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THE TWINS: The Twins have gone 5-1 over their seven-game roadtrip, taking three out of four against the Mariners last weekend and winning the first two here in Anaheim...the Twins will play the third of three with the Angels tonight before returning home for a quick five-game the weekend and two anainst the Milwauk, Bre grs from Monday-Tuesday the Twins have won 12 of their last 16 and seven of their last eight.

TWINS CALL IT A COMEBACK: The Twins beat the Angels last night by a score of 8-3, erasing an early 3-0 deficit and recording their eighth comeback win of the season....Michael Pineda (4-3) was the starter and winner, allowing three runs on four hits in 6.0 innings pitched... the bullpen combined to pitch 3.0 shutout innings...the offense had 10 hits: Kepler, Polanco, Gonzalez, Rosario and Arraez each with two...Gonzalez tied the game with a two-run homer in rix
the Twins have se 5-6 this month, went 17-10 in March/April, and 15-13 last September....it marks the first time the Twins have had three straight winning months (combining both March/April \& both Sept./Oct.), since 2010 when they went 15-11 in July, 18-10 in August, and 18-12 in Sept./Oct.
TWINNING: The Twins enter today with a 6.5 -game lead over Cleveland in the AL Central...it marks the first time in franchise history the Twins have had a 6.5 -game division lead in May... Sox. the last time the Twins had at least a 6.5 -game lead was when they won the Central in 2010 by 7.0 games on October 2, 2010.

THE RANKINGS: Below is an updated look at where the Twins rank in several offensive categories among all Major League Baseball:

TWINS AND HALOS: The Twins have gone 4-1 against the Angels this season.... a win tonight would give the Twins their first sweep of the Angels since April 15-17, 2016...a win would e

玉 Marwin Gonzalez is hitting . 321 ( 25 -for-78) with 10 doubles, four home runs, 15 RBI, 11 walks, a stolen base and a 1.007 OPS in his last 22 games vs. the Angels.

SOME LOVE FOR LOUEY: Luis Arraez has hit safely in all four games played so far, going 7 -for-12 (.583) with two walks...he has hit safely in 20 of his last 21 games, over three levels of the Twins organization, dating back to the end of April with Double-A Pensacola, Triple-A Rochester and the Twins...in 45 overall games this season, he is hitting . 360 ( 62 -for172) with seven doubles, one triple, one home run, $15 \mathrm{RBI}, 23$ runs scored, 21 walks and a 860 OPS...his home run last night marked the seventh of his professional career in 1,935 plate appearances.
$\Phi$ With seven hits in his first four games, only Kirby Puckett (1984) and Josmil Pinto (2013) had as many in their first four - each with nine hits.
'PEN PALS: The Twins have gone 14 -for-16 in save opportunities for a $87.5 \%$ success rate, the best in baseball...additionally they are tied for fourth in holds (29)...of the eight relievers the Twins currently have in their 'pen, five have ERA's at 2.00-or-less: Blake Parker (1.10), Taylor Rogers (1.33), Ryne Harper (1.77), Mike Morin (1.13), and Matt Magill (1.80)...the eight relievers combined have thrown 104.2 innings for the Twins with a 2.06 ERA and a .213 opponents batting average.

ROAD WARRIORS: With a win tonight, the Twins can collect their sixth victory of the roadtrip which would be their most on a trip since winning seven on a nine-game trip in May of 2018...last time they won six on a seven-game trip came in July of 2010, going 3-1 at Baltimore and 3-0 at Kansas City.
$\Phi$ Twins are hitting . 313 ( 72 -for-230) with 11 doubles, 14 home runs, 18 walks and a .910 OPS on this trip...they have out-scored the opposition 51-22.
$\Phi$ Twins are 17-8 on the road this season, hitting . 287 and have scored 6.60 runs-per-game, all the best in baseball...last season, they finished with a road record of 29-52-26th in baseball, hit .239-19th in baseball, and scored 4.21 runs-per-game - 18th in baseball.

CRON CRUSHIN' IT: C.J. Cron is hitting . 352 (19-for-54) with two doubles, six home runs, 12 RBI, 11 runs scored, five walks and a 1.139 OPS in his last 13 games...since May 8, he is tied with Eddie Rosario and Tommy La Stella for second most hits in the AL, trailing only Jorge Polanco (22)...Cron is hitting just . 150 ( 6 -for-40) with 20 strikeouts in 11 games vs. his former team.

MARGO STREAKING: Marwin Gonzalez enters today with a season-Iong 11-game hitting streak, second longest active streak in baseball, trailing Philadelphia's Jean Segura and longest for a Twin this season....he is slashing .378/.451/.644 (17-for-45) with three doubles, three home runs, eight RBI, five walks and a 1.095 OPS during the streak...his career-high is 13 , done July 15-August 3,2016 with Houston...in his last 16 games, since May 2, Gonzalez is hitting . 381 (24-for-63) with a 1.038 OPS after starting the season hitting . 159 (13-for-82) with a .477 OPS in his first 24 games...lastly, ranks second in the AL in batting average since May 2.

SWEEPS WEEK: The Twins are seeking their sixth sweep of an opponent this season...their previous sweeps came: three games May 6-8 at Toronto, three games April 26-28 vs. Baltimore, three games at Baltimore April 20-21, two games April 13-14 vs. Detroit, and two games April 2-3 at Kansas City...Twins recorded eight sweeps all of last season.

