TWINS CLEAN UP THE SOX: The Twins beat the White Sox yesterday afternoon by a score of 7-0, earning their seventh sweep and winning their sixth straight game...Jake Odorizzi (7-2) was the starter and winner, pitching 5.1 shutout innings with one hit, one walk and nine strikeouts... the offense recorded just six hits, their fewest since collecting just four on May 5 at New YorkAL...Max Kepler (12) and Eddie Rosario (16) each homered as Kepler had the only multi-hit game for the Twins...Twins sold out their third game of the season with 39,913 in attendance.

BRING 'EM OUT! BRING 'EM OUT!: Yesterday marked the third sellout of the season, the 164th in Target Field's history and second consecutively...it marked the Twins first back-to-back sellouts since June 20 \& 21, 2015 vs. Chicago-NL, drawing 40,066 and 40,273 respectively...Target Field sellouts through the years: 81 in 2010, 57 in 2011, eight in 2012, six in 2013, none in 2014, six in 2015, one in 2016, one in 2017, one in 2018 and three in 2019
BORDER BATTLE/INTERLEAGUE PLAY: The Twins have gone 2-3 in Interleague Play this season, going 1-2 at Philadelphia April 5-7 and 1-1 in New York April 9-10...they are 213-194 all-time in IL play, the seventh most wins in IL history, trailing Boston (245), New York-AL (240), Los Angeles-AL (228), Texas (222), Oakland (220) and Detroit (214)
© The Twins are 229-222 all-time against the Brewers (games since 1970) and have a record against them of 63-53 in Interleague Play...last season, they went 1-5 vs. the Brewers, going 1-2 at Target Field from May 18-20 and 0-3 at Miller Park from July 2-4. $\Phi$ Eddie Rosario is hitting .325 ( 40 -for-123) with 11 doubles, seven home runs and 18 RBI in his last 30 games vs. NL opponents $\Phi$ Jorge Polanco is hitting . 438 ( 32 -for-73) in his last 19 games against NL teams...has multiple hits in 10 of those games.

LAND OF 10,000 RAKES: The Twins have hit 104 home runs this season, the most in baseball...they are on pace to hit 324 , which would break the major league record of 267 , done by the Yankees last season...the Twins lead basebail with a +43 home run differential, in front of Houston at $+27 \ldots$...the +43 run differential is tied with the 2003 New York Yankees for third best through 52 games in the live-ball era.
FOR STARTERS: This month, Twins starters have gone 17-5, 2.80 ERA (151.0 IP, 47 ER) with 39 walks, 147 strikeouts, an opponent batting average of 234 and an opponent OPS of . 673 ...they also have 14 quality starts among the 25 games started this month...on the season, the Twins have three pitchers with seven wins: Martín Pérez (7-1), José Berríos (7-2) and Jake Odorizzi (7-2)...no other team in baseball has more than one pitcher with seven wins and just five other pitchers have at least seven wins: Domingo Germán (9), Justin Verlander (8), Max Fried (7), Hyun-Jin Ryu (7) and Brandon Woodruff (7).
玉 Three Twins with seven-plus wins within the Twins first 52 marks the first time for the club...three previous times with two starters to have seven-plus: 1972 Bert Blyleven (7) and Jim Kaat (8), 1979 Jerry Koosman (7) and Mike Marshall (8), 2001 Joe Mays (7) and Brad Radke (8).

HAPPY MEMORIAL DAY: The Twins are 20-28 all-time on Memorial Day...last season the Twins beat the Royals in Kansas City on Memoria Day by a score of 8-5...Lance Lynn was the winner and Fernando Rodney earned the save...the offense recorded 12 hits as Brian Dozier recorded three hits and Miguel Sanó hit his sixth home run of the season.

LAST START: Pineda earned his second consecutive win and his fourth of the season on May 21 at Angel Stadium...over 6.0 innings pitched, he allowed three runs (all earned) on four hits with two walks and three strikeouts... has allowed at least one home run in five consecutive starts dating back to April 30 vs. Houston... marked his 38th consecutive start with three or less walks dating back to his last game with 3+ walks on July 31, 2016.

WALK HARD: Through 10 starts, Pineda has only issued 11 walks in 53.0 innings pitched... owns 731 career strikeouts, 168 walks and a lifetime S0/BB ratio of 4.35 ...he hasn't issued more than three walks since July 31, 2016 at Tampa Bay, a stretch of 38 starts...since 2016, is one of 10 starters with an active streak of $38+$ starts and three or less walks (full list below).

AGAINST THE NATIONAL LEAGUE: Pineda is making his first career start against the Brew Crew tonight at Target Field...this will be the 27th team he has faced throughout his six year tenure in the majors... has yet to face the Colorado Rockies, Cincinnati Reds and the San Francisco Giants. - Against National League opponents, Pineda owns a lifetime record of 8-3 (15 starts) with a 2.99 ERA...over 87.1 innings pitched, he has allowed 29 earned runs on 66 hits with 23 walks and 88 strikeouts...over four starts against NL Central opponents, he is 2-0, 2.63 ERA ( $24.0 \mathrm{IP}, 7 \mathrm{ER}$ ) with five walks and 21 strikeouts.

TROUBLE AT HOME: In five home starts this season, Pineda is 1-2, 6.20 ERA (24.2 IP, 17 ER ) with three walks, 18 strikeouts, eight home runs and a .304 ( 31 -for-102) opponents' batting average...on the road, he is $3-1,4.76$ ERA ( $28.1 \mathrm{IP}, 15 \mathrm{ER}$ ) with eight walks, 26 strikeouts and a 250 (27-for-108) batting average against in five starts.

THE REPERTOIRE: Coming into 2019, Pineda relied on high-velocity fastball, as referenced by the 59.6 percent (2011), 29.7 (2014), 38.7 (2015), 47.6 (2016) and 47.9 (2017) usage rates for his fastball that averaged 94.1 MPH each year...similarly this season, has thrown the fastball 55.6 percent of the time at 92.1 MPH , despite a 2.0 MPH drop in velocity this season...below is Baseball Savant's breakdown of Pineda's pitches and usage in 2019:

KEEPING IT ON THE DOWN-LOW: Since his debut in 2011, Pineda has made a living off of striking people out and getting opposing batters to hit the ball into the ground...in fact, dating back to his debut, he has recorded 932 ground balls to his 703 fly balls, a 44.5 percent ground ball rate.

## TOMORROW'S STARTER - MARTíN PÉREZ, LHP [SEASON: 7-I, 2.95 ERA ; CAREER: 50-50, 4.51 ERA]

Pérez is making his ninth start of the season tomorrow evening against the Brewers...in his last outing, May 23 at Los Angeles-AL, he earned his seventh win on the year after allowing two runs on six hits with four walks and three strikeouts over 5.0 innings pitched...marked his seventh start with three or less earned runs...is one of three pitchers on the Twins staff with seven wins, which is tied for third in the American League (Berríos-7 \& Odorizzi-7)...has only faced the Brewers once on September 26, 2016, where he allowed eight runs on nine hits with two home runs, three walks and three strikeouts over 6.2 innings pitched as a member of the Texas Rangers.
