THE TWINS: The Twins have gone 4-1 on their current six-game roadtrip, going 3-0 in Baltimore and 1-1 in Houston...tonight the Twins will play the three-game series finale at Minute Maid Park...they will travel home post-game, enjoy an off-day on tomorrow, then repeat their current week by hosting Baltimore over the weekend, followed by four against the Astros...the Twins have won five of their last seven games overall.

'PEN CAN'T CONTAIN 'STROS: The Twins lost to the Astros last night by a score of 10-4, losing an early 3-0 lead and surrendering nine runs from the fifth inning on...Michael Pineda was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing four runs on eight hits in 5.1 innings pitched...Trevor Hildenberger allowed his first runs of the year and was issued the loss...the offense recorded just six hits, two doubles from Jonathan Schoop (6 & 7) and a home run from Eddie Rosario (10).

ROSTER MOVES: The Twins announced today that they have recalled right-handed pitchers Kohl Stewart and Fernando Romero from Triple-A Rochester...Stewart made three starts for the Red Wings this season, going 1-2 with a 6.00 ERA (12.0 IP, 8 ER), six walks and 15 strikeouts...Romero has appeared in four games for the Red Wings this season, posting a 4.32 ERA (8.1 IP, 3 ER) with two walks and 11 strikeouts...Romero was recalled on Saturday as the Twins 26th man for a doubleheader against the Baltimore Orioles and appeared in relief in the second game and pitched 2.0 innings, allowing three earned runs...to make room on the 25-man roster, the Twins have optioned outfielder Jake Cave and right-handed pitcher Tyler Duffey to Triple-A Rochester...Cave appeared in 12 games for the Twins, hitting .233 (7-for-30) with one double, three RBI and four walks...Duffey appeared in four games for the Twins, allowing five runs (1 earned), on five hits with two walks and seven strikeouts. ☞ Additionally, the Twins have returned left-handed pitcher Gabriel Moya from rehab assignment, reinstated him and optioned him to Triple-A Rochester.

TWINS-ASTROS: The Twins and Astros are playing the third of seven meetings this season...their next series will be at Target Field, starting on Monday, for four...the Twins are 28-31 all-time against the Astros, including a record of 17-22 since Houston joined the American League in 2013...they have won just four times in their last 17 meetings with the Astros. ☞ A win tonight would give the Twins their first series win over the Astros since taking two of three April 9-11, 2018 at Target Field...their last series win in Houston came August 11-13, 2014, taking two of three. ☞ Jorge Polanco is hitting .351 (20-for-57) with a .367 OBP vs. Houston, hitting safely in 12 of 14 career games.

WE HAVE CONTACT: The Twins have seen 3.67 pitches-per-plate appearance this season, the lowest ratio in baseball; the highest in baseball is Seattle at 4.13...they have also seen the lowest number of total pitches at 2,954, the next closest being Cincinnati with 2,992...Jonathan Schoop ranks second in baseball in fewest pitches-per-PA with 3.06...the Twins have struck out 151 times this season, only the Angels (147) have struck out fewer. ☞ Tonight's Astros starter Justin Verlander has struck out 238 Twins batters in 239.2 career innings...he fanned nine and eight respectively in two starts against Minnesota in 2018.

JUMP ON 'EM EARLY: The Twins have scored 15 runs in the first inning this season, 12 of those first-inning runs have come in their last six games, scoring multiple runs in four of those six...the 15 first-inning runs are the 10th most in baseball.

MAD MAX (FURY ROAD): Max Kepler went 1-for-3 last night, extending his on-base streak to 15, the third longest of his career, his longest being 19 done July 5-27, 2018...during the current streak, he is hitting .283 (17-for-60) with a .377 on-base percentage...Kepler has hit safely in all nine road games this season, hitting .333 (13-for-39) with 10 RBI and a .985 OPS.

ROSIES ARE RED HOT: After starting the season 0-for-11 in his first three games, Eddie Rosario is hitting .315 (23-for-73) with four doubles, 10 home runs, 23 RBI and a 1.131 OPS in his last 18 games...all 10 of his home runs have come since April 6, since that date he leads baseball in homers and is tied with Christian Yelich in RBI at 21, additionally leads baseball in slugging percentage since (.881). ☞ Fewest games in club history (since 1961) to reach 10 homers: Rosario (21 games), Kirby Puckett (23 games - 1986), Bob Allison (28 games - 1964)...in fact, Rosario is the first Twin to have 10 homers before May 1; Torii Hunter with nine in 2001 was previous high.

BACKSTOPS: Catchers Willians Astudillo, Jason Castro and Mitch Garver have combined to hit .366 (26-for-71) with eight doubles, seven home runs, 16 RBI and 21 runs scored when catching...at catcher, Castro has made nine starts, Garver has made eight starts, and Astudillo has made four starts...where those three combined offensive numbers rank in baseball compared to other team's catchers: tied for first in average (.366), slugging percentage (.775) and home runs (7), second in OBP (.434) and OPS (1.208), tied for second in doubles (8) and tied for fourth in RBI (16).

