WE WIN, ONE NOTHIN': The Twins beat the Astros last night by a score of 1-0...Jake Odorizzi (3-2) was the starter and winner, pitching 7.0 shutout innings with four hits allowed and seven strikeouts...Taylor Rogers earned his sixth hold and Blake Parker earned his sixth save... Ehire Adrianza's solo home run in the third inning off Justin Verlander was the difference in the game...the last time the Twins won 1-0 on a solo homer was May 12, 2017 at Cleveland on a Miguel Sanó homer.

TWINS-ASTROS: The Twins and Astros are playing the fifth of seven games this season...the Twins are 29-32 all-time against the Astros, including a record of 18-23 since Houston joined the American League in 2013...they have won just five times in their last 19 meetings with the Astros.

▼ Jorge Polanco is hitting .328 (21-for-64) with a .353 OBP vs. Houston, hitting safely in 13 of 16 career games.
▼ Jorge Polanco is hitting .365 (35-for-96) with nine doubles, five home runs, 15 RBI and a .986 OPS in 24 career games vs. the Astros...the .365 average is his highest vs. any AL opponent.

YARD WORK: The Twins have hit 50 home runs so far through 26 games, the second most in club history through their first 26 (51 in the first 26 of 1964)...they hit their 50th home run last season on May 30 at Kansas City in the club's 51st game...the Twins are on pace to hit 311 home runs, the club record is 225, set in 1963...the MLB record is 267, done by New York-AL last season...the Twins rank tied for third in baseball in home runs, despite playing in the fewest games...they lead baseball in at-bats-per-home run (17.56).

HOUSTON, WE HAD A PROBLEM: In his last time out, Pineda struggled against the Astros last Tuesday at Minute Maid Park, allowing four runs on eight hits over just 5.1 innings, receiving a no-decision in Houston's 10-4 win...cruised through the first two innings before George Springer hit a one-out single in the third...allowed four hits and three runs in the fifth before being pulled in the sixth following a one-out double to Carlos Correa...threw 86 pitches in the outing, 57 for strikes.

LOOKING TO GET BACK ON TRACK: In Pineda's first three starts of his comeback campaign (all Twins wins), "Big Mike" went 2-0 with a 3.00 ERA (15.0 IP, 5 ER), .241 opponents' batting average (13-for-54) and .689 OPS, along with 15 strikeouts and a WHIP of 1.00... in his last two outings (both Twins losses), Pineda is 0-1 with a 10.00 ERA (9.0 IP, 10 ER), .385 opponents' average (15-for-39) and 1.070 OPS, along with just five strikeouts and a WHIP of 2.00.

WALK HARD: Through five starts this season, Pineda has only issued five free passes in 24.0 innings pitched...owns 707 career strikeouts against 162 walks, a lifetime SO/BB ratio of 4.36, seventh best among pitchers currently on a 25-man roster (min. 700.0 IP)... he hasn't issued more than three walks in a start since July 31, 2016 at Tampa Bay, a stretch of 33 starts, and is one of 13 pitchers with an active streak of 33+ starts and less than four walks (full list is below).

AGAINST HOUSTON: Pineda brings a lifetime 3-3 record with a 4.66 ERA (48.1 IP, 25 ER) against the Houston Astros into this start...before his start on Tuesday, had not seen the 'Stros since before his "Tommy John" surgery, with his last appearance coming on June 30, 2017 in a 13-4 blowout victory at Minute Maid, as a member of the New York Yankees.

MARCH/APRIL FLOWERS: "Big Mike" owns a 15-8 record and a 3.78 ERA (162.0 IP, 68 ER) in the months of March and April, his second lowest of any month (September, 3.24), and his 164 strikeouts are the most of any month. In 2017, Pineda finished April 3-1 with a 3.14 ERA (28.2 IP, 10 ER), including a season-high 10 strikeout appearance on April 10.

THE REPERTOIRE: Pineda has relied on his big, high-velocity fastball throughout his eightyear big league career, as referenced by the 57.3 percent usage rate of his four-seamer this season...his slider is his favorite offspeed pitch, as he throws that 30.8 percent of the time...he'll also feature a changeup that fades away from a left-handed hitter...to right-handed hitters, Pineda favors his fastball/slider combo, throwing just 10 changeups to righties this season...he has thrown 377 pitches this year, below is the breakdown of each pitch and its usage, according to Baseball Savant:
