THE TWINS: The Twins have gone 2-3 through five games on their seven-game homestand, going 2-2 vs. the Tigers over the weekend and 0-1 vs. the Angels...tonight they will play the second of three with Los Angeles-AL...tomorrow afternoon they will play the three-game series finale before traveling to the west coast for a seven-game roadtrip...they will play four at Seattle from Thursday-Sunday and Los Angeles-AL from next Monday-Wednesday...the Twins have won 16 of their last 24, 12 of their last 18 and eight of their last 13.

☞ Twins are looking to avoid losing three straight for the first time this season...their last three-game losing streak came September 13-15, dropping three straight at Kansas City.

TWINS FALL SHORT TO ANGELS: The Twins lost to the Angels last night by a score of 5-4, just their fourth series opener loss this season (10-4)...José Berríos (6-2) was the starter and loser, allowing five runs on a career-high 12 hit in 5.2 innings pitched...15 hits allowed by Twins pitchers tied a season-high, previously done April 30 vs. Houston...the offense recorded seven hits, two from both Jorge Polanco and Eddie Rosario...Polanco (8) and Marwin Gonzalez (4) each homered...Twins went 0-for-10 with runners in scoring position.

TWINS AND HALOS: The Twins have gone just 1-4 in their last five against the Angels and 3-6 in their last nine...tonight they are looking to avoid losing their second consecutive series to the Angels, dating back to June of 2018 when they lost two of three at Target Field...the Twins will travel to Anaheim for three night games next week where they are 5-3 in their last eight.

☞ Marwin Gonzalez is hitting .319 (22-for-69) with eight doubles, three home runs, 12 RBI, 11 walks and a .978 OPS in his last 20 games vs. the Angels.
☞ Eddie Rosario is hitting .357 (10-for-28) in his last seven games vs. LAA.
☞ Jonathan Schoop is hitting .320 (24-for-75) in 22 career games vs. LAA.

TWINS & ANGEL TIES:

☞ Blake Parker pitched two seasons for the Angels from 2017-18, going 5-4, 2.90 ERA (133.2 IP, 43 ER) with 22 saves in 28 opportunities...he led the Angels in saves in 2018, going 14-for-17.
☞ C.J. Cron was drafted by the Angels 17th overall in the 2011 First-Year Player Draft...he played parts of four seasons with the Angels, from 2014-17, hitting .262 (358-for-1366) with 68 doubles, 59 home runs and 213 RBI in 408 games...he played 289 games at first base for the Angels and 99 games as designated hitter.
☞ Mike Morin was drafted by the Angels in the 13th round of the 2012 First-Year Player Draft and pitched parts of four seasons with Los Angeles from 2014-17, going 10-8, 4.49 ERA (164.1 IP, 82 ER) with one save, 45 walks and 154 strikeouts...from 2014-17, he appeared in 167 games for the Halos, third most on the club for that span, trailing Fernando Salas (187) and Joe Smith (184).

MARGO GOING GOOD: Marwin Gonzalez enters tonight with a season-long six-game hitting streak, hitting .381 (8-for-21) with five RBI, four walks and a 1.167 OPS during the streak...his career-high is 13, done July 15-August 3, 2016 with Houston...in his last 11 games, since May 2, Gonzalez is hitting .385 (15-for-39) with a 1.042 OPS after starting the season hitting .159 (13-for-82) with a .477 OPS...his 15 hits this month are second on the Twins, trailing Jorge Polanco (17).

POLANCO POP: Since September 1, 2018, Jorge Polanco is hitting .319 (84-for-263) with 18 doubles, five triples, 11 home runs, 33 RBI, 37 runs scored, 24 walks and a .931 OPS...since that date, he leads all MLB shortstops in hits, average, OBP, SLG and OPS...below are his American League rankings this season:

'SOTA POP: The Twins have homered in eight straight games, their longest streak of the season...it marks their longest stretch since August 25-September 2, 2018, when they also homered in eight straight...their last nine-game homer streak was August 11-20, 2018...the Twins have hit 73 home runs, third most in baseball, trailing Seattle (80) and Houston (79).

LIVE IN FRONT OF ASTUDILLO AUDIENCE!: Willians Astudillo enters tonight with a six-game hitting streak which ties his career-high, previously done September 19-27, 2018...during the current streak he is hitting .333 (6-for-18) with three doubles and two RBI...for his career, he is hitting .338 (51-for-151) with an .869 OPS.

WE HAVE CONTACT: The Twins have seen 3.79 pitches-per-plate appearance this season, the lowest ratio in baseball; the highest in baseball is Texas (4.09)...Jonathan Schoop ranks fifth in baseball in fewest pitches-per-PA with 3.38, the MLB leader being Andrelton Simmons (3.06)...the Twins have struck out 299 times this season, only the Angels (242) have struck out fewer.
☞ Willians Astudillo hasn't struck out in 41 consecutive at-bats, second longest active streak in the majors.

