THE TWINS: After completing their five-game homestand with a record of 4-1 (0-3 vs. Chicago-AL and 1-1 vs. Milwaukee), the Twins began their 10-game roadtrip with a loss to the Rays last night...tonight the Twins will play the second of four with the Rays through the weekend... they will enjoy an off-day in Cleveland on Monday, play three vs. the Tribe June 4-6, then three in Detroit June 7-9...the Twins have won 17 of their last 23 and 12 of their last 15 .

DIDN'T RECOGNIZE THOSE TWINS: The Twins lost to the Rays last night by a score of 14-3 matching their largest margin of defeat this season ( $0-11$, April 30 vs. HOU)... 14 runs allowed marked a season-high....Martín Pérez (7-2) was the starter and loser, allowing six runs on six hits in 2.2 innings pitched, all six runs allowed coming in the third inning...the offense recorded seven hits, all coming from the bottom five in the batting order, the top four in the lineup combining to go 0 -for-16.

TWINS-RAYS: The Twins and Rays are playing for the second of seven games this season.. the Twins will host the Rays for three games June 25-27...Twins are just 4-8 in their last 12 vs. the Rays...they are just 7-15 at Tropicana Field in their last 22 here...Twins haven't won a season-series vs. the Rays since going 4-2 in 2015.

THREE POINT LINE: The Twins have scored three-or-more runs in 23 consecutive games, dating back to May 6 at Toronto, and are one game shy of the single-season franchise record (24) set from June 7-July 3, 2006...the stretch marks the ninth time in franchise history with 20 -or-more games scoring three-plus runs in each...the overall franchise record is 30 consecutive games from September 14, 2003-April 23, 2004
\#BOMBASQUAD: The Twins have hit 106 home runs this season, the most in baseball...they are on pace to hit 312 , which would break the major league record of 267 , done by the Yankees last season...the Twins lead baseball with a +41 home run differential, in front of Houston at $+19 \ldots$... $w$ ins have homered in 21 of their last $23 \ldots$...for the season, they are $21-5$ when homering multiple times in game.

YES WAY, JORGE!: Jorge Polanco, who signed a five-year contract extension this offseason to remain with the organization through 2023, has established himself as one of the top offensive shortstops in Twins history....he ranks first in average (.284), slugging (.448), OPS (.791), wOBA (.345), Isolated Power (.164), BABIP (.319) and pitches-per-plate appearance (3.97).
$\Phi$ He has the lowest percentage of swings at the first pitch ( $16.5 \%$ ), and he has the second lowest at-bat/home run percentage ( 39.28 ABs ).玉 He also ranks tied for third in 4+ hit games (7), fourth in percentage of swings with balls put in play ( $44.1 \%$ ) and seventh in XBH (126).玉 Since his debut in 2014, Polanco ranks fourth among all Major League shortstops in batting average, sixth in on-base percentage, seventh in OPS and in swing-miss percentage (15.6)...he's also tied for the fourth-fewest strikeouts in that span (209) with Alexei Ramirez, who hasn't played since 2016, (the only active player with at least 300 games at shortstop and less strikeouts is Miami infielder Miguel Rojas, who has struck out 127 times in 338 games as a shortstop since 2014).

ROSIES ARE RED HOT: Eddie Rosario is hitting .352 ( 32 -for-91) with three doubles, six home runs, 22 RBI and a . 940 OPS in his last 22 games, dating back to May 6 ...for the entire month, he is hitting . 318 (34-for-107) with 23 RBI in 26 games; in May of 2018, Rosario hit. 368 (43-for-117) with 11 doubles, six home runs and 21 RBI in 28 games.
$\Phi$ Career . 388 (31-for-80) with six doubles, one triple, five home runs, 16 RBI and a 1.105 OPS in 22 career games vs. the Rays.

JOSE BERRIGS

- He is making his 12th start and appearance of 2019.
- He is making his 83rd career start and 84th career appearance.


