THE TWINS: The Twins completed their six-game roadtrip with a record of 4-2, going 3-0 in Baltimore and 1-2 in Houston...tonight they will begin a seven-game homestand with three vs. Baltimore this weekend, followed by four vs. Houston from Monday-Thursday...the Twins have won five of their last eight games overall.

TWINS DROP SERIES IN HOUSTON: The Twins lost the rubber game to the Astros on Wednesday night by a score of 7-1, dropping the three game series...Kohl Stewart made his 2019 debut as the starter, allowing five runs on eight hits in 6.0 innings pitched and was dealt the loss, opposite Justin Verlander...the offense recorded just four hits, two going for extra-base hits as Jorge Polanco homered and Eddie Rosario doubled.
TWINS AND BIRDS: The Twins are 9-1 vs. the Orioles dating back to last season...they swept a three-game series last weekend in Baltimore...their last loss came on 2018 Opening Day as Adam Jones hit a walk-off homer off Fernando Rodney in the 11th inning...since that game, their nine-game winning streak is the longest active streak vs. any opponent...it's tied for their longest ever vs. the Orioles tor the Twins, the other nine-game win-streak was September 23, 2006-August 26, 2007...it marks their longest streak vs. any opponent since winning 14 straight over Tampa Bay from July 21, 2004-September 5, 2006 - Twins Manager Rocco Baldelli hit. 200 ( 6 -for-30) with one home run and seven RBI for the Rays during that streak.
$\Phi$ Since 2017, the Twins are 14-3 vs. the 0 's, their best vs. any AL opponent in that span...
the Twins are 23-8 in their last 31, dating back to September 2014.
क Jonathan Schoop signed a one-year contract with the Twins on December 6...he was signed by the Orioles in 2008 and spent six seasons in Baltimore, hitting . 261 ( 615 -for2360) with 126 doubles, 106 home runs and 312 RBI in 635 games... he remains the club's all-time leader in homers among second basemen; ranks second in runs and RBI and third in doubles.
$\Phi$ Nelson Cruz spent 2014 with Baltimore, hitting 271 ( 166 -for-613) with 32 doubles, a major league-best 40 home runs and 108 RBI in 159 games for the AL East champs... he was named the starting. DH for the AL in the All-Star Game, played at Target Field.
$\Phi$ Max Kepler has hit safely in 13 of 14 career games against the Orioles, hitting 404 (21-for-52) with six doubles, one triple, five home runs, 16 RBI, eight walks, a 4830 OBP and a 1.329 OPS
$\mp$ Highlights from last weekend's series at Camden Yards: Twins hitters combined to hit .316 ( 37 -for-117) with 12 doubles, 11 home runs and 26 runs scored...Eddie Rosario went 5 -for-14 with three home runs...Jonathan Schoop went 5 -for-12 and hit two home runs...Nelson Cruz went 5 -for-13 with two home runs.
ROSTER MOVE: The Twins announced today that they have returned right-handed pitcher Matt Magill from his rehab assignment at Triple-A Rochester and reinstated him from the injured list...Magill, who was placed on the injured list on March 28 with right shoulder tendinitis, appeared in five rehab games for the Red Wings recording eight strikeouts with one walk in 5.1 innings pitched....he did record one save...additionally, the Twins announced that they have outrighted right-handed pitcher Chase De Jong off the 40-man roster and assigned him to Triple-A.

WE HAVE CONTACT: The Twins have seen 3.67 pitches-per-plate appearance this season, the lowest ratio in baseball the highest baseball is Seattle at 4.12...they have also seen the fewest number of total pitches at 3,067 , the next closest being Cincinnati with 3,279 ... Jonathan Schoop ranks second in baseball in fewest pitches-per-PA with 3.06 ...the Twins have struck out 161 times this season, only the Angels (157) have struck out fewer.
$\Phi 14.3 \%$ of Twins hitters plate appearances have lasted only one pitch (118/828 PAs) this season -- 2nd highest in MLB; League Avg: 10.8\%

ROSIES ARE RED HOT: After starting the season 0 -for-11 in his first three games, Eddie Rosario is hitting .316 (24-for-76) with five doubles, 10 home runs, 23 RBI and a 1.134 OPS in his last 19 games...all 10 of his home runs have come since April 6 , since that date he leads baseball in homers and is tied with Christian Yelich in RBI at 21, additionally he ranks second in baseball in slugging percentage since (.881), trailing Cody Bellinger (.879).
POLANCO POP: Jorge Polanco is hitting . 393 ( 24 -for-53) with four doubles, two triples, five home runs, 10 RBI and a 1.212 OPS in his last 16 games...in fact, since September 5,2018 he is hitting .346 ( 62 -for-179) with a . 401 on-base percentage and .971 OPS in 44 games - fifth best average in baseball since that date.
$\Phi$ Jorge Polanco is batting . 472 (25-for-53) with the bases empty this season -- best in MLB; League Avg: . 253