LAST START: Was the starter and winner, getting himself back into the win column with 6.2 innings of one-run ball on May 17 at Seattle, allowing just five hits with seven strikeouts in the 7-1 Twins victory...improved to $8-5$ against the Mariners in his career, lowering his ERA against them to 3.26 .

## LET'S GET IT STARTED:

- In seven starts this season, is 5-1 with a 2.01 ERA (44.2 IP, 10 ER), 13 BB, 41 S0 and a .213 opponents average (34-for-160)...six of the seven starts have been at least 6.0 IP , with five of them being quality starts.
- Since joining the rotation on April 15, Pérez ranks tied for fourth in the Majors in wins (trailing only Odorizzi, Germán and Verlander, is eighth in ERA and tied for 11th in innings pitched.
- Struck out seven Mariners in his last start, marking the fourth consecutive start with seven-or-more strikeouts...became the 13th Twins starter to toss four-or-more consecutive games with 7+ strikeouts, 34th instance...became just the fourth pitcher (14th instance) since 2000.
- Pérez reached a couple of milestones in his start on May 6, eclipsing 800.0 career innings pitched while also recording his 500th strikeout, becoming just the 19th Venezuelan-born major leaguer to reach the 500-strikeout mark.
- Made three relief appearances prior, pitching to a 7.56 ERA (8.2 IP, 7 ER) on 11 hits, nine walks and 12 strikeouts with a 1-0 record.

AGAINST THE ANGELS: Is making his first start and appearance against the Angels this season... in 17 career games ( 13 starts) against Los Angeles, he owns a 4-5 record with a 4.34 ERA (83.0 IP, 40 ER), 33 walks and 42 strikeouts...has seen the Halos more than any other opponent in baseball outside of Seattle and Oakland, due to his time as a starter for the Texas Rangers.

- Struggled against the Angels last season, going 0-2 in five games (two starts) with an 11.12 ERA (11.1 IP, 14 ER)...only made two relief appearances in Anaheim last season, allowing two unearned runs in 1.1 innings of work...last started here on August 24, 2017, throwing 7.0 shutout innings.
- Has a career 4.09 ERA (33.0 IP, 15 ER) in seven games ( 5 starts) at Angel Stadium, but is just 2-3 in those outings.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: Enters tonight 3-0, 3.33 ERA (24.1 IP, 9 ER) in five games (3 starts) away from Target Field...is making his second consecutive start on the road after throwing Friday in Seattle...among Twins starters, he owns the best ERA, the most wins (3) and the second lowest opponents batting average (.216)...by comparison, he has gone 3-1, 2.51 ERA ( $28.2 \mathrm{IP}, 8$ ER) in five games (4 starts) at home this season.

AMONG THE LEAGUE'S BEST: Before joining the starting rotation on April 15, Pérez struggled in three relief outings, allowing seven runs in 8.2 innings pitched...since then, he has compiled a 2.01 ERA (44.2 $1 \mathrm{P}, 10$ ER) with 41 SO....he ranks tied for fourth among American League starters in wins (5), fourth in ERA, tied for fifth in GIDP (5), tied for sixth fewest earned runs allowed (10), 10th in WHIP (1.05) and tied for 15th in strikeouts...in that span, he has received the fourth-highest run support average at 8.26 runs per 9.0 innings.

REVERSE SPLITS: Pérez has posted an opponent batting average of 215 (35-for-163) with 12 extra-base hits to right-handed batters this season while lefties are hitting . 313 (10-for-32) with one extra-base hit...for his career righties have hit . 294 and lefties have hit . 245 .

TURN THE LIGHTS OFF: Pérez has bounced back from his rough 2018 campaign by pitching to a 2.89 ERA (53.0 IP, 18 ER) this season through 10 appearances (seven starts)...he has done his best work when pitching at night, compiling a $5-0$ record with a 2.23 ERA (44.1 IP, 11 ER) with 40 of his 53 strikeouts coming at night....he ranks eighth in baseball (third in the American League) in nighttime ERA, 10th in the AL in strikeouts and 14th in opponents batting average (.225) among AL pitchers...despite the small sample size, he owns a 6.23 ERA ( $8.2 \mathrm{IP}, 6 \mathrm{ER}$ ) in two day appearances (one start).

- Made three starts at three different stops on rehab assignment last season, Single-A Hickory, Double-A

Frisco and Triple-A Round Rock, going 2-0, 0.52 ERA (17.1 IP, 1 ER).

- Led the Rangers in wins ( 13 -career high), starts (32) and innings (185.0) in 2017, while setting a career-best in strikeouts (115).
- His career-high 198.2 IP in 2016 were the sixth-most by a Texas pitcher age 25 -or-younger and the most since José Guzmán in 1988.
- Went $10-6$ with a 3.62 ERA ( 50 ER in 124.1 IP) in 2013, ranking tied for first among American League rookies in wins, second in ERA and third in both starts (20) and quality starts (11).
- Was named Rangers Nolan Ryan Minor League Pitcher of the Year after combining to go 6-8,
2.90 ERA (37 ER in 114.2 IP) with 119 strikeouts in 27 games (19 starts).
