THE TWINS: The Twins have gone 4-1 to start their seven-game roadtrip, taking three out of four against the Mariners over the weekend and the first of three with the Angels last night... the Twins will play the second of two tonight in Anaheim, before returning home for a quick five-game homestand, featuring an off-day Thursday, three games against the Chicago White Sox and two against the Milwaukee Brewers...the Twins have won 22 of their last 31, 18 of their last 25 and 14 of their last 20.

SANÓ WITH THE SAVE!: The Twins beat the Angels last night by a score of 3-1...Jake Odorizzi was the starter but did not factor into the decision, pitching 5.0 shutout innings with three hits allowed...the offense recorded 10 hits as Luis Arraez collected three of them, all singles... Miguel Sanó hit his second home run of the season, a two-run shot in the eighth inning to break a 1-1 tie...Blake Parker entered in the ninth inning to earn his eighth save of the season.

GAINING SEPARATION: Minnesota owns a run differential of +76, which trails only the Houston Astros (+95)...they have scored 265 runs in 47 games, their highest total through their first 47 games of any season in franchise history (includes time as Washington Senators)...the previous high was 254 set by the 1925 Senators, who were also shutout just once in their first 47 games.

TWINS AND HALOS: The Twins have gone 3-1 against the Angels this season...a win tonight would secure the season-series for the third time in the last four seasons.
☞ Eddie Rosario is hitting .333/.381/.513 (13-for-39) in his last 10 games vs. LAA.
☞ Marwin Gonzalez is hitting .315 (23-for-73) with nine doubles, three home runs, 12 RBI, 11 walks, a stolen base and a .966 OPS in his last 21 games vs. the Angels.
☞ Jonathan Schoop is hitting .325 (27-for-83) in 24 career games vs. LAA.

SOME LOVE FOR LOUEY: Luis Arraez has hit safely in all three games played so far, going 5-for-8 (.625) with two walks...he has hit safely in 19 of his last 20 games, over three levels of the Twins organization, dating back to the end of April with Double-A Pensacola, Triple-A Rochester and the Twins...in 44 overall games this season, he is hitting .357 (60-for-168) with seven doubles, one triple, 14 RBI, 22 runs scored, 21 walks and a .839 OPS.
☞ He gets the start at third base tonight...he played 15 games at third for Pensacola and two at third for Rochester (all starts).

CLOSING TIME: Former Angel Blake Parker is tied for seventh in the AL with eight saves...he is one of five AL relievers to have not yet blown a save, joining Alex Colome (9-for-9), Shane Greene (15-for-15), Brad Hand (12-for-12) and Roberto Osuna (12-for-12)...as a team only Los Angeles has a better save percentage in the AL; Angels are 12-for-13 (92.3%), while the Twins are 14-for-16 (87.5%).

ROAD WARRIORS: Last night's victory secured another winning roadtrip for the Twins...they have now had winning roadtrips in all four trips this season, going 4-3 at KC, PHI and NYM from April 2-10, going 4-2 at BAL and HOU from April 20-24 and going 4-2 at NYY and TOR from May 3-8...they have gone 16-8 on the road this season for the best away record in baseball.

MARGO STREAKING: Marwin Gonzalez enters today with a season-long 10-game hitting streak, second longest active streak in baseball, trailing Philadelphia's Jean Segura...he is slashing .375/.457/.575 (15-for-40) with two home runs, five RBI, five walks and a 1.032 OPS during the streak...his career-high is 13, done July 15-August 3, 2016 with Houston...in his last 13 games, since May 2, Gonzalez is hitting .379 (22-for-58) with a .989 OPS after starting the season hitting .159 (13-for-82) with a .477 OPS in his first 24 games.

YARD WORK: The Twins have homered in 13 of their last 14 games and have homered in 37 of 47 total games on the season...the Twins have hit 88 home runs, tied with Houston for second most in baseball, trailing Seattle (92)...finally, the Twins lead all of baseball in at-bats-per-home run at 18.31.

QUICK HITTER: Eddie Rosario has gone 28 consecutive at-bats without a strikeout, the second-longest stretch in baseball behind Cincinnati's José Peraza (37)...in his last 10 games, he is slashing .375/.390/.400 (15-for-40) with a double and four RBI in that stretch.

ROLL OUT THE BARREL: Rankings among all players in baseball in Barrels/Plate Appearance%...Jason Castro ranks second at 15.6%, C.J. Cron ranks 13th at 11.8%, Mitch Garver (IL) ranks 22nd at 11.0%, Nelson Cruz (IL) ranks 30th at 10.4%, and Eddie Rosario ranks 60th at 8.5%.

ML PITCHER OF THE WEEK: The Midwest League, MiLB.com and the Minnesota Twins announced yesterday that Single-A Cedar Rapids pitcher Andrew Cabezaz has been named the Midwest League Pitcher of the Week after recently earning Twins organization minor league Pitcher of the Week...on May 15th vs. Quad Cities, Cabezaz allowed one hit and struck out nine over seven innings of work...he was selected by the Twins in the 18th round of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Miami (FL)...Cabezaz is the first Kernel this season to earn MWL weekly honors.

HAPPY BIRTHDAY, HRBIE!: Kent Hrbek is celebrating his 59th birthday today...he played eight games on his birthday during his 14-year career with Minnesota, hitting .240 (6-for-25) with two doubles, one home run and two RBI...he shares a birthday with Bobby Cox (78), Al Franken (68) and Mr. T (67).