WINNER WINNER, CHICKEN DINNER: Pérez comes into tonight's start after receiving his first win of the season as a starter (also won on March 31 vs. CLE in relief), on Saturday after beating these Orioles in Game 2 of the doubleheader 16-7...pitched 3.0 scoreless innings before Renato Núñez drove an 0-2 fastball over the fence to lefttield, driving in a pair...yielded another home run in the sixth to "best friend" Hanser Alberto, a two-run shot, before retiring Jesús Sucre to finish his evening...struck out two in the outing, his fewest in a $6.0+$ IP start since September 29, 2017 vs. Oakland, (also 6.0 IP, 2 SO)...in two starts this season, is 1-0 with a 3.75 ERA ( 12.0 IP, 5 ER) with 7 SO.

- Made three relief appearances prior, pitching to a 7.56 ERA ( $8.2 \mathrm{IP}, 7 \mathrm{ER}$ ) on 11 hits, nine walks and 12 strikeouts...recorded the win in relief March 31 vs. CLE (his Twins debut) after allowing three runs over 3.2 IP in relief of starter Michael Pineda in a pre-arranged outing for the duo.

AGAINST THE O'S: The Venezuelan lefty is making his second consecutive start against the 0's, and in seven starts against Baltimore, he owns a 3-4 record with a 5.44 ERA (48.0 IP, 29 ER), the third highest of any team he has made at least five starts against, trailing only Tampa Bay (6.57) and Boston (5.68)...as the "home" starter, he brings a career line of 1-2, 6.65 ERA (23.0 IP, 17 ER ), with his last start at home (with Texas) coming on July 30, 2017, when he allowed nine hits and 8 ER in 4.1 IP...against American League East opponents, Pérez owns a 5.18 ERA ( 97.1 IP, 56 ER) in 19 games ( 18 starts), the highest ERA of any division in baseball (tied with NL Central, 24.1 IP, 14 ER).
CABALLO ZURDO: Pérez has thrown 489.1 innings since the beginning of 2016, ranking sixth among left-handed pitchers in the American League. Below is a list of AL lefties with at least 475.0 IP since 2016:

GETTING AHEAD EARLY: Among pitchers who have thrown at least 20.0 IP this season, Pérez ranks 13th in the American League in first strike percentage at 66.0 percent (62/94 first pitch strikes)...teammate Michael Pineda is tied for 11th ( 66.7 percent).

THE REPERTOIRE: Pérez has relied on using his five-pitch mix to keep batters off balance throughout his eight-year big league career, as referenced by his usage rates for each pitch this season being less than 30 percent....his cut-fastball and his sinker are his goto pitches, as he throws them 28.9 and 28.7 percent of the time, respectively....he'll also feature a four-seamer (18.7 percent), a changeup (16.1 percent) and a curveball (7.4 percent)...has thrown 380 pitches this year, below is the breakdown of each pitch and its usage, according to Baseball Savant:

- His 489.1 innings since 2016 are the sixth-most among American League lefties. - Battled through injury in 2018 after breaking his non-throwing arm in the offseason after being charged by his pet bull.
- According to Inside Edge, opponents had a groundball rate of 67.3 percent (37/55) against Pérez's changeup in 2018, the highest in Major League Baseball with at least 80.0 IP.
- Made three starts at three different stops on rehab assignment last season, Single-A Hickory, Double-A

Frisco and Triple-A Round Rock, going 2-0, 0.52 ERA (17.1 IP, 1 ER).

- Led the Rangers in wins (13-career high), starts (32) and innings (185.0) in 2017, while setting a career-best in strikeouts (115).
- His career-high 198.2 IP in 2016 were the sixth-most by a Texas pitcher age 25-or-younger and the most since José Guzmán in 1988.
- Went $10-6$ with a 3.62 ERA ( 50 ER in 124.1 IP) in 2013, ranking tied for first among American League rookies in wins, second in ERA and third in both starts (20) and quality starts (11).
- Was named Rangers Nolan Ryan Minor League Pitcher of the Year after combining to go 6-8,
2.90 ERA (37 ER in 114.2 IP) with 119 strikeouts in 27 games (19 starts).
- Entered 2008 as the youngest player in the Northwest League and was rated by Baseball America as the second-best prospect in the NWL, fifth-best in the Rangers' organization.
