THE TWINS: After completing their six-game roadtrip with a record of 4-2 (3-0 in Baltimore and 1-2 in Houston), the Twins began their homestand with a win over the Orioles last night...today they will play the second of three vs. Baltimore...after tomorrow afternoon's game, the Twins will host Houston from Monday-Thursday...the Twins have won six of their last nine games overall.

TWINS TAKE O'S AGAIN: The Twins beat the Orioles last night by a score of 6-1, extending their winning streak over Baltimore to 10 games...Martín Pérez (3-0) was the starter and winner, allowing one run on six hits in 6.0 innings pitched...the offense recorded 10 hits, three from Nelson Cruz, who homered twice, the 29th multi-homer game of his career...the Twins homered five times on the night, including back-to-back-to-back homers from Cruz, Eddie Rosario and C.J. Cron in the first inning.

TWINS AND BIRDS: The Twins are 10-1 vs. the Orioles dating back to last season...their last loss came on 2018 Opening Day as Adam Jones hit a walk-off homer off Fernando Rodney in the 11th inning...since that game, their 10-game winning streak is the longest active streak vs. any opponent...it's their longest ever vs. the Orioles for the Twins (see next note).
☞ Since 2017, the Twins are 15-3 vs. the O's, their best vs. any AL opponent in that span...the Twins are 24-8 in their last 32, dating back to September 2014.

☞ Max Kepler has hit safely in 14 of 15 career games against the Orioles, hitting .411 (23-for-56) with six doubles, one triple, six home runs, 17 RBI, eight walks, a .484 OBP and a 1.359 OPS.

☞ The Twins have now hit 16 home runs vs. the Orioles this season, their club record over the O's in a single season is 22 done in both 1962 and 1964.

☞ Nelson Cruz is hitting .471 (8-for-17) with one double, four home runs and six RBI against the Orioles this season...Eddie Rosario is hitting .333 (6-for-18) with four home runs and five RBI against the O's this season...C.J. Cron is hitting .455 (5-for-11) with two home runs vs. the O's this season.

WE HAVE CONTACT: The Twins have seen 3.68 pitches-per-plate appearance this season, the lowest ratio in baseball; the highest in baseball is Seattle at 4.12...they have also seen the fewest number of total pitches at 3,212, the next closest being Pittsburgh with 3,412...Jonathan Schoop ranks second in baseball in fewest pitches-per-PA with 3.11...the Twins have struck out 166 times this season, only the Angels (158) have struck out fewer.

ROSIES ARE RED HOT: After starting the season 0-for-11 in his first three games, Eddie Rosario is hitting .313 (25-for-80) with five doubles, 11 home runs, 24 RBI and a 1.140 OPS in his last 20 games...all 11 of his home runs have come since April 6, since that date he leads baseball in homers and is tied with Christian Yelich in RBI at 22, additionally he ranks second in baseball in slugging percentage (.879), trailing Los Angeles-NL's Cody Bellinger (.918).

WHOA NELLY!: Nelson Cruz is hitting .333 (12-for-36) with two doubles, four home runs, nine RBI and a 1.122 OPS in his last nine games...he ranks 83rd on baseball's all-time home runs list (365), one shy of Lance Berkman (366) and four short of Todd Helton and Ralph Kiner (369)...among designated hitters this season, he ranks second in batting average (.313), OBP (.421), slugging (.609) and OPS (1.030).

JUMP ON 'EM EARLY: The Twins have scored 18 runs in the first inning this season, 15 of those first-inning runs have come in their last 10 games, scoring multiple runs in five of those 10...the 15 first-inning runs are the seventh most in baseball...19 of the Twins 32 runs scored vs. the Orioles this season have come in the first three innings.

LEAVING THE YARD: The Twins have hit 42 home runs so far through 23 games, tied for most in club history through their first 23 - also 42 in 1964...the Twins are on pace to hit 295 home runs, which would pass their club record of 225, set in 1963...the MLB record is 267, done by New York-AL last season...the Twins rank tied for fifth in baseball in home runs, despite playing in the fewest games...they rank third in at-bats-per-home run (18.79).

MINNESOTA WINS: The Twins enter today with the third best winning percentage in baseball at .609, trailing only Tampa Bay (.640, 16-9) and Seattle (.621 - 18-11)...their 14 wins through the first 23 games is their best start through 23 since going 15-8 in 2010... additionally, the Twins have gone 6-4 at home this season.

LAST OUTING: Berríos earned his third win of the season after allowing four runs on eight hits with three walks and five strikeouts...matched his career-high (fifth time) allowing three home runs in his first non-quality start of the season, snapping a stretch of five straight quality starts...issued a season-high three walks and threw a season-high 104 pitches and 63 strikes.

