**THE TWINS:** The Twins have gone 2-1 through three games on their seven-game homestand, going 2-1 vs. the Tigers...today they will play the four-game series finale with Detroit...tomorrow night the Twins will begin a three-game series with the Angels from Monday-Wednesday...the Twins have won 16 of their last 22, 12 of their last 16 and eight of their last 11.

**TWINS SPLIT WITH TIGERS:** The Twins lost game one yesterday by the score of 5-3 and won game two by a score of 8-3...Michael Pineda started game one, allowing three runs on six hits in 6.0 innings pitched with no walks...Kohl Stewart started game two, allowing three runs on six hits in 6.0 innings pitched and earned his first win of the season...individual offensive highlights include Eddie Rosario going 4-for-10 and C.J. Cron going 5-for-8 with a home run in each game and a total of four RBI on the day.

### ROSTER SHUFFLES: Two up, three down...

☞ Twins have reinstated left-handed pitcher Martín Pérez from the Paternity List...Pérez has appeared in eight games (5 starts) for the Twins, going 5-0 with a 2.83 ERA (41.1 IP, 13 ER), 16 walks and 39 strikeouts.  
☞ The Twins have reinstated catcher/infielder Willians Astudillo from the 10-day Injured List...Astudillo, who missed the Twins last 14 games with a left hamstring strain, is hitting .327 (16-for-49) with four doubles, two home runs and seven RBI in 16 games for the Twins.  
☞ Fernando Romero and Kohl Stewart were optioned to Triple-A Rochester.  
☞ Tyler Duffey has been returned to Rochester after serving as the 26th man yesterday.

**TWINS AND TIGERS:** The Twins are 4-1 vs. Detroit this season...Twins have won six of their last seven over the Tigers and 10 of their last 12 over Detroit, dating back to August 19, 2018.  
☞ C.J. Cron is hitting .333 (34-for-102) with five doubles, eight home runs and 26 RBI in 26 career games vs. DET...he has 10 RBI in his last six games vs. DET.  
☞ Nelson Cruz is hitting .346 (27-for-78) with six doubles, five home runs, 16 RBI and a 1.071 OPS in his last 21 vs. the Tigers.  
☞ Jorge Polanco is hitting .329 (23-for-70) with eight multi-hit games vs. DET since 2018...he has a seven-game hitting streak vs. DET, hitting .400 (12-for-30) in that span.  
☞ **DID YOU KNOW?:** Just three players on the current Twins roster were ever on a Ron Gardenhire-managed team in Minnesota: Kyle Gibson started 10 games for Gardy in 2013 and 31 games in 2014...Trevor May pitched in 10 games (9 starts) in 2014...Jorge Polanco played five games in 2014.

**WE DIG THE LONG BALL:** The Twins have hit 70 home runs, third most in baseball, trailing Seattle (77) and Houston (71)...they lead baseball in home runs-per-game with 1.84...they are pace to hit 298 homers, which would pass the club record of 225 in 1963.  
☞ Twins have six players with seven-plus homers (Rosario - 13, Cron - 9, Garver - 8, Kepler - 8, Cruz - 7, Polanco 7)...tied with Seattle for most in baseball.

**TWINS, FOR THE RECORD:** The Twins enter today with 25 wins, tied for third most wins through the club's first 38 games (27-11 in 2001, 26-12 in 1970 and 25-13 in 1979); also May 12 is the earliest in the calendar the Twins have reached 25 wins...they enter today with a five-game lead in the AL Central, their biggest lead in the division since the end of the 2010 season when they finished 94-68 and 6.0 games up on the White Sox (88-74).

**FOR THE MOMS:** The Twins lost on Mother's Day in 2018, by a score of 2-1 at Los Angeles-AL and opposing starter Shohei Ohtani...Fernando Romero was the Twins starter, allowing one run on four hits in 5.0 innings pitched...the Twins lost on a Zack Cozart walk-off single...the Twins last win on Mother's Day came in 2014 when a Ron Gardenhire-led Twins team beat Detroit at Comerica Park by a score of 4-3...Samuel Deduno was the Twins starter, allowing three runs on six hits in 6.0 innings pitched as today's FS North pregame analyst Glen Perkins earned his 10th save...the Twins lineup that day: 1) 2B Brian Dozier, 2) DH Joe Mauer, 3) 3B Trevor Plouffe, 4) 1B Chris Colabello, 5) C Josmil Pinto, 6) LF Eduardo Núñez, 7) RF Chris Parmelee, 8) CF Aaron Hicks, 9) SS Eduardo Escobar

**OLD FRIEND UPDATE:** It was recently announced that former Twins pitcher Nick Blackburn was hired as an assistant coach for the Mid-America Christian University baseball team in Oklahoma City, OK...Blackburn, who pitched six seasons with the Twins from 2007-12, went 43-55, 4.85 ERA (818.2 IP, 441 ER) with 202 walks, 388 strikeouts and five complete games in 145 games (137 starts) for Minnesota...since retiring from Major League Baseball following the 2014 season, Nick has since been helping Washington High School in Washington, OK as a coach.