LAST STOP CHICAGO: In his last start May 24 vs. the White Sox at Target Field, Berríos earned his seventh win of the season and his first in his last three starts, tying Martín Pérez for the team-lead...earned his eighth quality start on the year, marking the most through his first 11 starts of any year in his career.

- Allowed just one earned run, his third start this season allowing one or less earned runs in a start, first since his 7.0 shutout innings on May 7 at Toronto.

TAKING ON TAMPA BAY: Berríos is making just his fourth career appearance against Tampa Bay, and his third at Tropicana Field... his last start against the Rays came on July 14, 2018 at Target Field, he was dealt the no-decision after allowing six runs on six hits in 6.0 innings with five strikeouts...Berríos is 8-6, 4.510 ERA ( 105.0 IP, 48 ER ) with 33 walks and 106 strikeouts in his career against the AL East.

THE TERRIFIC TRIO: Berríos has won seven games this season joining Jake Odorizzi and Martín Pérez as the only trio of pitchers in Twins history to win seven decisions within the team's first 55 games of any season...marks just the fourth time in Twins history with multiple $7+$ wins through 55 games joining: Joe Mays (7) and Brad Radke (7) in 2001, Mike Marshall (8) and Jerry Koosman (7) in 1979 and Jim Kaat (8) and Bert Blyleven (7) in 1972.

NO FREE PASSES: Entering tonight's start, Berríos has only walked 11 batters this year, which is tied for the fewest in the AL among starters with at least 49.0 innings pitched...his $\mathrm{BB} / 9$ rate is 1.41 , which ranks as the best in the AL and third best in all of baseball behind Zack Greinke of the Diamondbacks (1.27) and Hyun-Jin Ryu of the Dodgers (0.67)...has five starts without walking a batter this season, and has yet to walk more than three batters in his 11 starts, the last time coming September 28,2018 vs. CWS where he walked four.

ROAD WOES: In 43 career road starts, Berríos is $13-17$ with a 5.11 ERA over 229.0 innings...of the 61 home runs Berríos has surrendered in his career, 43 have been at opposing ballparks... owned a 3-7 away record in 2018 with a 4.85 ERA ( 85.1 IP, 46 ER).

- However, has a 3.82 ERA ( 30.2 IP, 3 ER) with only six walks and 27 strikeouts in five road starts this year... has pitched at least $6.0+$ innings in all but one outings.

LEADERBOARD LOVE: Berríos leads Twins starters in innings pitched (70.1), strikeouts (64), quality starts ( 8 ) and $\mathrm{BB} / 9$ ratio ( 1.41 ), while he is second behind Odorizzi ( 0.99 ) in WHIP (1.15). - Among American League starters, Berríos is tied for third in quality starts (8) behind Matthew Boyd (9) and Justin Verlander (10) and is tied for third in wins (7).

PITCH SELECTION: José is throwing his curveball this season at a 32.7 percent usage rate...in 2018 he threw it 30.4 percent of time, 30 percent in 2017 and 21.6 in 2016 ...he has thrown a total of 1,067 pitches on the year with 52.4 percent of those landing in the strike zone...below is the breakdown of his 2019 pitch arsenal, according to Baseball Savant:

    Gibson is making his 11th start of the season tomorrow and his fifth career start at Tropicana Field...in his last start May 25 vs. CWS, he earned his fifth win of the season after throwing 7.0 innings of five-hit baseball allowing just one run, one walk and sat down nine batters...seventh time in his career with nine-plus strikeouts and second outing this season with one run allowed in 7.0 innings, the other was April 28 vs. Baltimore...in his career against Tampa Bay, he is 2-5, 5.80 ERA ( 45.0 IP, 29 ER) with 18 walks and 31 strikeouts...his last outing vs. the Rays came July 12 of last season where he earned the win after allowing just one run on five hits with no walks and nine strikeouts.