LAST START: Pineda earned his third win of the season and his first since April 13 vs. Detroit last Wednesday at Seattle, snapping a five-start winless streak...over 7.0 innings pitched, his longest outing of the season, he allowed three runs (all on solo home runs) on five hits with no walks and six strikeouts...marked his 37th consecutive start with three or less walks dating back to his last game with 3+ walks on July 31, 2016.

• Over 127 career starts, he has lasted 7.0+ innings in only 19 of those starts...owns a 12-5 record with two no-decisions in those 19 games.

WALK HARD: Through nine starts, Pineda has only issued nine walks in 47.0 innings pitched...owns 728 career strikeouts, 166 walks and a lifetime SO/BB ratio of 4.39...he hasn't issued more than three walks since July 31, 2016 at Tampa Bay, a stretch of 37 starts...since 2016, is one of 10 starters with an active streak of 37+ starts and three or less walks (full list below).

AGAINST THE ANGELS: Pineda is making his fifth career start against the Angels and his first since June 20, 2017...he is 1-1, 6.08 ERA (23.2 IP, 16 ER) with six walks and 20 strikeouts in his four career starts...he made his first career start against the Angels, as a member of the Seattle Mariners, July 9, 2011...in his last start against the Angels, back on June 20, 2017 with the New York Yankees, he threw 5.2 innings, allowing three runs (one earned) on seven hits with one walk and seven strikeouts...received a no-decision as the Yankees lost the game 3-8.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: Is 2-1, 4.84 ERA (22.1 IP, 12 ER) with six walks and 23 strikeouts in four road starts this season as opposed to 1-2, 6.20 ERA in five starts at Target Field this season...he carries a lifetime record of 19-25 on the road with a 4.43 ERA, as opposed to a 24-19 record with a 3.89 ERA at home.

THE REPERTOIRE: Coming into 2019, Pineda relied on high-velocity fastball, as referenced by the 59.6 percent (2011), 29.7 (2014), 38.7 (2015), 47.6 (2016) and 47.9 (2017) usage rates for his fastball that averaged 94.1 MPH each year...similarly this season, has thrown the fastball 55.9 percent of the time at 92.1 MPH, despite a 2.0 MPH drop in velocity this season...below is Baseball Savant's breakdown of Pineda's pitches and usage in 2019:

RIGHTY-LEFTY SPLITS: Right-handed batters are batting .308 (37-for-120) against Pineda this season, and lefties are hitting .250 (17-for-68)...below is a breakdown of how he uses each pitch depending on handedness entering today's start:

KEEPING IT ON THE DOWN-LOW: Since his debut in 2011, Pineda has made a living off of striking people out and getting opposing batters to hit the ball into the ground...in fact, dating back to his debut, he has recorded 926 ground balls to his 698 fly balls, a 44.6 percent ground ball rate, the 15th lowest among American League starters currently on a 25-man roster...he also has the 15th lowest ground-ball-to-fly-ball ratio at 1.33, while he has allowed the fifth fewest extra-base hits, yielding 259 (min. 700.0 IP).

TOMORROW'S STARTER - MARTÍN PÉREZ, LHP [SEASON: 5-1, 3.11 ERA ; CAREER: 48-50, 4.55 ERA]

Pérez will be making his eighth start this season tomorrow in the series finale against the Angels...earned the win in his last start, his sixth of the season, May 17 at Seattle...he allowed just one run on five hits over 6.2 IP, marking his fifth quality start on the year, in a 7-1 Twins victory at T-Mobile Park...struck out seven batters for the third time this season, second consecutive outing, and marked his fourth straight start striking out 7+ batters (struck out nine batters May 6 at Toronto)...will be making his 14th career start against the Angels...owns a 4-5 lifetime record with a 4.34 ERA (83.0 IP, 40 ER) with 33 walks and 42 strikeouts...faced the Halos three times as a reliever at the end of last season, but saw them twice as a starter and pitched to a 14.00 ERA (9.0 IP, 14 ER) with three home runs and six walks in those starts.

CAREER NOTES

- Spent the entire 2018 season on the Injured List, recovering from "Tommy John" surgery on right elbow.
- Appeared in four minor league games in 2018, allowing two runs over 12.0 innings pitched.
- Was shut down due to right knee discomfort suffered while throwing a bullpen in late August.
- Struck out 207 batters over 175.2 innings pitched in 2016, setting the fifth-lowest innings total for a pitcher who recorded 200+ strikeouts in American League history.
- Was an AL All-Star in 2011 as a member of the Seattle Mariners, posting a 3.03 ERA (113.0 IP, 38 ER) with 113 strikeouts and an opponents average of .198 in the first half, and finished the year fifth in the AL Rookie of the Year voting.
- In 2011, he became one of 27 rookie pitchers in the Expansion Era (1961-present) to throw at least 171.0 innings and strikeout 173 or more batters, and first since Daisuke Matsuzaka (Boston, 2007).
- Was signed by Seattle as a 16-year-old undrafted free agent December 12, 2005.
- He owns a farm in his native Dominican Republic, where he raises chickens in addition to growing a number of crops.

- Twins relievers have pitched 144.1 innings, 4th fewest in baseball behind the Indians, Nationals & Marlins...bullpen has gone 6-5-14 with 28 holds, a 4.18 ERA (144.1 IP, 67 ER), 62 walks, 153 strikeouts and a .250 opponents' batting average (139-for-556) in 47 games. Twins bullpen is 2nd in baseball in save percentage (87.5%), going 14-for-16 in save opportunities with two blown saves. Two blown saves this season, is tied for 2nd best in MLB w/ White Sox & Marlins, trailing the Angels (1).
