THE TWINS：The Twins have gone 4－1 on their current seven－game homestand，sweeping the Orioles over the weekend，followed by a win and a loss to the Astros the last two nights．．． tonight they will play the third of four with the Astros．．．after tomorrow afternoon＇s series finale，the Twins will travel to New York for three over the weekend vs．the Yankees，followed by three in Toronto Monday－Wednesday．．．the Twins have won eight of their last 11 games overall．
BOY，THAT ESCALATED QUICKLY：The Twins lost to the Astros last night by a score of 11－0， suffering their first shutout of the season and largest margin of loss since losing 18－4 on September 2， 2018 at Texas．．．Michael Pineda（2－2）was the starter and winner，allowing five runs on nine hits in 5.0 innings pitched．．．the offense was held hit－less by Gerrit Cole through 5.1 innings until a Max Kepler double．．．Kepler added another single as the Twins totaled three hits．

TWINS－ASTROS：The Twins and Astros are playing the sixth of seven games this season．．． the Twins are 29－33 all－time against the Astros，including a record of 18－24 since Houston joined the American League in 2013．．．they have won just five times in their last 20 meetings with the Astros．

क Jonathan Schoop is hitting .360 （36－for－100）with nine doubles，five home runs， 15 RB and a .966 OPS in 25 career games vs．the Astros．．．the .360 average is his highest vs．any AL opponent．．．additionally，he is hitting ． 435 （20－for－46）in his last 11 vs．the Astros．
YARD WORK：The Twins have hit 50 home runs so far through 27 games，the second most in club history through their first 27 （ 51 in the first 27 of 1964）．．．they hit their 50th home run last season on May 30 at Kansas City in the club＇s 51 st game．．．the Twins are on pace to hit 300 home runs，the club record is 225，set in 1963．．．the MLB record is 267，done by New York－AL last season．．．the Twins rank tied for fourth in baseball in home runs，despite playing in the second fewest games．．．they rank second in baseball to Milwaukee（17．91） in at－bats－per－home run（18．14）．

WINNER WINNER, CHICKEN DINNER: Pérez enters tonight's start after receiving his second consecutive win of the season as a starter (also won on March 31 vs. CLE in relief), on Friday after beating the Orioles $6-1 \ldots$...pitched 5.0 scoreless innings, allowing just three hits, a pair of leadoff singles preceded a one-out, RBI single from Dwight Smith Jr., plating the 0's lone tally of the ballgame....struck out four in the outing and did not issue a walk for the first time this season, and just the fourth time since the beginning of 2018 (as a starter)...in three starts this season, is 2-0 with a $3.00 \mathrm{ERA}(18.0 \mathrm{IP}, 6 \mathrm{ER}$ ) with 11 SO .

- Made three relief appearances prior, pitching to a 7.56 ERA ( $8.2^{\prime} \mathrm{IP}, 7 \mathrm{ER}$ ) on 11 hits, nine walks and 12 strikeouts...recorded the win in relief March 31 vs. CLE (his Twins debut) after allowing three runs over 3.2 IP in relief of starter Michael Pineda in a pre-arranged outing for the duo.

AGAINST THE 'STROS: The Venezuelan lefty is making his first start against the 0's this season, and first since August 29, 2017...in 11 starts against Houston, he owns a 6-4 record with a $3.00 \mathrm{ERA}(72.0 \mathrm{IP}, 24 \mathrm{ER})$, the third lowest of any team he has made at least three starts against, trailing only Kansas City (2.29) and Toronto (2.96)...as the "home" starter, he brings a career line of 4-1, 3.13 ERA (31.2 IP, 11 ER ), with his last start at home (with Texas) coming on June 4, 2017, when he allowed six runs (five earned) on seven hits (three HR) in 3.2 IP....against American League West opponents, Pérez has a 4.02 ERA ( 365.1 IP, 163 ER) in 68 games ( 61 starts).

HOME COOKING: Is 2-0, 2.87 ERA ( $15.2 \mathrm{IP}, 5 \mathrm{ER}$ ) with five walks and 15 strikeouts in three home starts this season...his last home loss came April 22, 2018 vs. Seattle at Globe Life Park in Arlington.

CABALLO ZURDO: Pérez has thrown 495.1 innings since 2016, sixth-most among left-handed pitchers in the American League...below is a list of AL lefties with 475.0+ IP since 2016:

THE REPERTOIRE: Pérez has relied on using his pitch variety to keep batters off balance throughout his eight-year big league career, as referenced by his usage rates for all-butone pitch this season being less than 30 percent...his cut-fastball and his sinker are his go-to pitches, as he throws them 33.0 and 26.7 percent of the time, respectively....he'll also feature a Four-Seamer (17.0 percent), a Changeup (14.9 percent), a Curveball (7.8 percent), a Slider ( 0.4 percent) and a splitter ( 0.2 percent)...has thrown 576 pitches this year, with 82 of those pitches being batted into play with an average exit velocity of 87.6 MPH....below is the breakdown of each pitch and its usage, according to Baseball Savant: $\frac{\mathrm{PITCH}}{\text { Cutter.... }}$ $\qquad$ PERCENTAGE

## CAREER NOTES

- His 495.1 innings since 2016 are the sixth-most among American League lefties. - Battled through injury in 2018 after breaking his non-throwing arm in the offseason after being charged by his pet bull.
- According to Inside Edge, opponents had a groundball rate of 67.3 percent (37/55) against Pérez's changeup in 2018, the highest in Major League Baseball with at least 80.0 IP . - Made three starts at three different stops on rehab assignment last season, Single-A Hickory, Double-A Frisco and Triple-A Round Rock, going 2-0, 0.52 ERA ( $17.1 \mathrm{IP}, 1 \mathrm{ER}$ ).
- Led the Rangers in wins (13-career high), starts (32) and innings (185.0) in 2017, while setting a career-best in strikeouts (115).
- His career-high 198.2 IP in 2016 were the sixth-most by a Texas pitcher age 25 -or-younger and the most since José Guzmán in 1988.
- Went $10-6$ with a 3.62 ERA ( 50 ER in 124.1 IP) in 2013, ranking tied for first among American League rookies in wins, second in ERA and third in both starts (20) and quality starts (11).
- Was named Rangers Nolan Ryan Minor League Pitcher of the Year after combining to go 6-8,
2.90 ERA (37 ER in 114.2 IP) with 119 strikeouts in 27 games (19 starts).

Entered 2008 as the youngest player in the Northwest League and was rated by Baseball America as the second-best prospect in the NWL, fifth-best in the Rangers' organization.