SKOL VIKINGS!: The Twins are celebrating their second annual "SKOL Night" honoring the Minnesota Vikings...fans that purchase this special event ticket package will receive an exclusive co-branded SKOL/Twins beanie...Quarterback Kirk Cousins and Defensive Lineman Everson Griffen will be throwing out the first pitch...other Vikings scheduled to attend this evening are Tight End Kyle Rudolph, Linebacker Eric Kendricks, Safeties Harrison Smith, Anthony Harris and Jayron Kearse and Cornerbacks Trae Waynes, Mackensie Alexander, Holton Hill and Mike Hughes...a portion of each ticket purchased through this special ticket package will go to support the University of Minnesota Masonic Children's Hospital.

LAST START: Struck out a career-high 11 Blue Jays in a 4-1 win last Wednesday, setting a season-low in hits (two) and tying his season-low in runs allowed (one)...allowed just two baserunners through 4.1 IP, a walk and a fielder's choice, before surrendering the lone run of the game on a Billy McKinney solo homer in the fifth...retired five of his final six batters and exited with 88 pitches, 62 strikes.

AGAINST THE HALOS: The right-hander is making his 11th career start against the Angels, first this season...owns a career line of 2-3 with a 4.76 ERA (58.2 IP, 31 ER) against Los Angeles, but has allowed exactly two runs in each of his last five starts...Gibby at home has posted a 3.44 ERA (34.0 IP, 13 ER) with 19 strikeouts, as opposed to his 6.57 ERA (24.2 IP, 18 ER) at Angel Stadium.

MAXIMUM SECURITY: Gibson enter's tonight's start tied for the fifth-most starts (with Boston's Chris Sale) and the eighth-highest innings pitched total in the American League since the beginning of 2014 (914.2)...he also ranks first in opponents grounding into double plays (121) and 16th in strikeouts (696).

MAY FLOWERS: Kyle owns a career record of 6-7, 3.38 ERA (128.0 IP, 48 ER) with 43 walks and 102 strikeouts in the month of May...his 3.38 career ERA and his .246 opponents batting average are both his monthly lows...he went 0-2, 3.75 ERA (36.0 IP, 15 ER) with four home runs, 14 walks and 36 strikeouts while holding opponents to a .237 average in six May starts last season.

RIGHTY-LEFTY SPLITS: Right-handed batters are hitting .224 (15-for-67) against Gibson this season, and lefties are hitting .247 (20-for-81)...below is a breakdown of how he uses each pitch depending on handedness entering tonight's start:

FUN WITH STATCAST: So far through 2019, Gibson has seen the most success with his slider, as opponents are hitting just .150 (6-for-40) against it, and 23 of his 40 strikeouts have come via the slider (54.1 whiff percentage)...conversely, batters have seen success against his curveball, going 4-for-9 with two singles and two home runs (average exit velocity against the curveball).

THE SHERIDAN STORY: Gibson, along with catcher Jason Castro, are proud to support The Sheridan Story, an organization dedicated to fighting child hunger in Minnesota...the innovative organization serves over 6,500 kids in over 200 schools - with the aid of strong community partnerships...Kyle will donate \$100 for every Twins win while Jason will contribute \$250 per victory.

INSIDE EDGE: Below are a couple of statistics about Gibson's 2018 campaign:

- Opponents batted just .157 (13-for-83) against Kyle Gibson's changeup in the 2018 season — 6th best in MLB among starting pitchers with at least 80 IP; League Avg: .232.
- Kyle Gibson allowed a slugging percentage of just .269 (42 Total Bases / 156 ABs) with RISP in the 2018 season — 7th best among qualified SPs in MLB; League Avg: .388.
- Kyle Gibson induced opposing right-handed batters to ground into 20 double plays in 72 opportunities (27.8%) in the 2018 season — best among qualified SPs in MLB; League Avg: 12.2%.

CAREER NOTES

- Named 2018 Charles O. Johnson Award for Most Improved Twin, also Mike Augustin "Media Good Guy" award.
- Since the start of 2014 has induced 121 ground ball double plays, the most in baseball...teammate Martín Pérez is third with 110.
- Finished 2018 with 32 starts; along with José Berríos (32) and Jake Odorizzi (32), they became the first trio of Twins with 30-plus starts in the same season since 2007 (Johan Santana - 33, Carlos Silva - 33 and Boof Bonser - 30).
- Won 50th career game August 11 at Detroit, allowing one run on seven hits in 7.0 innings.
- Recorded double-digit win totals four times in career (13 in 2014, 11 in 2015, 12 in 2017 and 10 in 2018).
- Was given the 2015 Joseph W. Haynes Award for Twins pitcher of the Year as voted on by the Twin Cities chapter of the BBWAA.
- His 2.85 ERA pre-ASG in 2015 was the fourth-lowest for a Twins starter since 1992 with a minimum of 80.0 IP (Liriano - 1.83 in 2006, Santana - 2.75 in 2007, Radke - 2.77 in 1998).
- In 2014, his first full season in the majors, became one of three pitchers in Twins history to win each of their first three games while posting a sub-1.00 ERA.
