Rock, and Faceoff.

HOT WHEELS: Byron Buxton has stole a club record 32 straight stolen bases successfully...Buxton is now 38-for-his-last-39 (97%)...below are a few notable charts on Buxton's stolen base success rate (Buxton is 49-for-54 in his career):

- ⌘ Twins hitters have chased 23.1% of pitches out of the zone (61/264) on the first pitch of at-bats this season -- highest in MLB; League Avg: 13.4%.
- ⌘ 15.1% of Twins hitters plate appearances have lasted only one pitch (84/556 PAs) this season -- highest in MLB; League Avg: 10.8%.
- ⌘ Twins hitters have not hit a home run to the opposite field this season -- tied for fewest in MLB.
- ⌘ Hitters have swung at 63.5% of Michael Pineda's non-fastballs (61/96) this season -- highest in MLB among starting pitchers with at least 7 IP; League Avg: 47.1%.

TIGER TAMER: Pineda recorded his first quality start in a 4-3 victory over the Detroit Tigers on Saturday...retired the first six batters of the game before a pair of singles led off the third, setting up a sacrifice fly and a single that plated the first two runs of the game in the third...settled down, allowing just two more hits before a one-out, sixth inning home run from Christin Stewart brought the Tigers within one...finished his outing by retiring Dustin Peterson and Grayson Greiner to end the sixth, throwing 96 pitches, 73 for strikes (76.0 percent), with five strikeouts.

WALK HARD: Big Mike's start versus the Tigers marked his first start of 6.0+ innings pitched without allowing a walk since June 30, 2017 at Houston, as a member of the Yankees...owns 702 strikeouts and 159 walks, a career SO/BB ratio of 4.42, seventh best among pitchers currently on a 25-man roster, (min. 695.0 IP)...he hasn't issued more than three walks in a start since July 31, 2016 at Tampa Bay, a stretch of 31 starts, and is one of 13 players with a streak of 31+ starts and less than four walks...below is a list of all starting pitchers with an active streak of 31+ starts with three walks or less in 6.0 IP or more.

SETTING 'EM DOWN: In the third inning of his last start, Pineda struck out Christin Stewart to register the 700th strikeout of his big league career...in the history of baseball, there are only three pitchers to record 700+ strikeouts in less than 700.0 IP, and Pineda is the first to accomplish the feat as an American League pitcher...the other two pitchers to have these numbers are Chicago Cubs pitcher Mark Prior, who struck out 757 batters over 657.0 innings pitched from 2002-2006, and Arizona Diamondback Robbie Ray, who currently sits at 763 strikeouts through just 635.0 innings pitched since 2014.

AGAINST TORONTO: Pineda brings the most experience against the American League East among current Twins starters, given his time spent with the Yankees from 2012-2014, as this will be the 14th start of his career against the Jays...is 2-4 with a 3.98 ERA (74.2 IP, 33 ER) with 22 walks and 61 strikeouts, but has not recorded a quality start against them since April 13, 2016.

FULL CIRCLE: Pineda is making his first start against Toronto since July 5, 2017, when he allowed five runs on nine hits over 3.0 innings of work at Yankee Stadium...that appearance would be his last at the big league level until March 31, 2019 (633 days later) after undergoing "Tommy John" surgery to repair a torn ulnar collateral ligament in his right elbow.

MARCH/APRIL FLOWERS: "Big Mike" owns a 15-7 record and a 3.41 ERA (153.0 IP, 58 ER) in the months of March and April, his second lowest of any month (September, 3.24), and his 159 strikeouts are the most of any month. In 2017, Pineda finished April 3-1 with a 3.14 ERA (28.2 IP, 10 ER), including a season-high 10 strikeout appearance on April 10.

THE REPERTOIRE: Pineda has relied on his big, high-velocity fastball throughout his eight-year big league career, as referenced by the 54.6 percent usage rate of his four-seam fastball this season...his slider is his favorite offspeed pitch, as he throws that 32.4 percent of the time...he'll also feature a changeup (8.3 percent), sinker (3.7 percent) and a curveball (0.9 percent)...in fact, hitters have swung at 63.5% of his non-fastballs this season, the highest in MLB among starting pitchers with at least 7.0 IP (league avg. is 47.1%)...has thrown 216 pitches this year, below is the breakdown of each pitch and its usage, according to Baseball Savant:

TOMORROW'S STARTER - JOSÉ BERRÍOS, RHP [SEASON: 2-1, 2.30 ERA ; CAREER: 31-27, 4.33 ERA]

Berrios will look to continue his hot start as he takes the ball in the series opener tomorrow at Baltimore...has allowed just seven earned runs in 27.1 innings pitched this season, (2.30 ERA), and brings an impressive 5.60 SO/BB ratio into tomorrow's game, (7th-best among American League starters)...is making his first start against the Orioles this season, his fifth start against Baltimore in his career...in his last start against Baltimore on April 1 of last season, the Puerto Rican right-hander spun his first career complete game shutout, allowing just three hits while striking out six...is 3-0 and owns a lifetime ERA of 3.08 (26.1 IP, 9 ER) with a 0.99 WHIP, a 5.75 SO/BB rate (23/4) and .222 opponents batting average (22-for-99) against the O's...only four current Orioles batters have faced Berrios, with Chris Davis (2-for-9), 1 BB leading the way with 10 PA's.

CAREER NOTES

- Spent the entire 2018 season on the Injured List, recovering from "Tommy John" surgery on right elbow.
- Appeared in four minor league games in 2018, allowing two runs over 12.0 innings pitched.
- Was shut down due to right knee discomfort suffered while throwing a bullpen in late August.
- Currently has 702 strikeouts in 695.0 IP...is one of three pitchers to record 700+ strikeouts in less than 700.0 IP, and Pineda is the first to turn the trick as an American League pitcher.
- Struck out 207 batters over 175.2 innings pitched in 2016, setting the fifth-lowest innings total for a pitcher who recorded 200+ strikeouts in American League history.
- Was an AL All-Star in 2011 as a member of the Seattle Mariners, posting a 3.03 ERA (113.0 IP, 38 ER) with 113 strikeouts and an opponents average of .198 in the first half, and finished the year fifth in the AL Rookie of the Year voting.
- In 2011, he became one of 27 rookie pitchers in the Expansion Era (1961-present) to throw at least 171.0 innings and strikeout 173 or more batters, and first since Daisuke Matsuzaka (Boston, 2007).
- Was signed by Seattle as a 16-year-old undrafted free agent December 12, 2005.
- He owns a farm in his native Dominican Republic, where he raises chickens in addition to growing a number of crops.

- Twins relievers have combined for four wins this season, tied for ninth most in baseball...they've walked 34, tied for eighth most in baseball...they've walked 26 in their last 10 games vs. 19 in their first five...Twins are 6-for-7 in save opps this season (Parker 4-for-4, Rogers 1-for-1, Hildenberger 1-for-1 & Mejia 0-for-1)...opp. batting average of .256 (52-for-203) in 15 games (53.0 IP).
- Their Twins bullpen went 1-1, 3.75 ERA (24.0 IP, 10 ER) with a HR, 10 BB, 26 K and a .256 BAA in six games vs. Toronto last season...the Twins bullpen recorded six holds and allowed only one home run against Toronto in those six games...in three games at Target Field last season vs. TOR, the Twins bullpen went 0-1 w/ a 3.65 ERA (12.1 IP, 5 ER) six walks & 13 strikeouts.