**TWINS ML WEEKLYS:** Single-A Ft. Myers outfielder Trevor Larnach and Single-A Cedar Rapids right-handed pitcher Jordan Balazovic have been named as the Twins minor league Player and Pitcher of the Week...in six games for the Miracle, Larnach hit .440 (11-for-25) with two doubles, two home runs, five RBI, seven runs scored, three walks and a 1.260 OPS...Larnach, 22, was drafted by the Twins in the first round (20th overall) in the 2018 First-Year Player Draft out of Oregon State University, entering the 2019 season as the fifth best prospect in the Twins system by *Baseball America*...Balazovic made a start on Sunday at Palm Beach, pitching 7.0 no-hit innings with no walks and 10 strikeouts...Balazovic, 20, was drafted by the Twins in the fifth round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft out of St. Martin Secondary School in Mississauga, Ontario.

**ON THIS DAY IN TWINS/SENATORS FRANCHISE HISTORY:** In 1926, Walter Johnson of the Washington Senators records his 400th career win when he defeats the St. Louis Browns, 7-4, to reach the rarely-achieved milestone..."The Big Train" remains the all-time Twins/Senators franchise leader in wins with 417.

**LAST START:** Was the starter and winner, May 6 at Toronto opposite Marcus Stroman, pitching 7.0 shutout innings with two hits allowed, two walks and career-high nine strikeouts...extended his winning streak to five games, his long being seven (August 9-September 8, 2017)...the two hits allowed were a Freddy Galvis fourth inning single and a Rowdy Tellis fifth inning single...the Twins won 8-0 in game one of a three-game sweep in Toronto.

- This start became part of a stretch of 25.0 consecutive scoreless innings by Twins pitchers from mid-game Sunday through mid-game Wednesday, their longest since September 1-4, 2004 (also 25.0)

### WINNER, WINNER, WINNER, WINNER, CHICKEN DINNER:

- In five starts this season, is 4-0 with a 1.64 ERA (33.0 IP, 6 ER), 7 BB, 27 SO and a .214 opponents average...all five starts have been at least 6.0 IP with four of them being quality starts.
- Since joining the rotation on April 15, Pérez ranks tied for second in baseball in wins (tied with Berríos, trailing only Odorizzi), eighth in ERA and is tied for ninth in innings pitched.
- Pérez reached a couple of milestones in his last start, eclipsing 800.0 career innings pitched while also recording his 500th strikeout, becoming just the 19th Venezuelan-born major leaguer to reach the 500-strikeout mark.
- Made three relief appearances prior, pitching to a 7.56 ERA (8.2 IP, 7 ER) on 11 hits, nine walks and 12 strikeouts with a 1-0 record.

**AGAINST THE TIGERS:** Is making his first start against the Tigers this season...in five games (4 starts) in his career against Detroit, he owns a 1-2, 6.17 ERA (23.1 IP, 16 ER), the fourth-highest of any team he has made at least three starts against, trailing only New York-AL (9.68), Cleveland (9.13) and Tampa Bay (6.57)...has not pitched against the Tigers since 2017.

- His only career win vs. Detroit, came in his last start against them on August 14, 2017, allowing two runs on six hits in 6.0 innings pitched at Texas, pitching for the Rangers.

**ON TARGET:** Enters today 3-0, 1.90 ERA (23.2 IP, 5 ER) in four games at Target Field (3 starts)...has allowed two runs in his last three starts here, including four walks and 16 strikeouts in that span...earned the win in his last start at home, pitching 8.0 shutout innings with just four hits allowed, earning the win vs. Houston...by comparison, he has gone 2-0, 4.08 ERA (17.2 IP, 8 ER) in four game (2 starts) on the road this season.

**REVERSE SPLITS:** Pérez has posted an opponent batting average of .225 (29-for-129) with six extra-base hits to right-handed batters this season while lefties are hitting .304 (7-for-23) with no extra-base hits...for his career righties have hit .295 and lefties have hit .244.

**CABALLO ZURDO:** Pérez has thrown 510.1 innings since 2016, fifth-most among left-handed pitchers in the American League...below is a list of AL lefties with 490.0+ IP since 2016:

## CAREER NOTES

- His 510.1 innings since 2016 are the sixth-most among American League lefties.
- Battled through injury in 2018 after breaking his non-throwing arm in the offseason after being charged by his pet bull.
- According to Inside Edge, opponents had a groundball rate of 67.3 percent (37/55) against Pérez's changeup in 2018, the highest in Major League Baseball with at least 80.0 IP.
- Made three starts at three different stops on rehab assignment last season, Single-A Hickory, Double-A Frisco and Triple-A Round Rock, going 2-0, 0.52 ERA (17.1 IP, 1 ER).
- Led the Rangers in wins (13-career high), starts (32) and innings (185.0) in 2017, while setting a career-best in strikeouts (115).
- His career-high 198.2 IP in 2016 were the sixth-most by a Texas pitcher age 25-or-younger and the most since José Guzmán in 1988.
- Went 10-6 with a 3.62 ERA (50 ER in 124.1 IP) in 2013, ranking tied for first among American League rookies in wins, second in ERA and third in both starts (20) and quality starts (11).
- Was named Rangers Nolan Ryan Minor League Pitcher of the Year after combining to go 6-8, 2.90 ERA (37 ER in 114.2 IP) with 119 strikeouts in 27 games (19 starts).
- Entered 2008 as the youngest player in the Northwest League and was rated by Baseball America as the second-best prospect in the NWL, fifth-best in the Rangers' organization.