MOVING UP IN THE RANKS: Through five starts, Berríos ranks in the American League and in Major League Baseball when pitching at home in the following categories:

AGAINST THE ORIOLES: He will be making his sixth career start against the Orioles, third at Target Field...he is 4-0, 3.62 ERA (32.1 IP, 13 ER) with seven walks and 28 strikeouts in his career vs. Baltimore...last start vs. the O's at home came July 6, 2017...he threw 6.0 innings and allowed four runs on seven hits with zero walks and four strikeouts...last outing on April 20 at Camden Yards, he allowed four runs on eight hits in 6.0 innings pitched and was the winner in a Twins 6-5 victory in game 1 of a doubleheader.

NO PLACE LIKE HOME: Berríos enters today with a 3-0 record and a 1.26 ERA this season at Target Field...he went 9-4, 3.03 ERA (107.0 IP, 36 ER) in 17 appearances (17 starts) at home in 2018...conversely, Berríos was 3-7, 4.85 ERA (85.1 IP, 46 ER) on the road...suffered six consecutive road losses before winning at Toronto July 24, 2018...opponents only hit .200 (78-for-390) against him at home in 2018 with only six home runs.

THE FLY BALL: Berríos has produced 438 total fly balls in his career, the second-most among Twins pitchers behind Ervin Santana (455) since 2016...in that same time span, José has produced 42 fly balls against the Orioles, which is good for the club's best in front of Kyle Gibson (25).

LEFT AND RIGHT: He has held right-handed hitters to a .182 (12-for-66) average with four home runs, four walks, 19 strikeouts and a .225 OBP...for his career, righties have hit .237 (198-for-834) with 52 walks and 214 strikeouts and lefties have hit .240 (189-for-789) with 100 walks and 209 strikeouts.

PITCH SELECTION: José has favored his curveball more this season than any other with a 37.6 percent usage rate...in 2018 he threw it 30.4 percent of time, 30 percent in 2017 and 21.6 in 2016...he has thrown a total of 482 pitches on the year with 50.2 percent of those landing in the strike zone...below is the breakdown of his 2019 pitch arsenal, according to Baseball Savant:

CAREER YEAR: After his last start of the 2018 campaign vs. Chicago-AL, Berríos set a career high for starts in a season with 32, his previous career high being 25 in 2017...joined Kyle Gibson (32) and Jake Odorizzi (32), becoming the first trio of Twins with 30-plus starts in the same season since 2007 (Johan Santana - 33, Carlos Silva - 33, and Boof Bonser - 30)...the righty also set career highs in innings pitched (192.1) and strikeouts (202).

Ks FOR GOOD: Berríos will donate \$50 per strikeout in 2019 to Fundación CAP. Fundación CAP is a non-profit organization that since 1989 has been working for children with cancer at Hospital Pediátrico, the leading public pediatric hospital in Puerto Rico and the only one that treats certain types of cancer. The mission of CAP is to ensure that ALL children with cancer, regardless of their financial resources, have access to first-rate cancer treatment here in Puerto Rico, close to their family and home. 100% of the funds collected remain in Puerto Rico and their benefit is seen and felt in every corner of the Hospital.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - KYLE GIBSON, RHP [SEASON: 1-0, 6.10 ERA ; CAREER: 55-61, 4.50 ERA]

Gibson is making is fifth start of the season tomorrow in the series finale against the Orioles at Target Field...he is 1-0, 6.10 ERA (20.2 IP, 14 ER) with eight walks and 18 strikeouts in four appearances this season...he was the winner in his last start April 21 at Baltimore, allowing two runs on five hits with zero walks and six strikeouts in 6.0 innings pitched...marked his first quality start of the year...Gibson has a career record of 5-2, 4.69 ERA (55.2 IP, 29 ER) with 28 walks and 51 strikeouts in 10 games (10 starts) against Baltimore.

- Twins relievers have combined for four wins this season, tied for 20th most in baseball...they've walked 45, tied for 12th most in the majors...Twins are 8-for-9, in save opps' this season, tied for 18th most in baseball (Parker 4-for-4, Rogers 3-for-3, Hildenberger 1-for-1 & Mejia 0-for-1)...opp. batting average of .259 (79-for-305) in 23 games (78.1 IP)...4.71 ERA 21st highest in MLB.
- The Twins bullpen went 0-1, 4.50 ERA (18.0 IP, 9 ER) with 4 HR, 6 BB, 19 K and a .254 BAA in six games vs. Baltimore last season...the Twins bullpen recorded three holds and averaged 16.2 pitches per inning against Baltimore in those six games...in four games at Target Field vs. BAL last season, the Twins bullpen went 0-0 w/ a 3.27 ERA (11.0 IP, 4 ER) one walk & eight strikeouts.