LIVE FROM ASTUDILLO AUDIENCE!: Willians Astudillo is making his first career start in rightfield tonight after playing 3.0 innings in right for the first time in his career on Saturday in Game 2 of the doubleheader at Baltimore...for his career, he has played eight positions with the exception of shortstop (21 at C, 9 at 3B, 4 at 1B, 2 at 2B, 2 in LF, 1 in CF, 1 in RF and 1 at P)...for his career, he is hitting .336 (46-for-137)..."La Tortuga" was signed by the Twins as a minor league free agent on November 25, 2017.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 1996, Greg Myers and Paul Molitor each recorded five RBI as the Twins set a team record for runs and beat the Detroit Tigers, 24-11...it was the highest run total against the Tigers in 84 years, matching the mark set in a 24-2 loss to the Philadelphia Athletics on May 18, 1912, in a game in which Detroit did not have its regulars due to a players strike...in 2018, Joe Mauer played in his 1,748th career game, passing Kent Hrbek and moving into sole possession of third on the Twins all-time list (since 1961).

ANSWER THE CALL: Stewart is making his season debut in today's series finale against the Astros after being recalled from Triple-A Rochester earlier today...will be the ninth appearance of his big league career, the fifth start, after pitching four games as the "primary pitcher" in September and logging four starts in August.

DOWN ON THE FARM: Stewart began the season with Triple-A Rochester after being optioned from spring training on March 8...made three starts for the Red Wings, going 1-2 with a 6.00 ERA (12.0 IP, 8 ER) with 15 strikeouts...began his 2019 season as the Opening Day starter for Rochester...tossed 5.0 three-hit innings at Lehigh Valley on April 4 and earned the win in a 4-2 victory...all three starts this season came on the road.

LAST MAJOR LEAGUE APPEARANCE: Stewart made his eighth career appearance and fourth against Detroit on September 25, 2018...received a no-decision despite limiting the Tigers to no runs on two hits over 6.0 innings pitched in an eventual 4-2 loss...scattered a pair of singles in the second and sixth...the second inning single was to JaCoby Jones, who stole second and advanced to third on a wild throw from catcher Williams Astudillo...Dawel Lugo hit a ball back to Stewart who threw home, getting Jones at the plate, keeping the Tigers scoreless.

AGAINST HOUSTON: Made one appearance against the Astros during his time with the Twins last season, tossing 5.0 IP as the "primary pitcher" on September 4 at Minute Maid...held the Astros scoreless while allowing just three hits and a walk in an eventual 5-2 Twins loss.

TEXAS FOREVER: Born in Houston, Stewart was a quarterback at St. Pius X High School and turned down both a baseball and football scholarship to play at Texas A&M after being drafted by the Twins fourth overall in 2013...he is just the third Texas-born Twins pitcher in history to start a game in Houston, joining Tyler Duffey (Born in Houston, pitched on Sept. 6, 2015 in an 8-5 loss) and Rich Robertson (Born in Nacodoches, pitched on June 14, 1997 in a 6-1 victory)...Duffey also made a start against the Astros at home in 2015, as did Kevin Slowey (Born in Conroe) in 2009.

RIGHT WHERE WE LEFT OFF: Stewart finished 2018 as the "primary pitcher" in his final four outings, going 2-0, 1.33 ERA (20.1 IP, 3 ER) with nine walks and 13 strikeouts...his final two outings were both against Detroit, pitching 6.0 shutout innings in each.

- Started the season with Double-A Chattanooga, was 3-4, 4.76 ERA (68.0 IP, 36 ER) in 14 starts.
- Named Twins minor league Pitcher of the Week April 8-14, winning his only start of the week, allowing one run on three hits with nine strikeouts over 5.0 innings.
- Promoted to Triple-A Rochester on June 24.
- Named Twins minor league Pitcher of the Week again July 15-21, went 0-2 over two starts after allowing two runs on 10 hits and four walks with 10 strikeouts over 12.0 innings.

- Combined to go 5-8, 4.27 (145.1 IP, 69 ER) with 51 walks and 125 strikeouts in 29 games (23 starts) between Minnesota, Rochester and Chattanooga.

FRIDAY'S STARTER - MARTÍN PÉREZ, LHP [SEASON: 2-0, 5.31 ERA ; CAREER: 45-49, 4.65 ERA]

Pérez is making his third start of the season and his 131st career start Friday night in the series opener against Baltimore...made his second start on Saturday in Game No. 2 of a doubleheader against the Orioles and earned his first win as a starter, tossing 6.0 innings, allowing four runs on six hits in a 16-7 victory...is 45-49 with a 4.65 ERA (781.2 IP, 404 ER), 282 walks and 481 strikeouts in 146 career appearances (130 starts)...lifetime against Baltimore, Pérez is 3-4, 5.44 ERA (48.0 IP, 29 ER) with 10 walks and 31 strikeouts in eight appearances (all starts).
