LAST START: Was the starter and loser, May 12 vs. Detroit opposite Daniel Norris, allowing three runs on two home runs over just 5.0 IP in a 5-3 Tigers victory...marked his shortest outing as a starter this season, but he did compile seven strikeouts...snapped his winning streak at five games, his longest since a seven-game stretch from August 9-September 8, 2017 (with Texas)... the two home runs allowed matched his total from the previous eight outings (five starts).

### LET'S GET IT STARTED:

- In six starts this season, is 4-1 with a 2.13 ERA (38.0 IP, 9 ER), 9 BB, 34 SO and a .213 opponents average (29-for-136)...five of the six starts have been at least 6.0 IP, with four of them being quality starts.
- Since joining the rotation on April 15, Pérez ranks tied for fifth in baseball in wins (tied with Berríos and Gibson, trailing only Odorizzi, Germán, Verlander and Woodruff), is tied for 11th in innings pitched and 13th in ERA.
- Pérez reached a couple of milestones in his start on May 6, eclipsing 800.0 career innings pitched while also recording his 500th strikeout, becoming just the 19th Venezuelan-born major leaguer to reach the 500-strikeout mark.
- Made three relief appearances prior, pitching to a 7.56 ERA (8.2 IP, 7 ER) on 11 hits, nine walks and 12 strikeouts with a 1-0 record.

**AGAINST THE MARINERS:** Is making his first start and appearance against the Mariners this season...in 21 career games (19 starts) against Seattle, he owns a 7-5 record with a 3.38 ERA (109.1 IP, 41 ER), 41 walks and 73 strikeouts...has seen the M's more than any other opponent

- (109.1) P, 41 EK), 41 Warks and 73 strikeouts...has seen the M'S more than any other opponent in baseball, due to his extensive time as a starter for the Texas Rangers.
  In his last start here in Seattle, Pérez struggled with his command as he allowed five runs (two earned) on one hit and a career-high five walks in just 1.2 innings pitched on September 28 of last year, suffering a 12-6 loss.
  Has a career 3.83 ERA (47.0 IP, 20 ER) in 10 games (9 starts) at T-Mobile Park, but is just 2.4 in these outlones.

**ON THE ROAD AGAIN:** Enters tonight 2-0, 4.08 ERA (17.2 IP, 8 ER) in four games (two starts) away from Target Field...last threw away from home on May 6 in Toronto when he tossed 7.0 shutout innings and set a career-high with nine strikeouts...coming into that start, he owned a 6.75 ERA (10.0 IP, 8 ER) on the road...by comparison, he has gone 3-1, 2.51 ERA (28.2 IP, 8 ER) in five games (4 starts) at home this season.

**REVERSE SPLITS:** Pérez has posted an opponent batting average of .223 (33-for-148) with 11 extra-base hits to right-handed batters this season while lefties are hitting .304 (7-for-23) with no extra-base hits...for his career righties have hit .295 and lefties have hit .244...below is a breakdown of how he has used each pitch depending on handedness this season entering today's start:

   According to Inside Edge, opponents had a groundball rate of 67.3 percent (37/55) against Pérez's changeup in 2018, the highest in Major League Baseball with at least 80.0 IP. Made three starts at three different stops on rehab assignment last season, Single-A Hickory, Double-Frisco and Triple-A Round Rock, going 2-0, 0.52 ERA (17.1 IP, 1 ER).
   Led the Rangers in wins (13-career high), starts (32) and innings (185.0) in 2017, while setting a career-best in strikeouts (115).
- this career-high 198.2 IP in 2016 were the sixth-most by a Texas pitcher age 25-or-younger and the most since José Guzmán in 1988.
- Went 10-6 with a 3.62 ERA (50 ER in 124.1 IP) in 2013, ranking tied for first among American League rookies in wins, second in ERA and third in both starts (20) and quality starts (11). Was named Rangers Nolan Ryan Minor League Pitcher of the Year after combining to go 6-8,
- 2.90 ERA (37 ER in 114.2 IP) with 119 strikeouts in 27 games (19 starts). Entered 2008 as the youngest player in the Northwest League and was rated by Baseball Ameri-ca as the second-best prospect in the NWL, fifth-best in the Rangers' organization.
