THE TWINS: The Twins have gone 3-2 through five games on their six-game roadtrip...tonigh they will complete the trip with the third of three north of the border...the Twins began their roadtrip with a series loss in New York, winning the middle of the three games last weekend... tonight they will fly home post-game to enjoy an off-day tomorrow, followed by four vs. the Tigers at Target Field (DH on Saturday) and three against the Angels next week...the Twins have won eight of their last 11 and 13 of their last 18.

TWINS TAKE TORONTO AGAIN: The Twins beat the Blue Jays on Tuesday night by a score of 3-0, their fourth shutout this season and second consecutively...it marked the Twins first consecutive shutouts since June 2 and 4, 2013 vs. SEA and at KC...they have recorded three straight shutouts once in club history, coming July 5-7, 2004 vs. Kansas City.... Oosé Berríos (6-1) was the starter and winner, pitching 7.0 shutout innings, with four hits, no walks and five strikeouts...Mitch Garver had three of the Twins eight hits, including his seventh home run.

MINNESOTA WINS: The Twins enter tonight with the second best winning percentage in baseball, having gone 22-12, $647 \ldots$...the Twins won their 22nd game of 2018 on May 28 , beating Kansas City $8-5$... below is where the Twins rank in baseball in terms of winning percentage:


NOTE: The Twins are 10 games over 500 for the first time since being $50-40$ on July 17, 2015.
FOR STARTERS: Through seven games this month, Twins starters have combined to go 5-2, 1.40 ERA (45.0 IP, 7 ER) with 13 walks, 47 strikeouts a .200 opponent batting average, three home runs and a .538 OPS....below are where Twins starters rank in the AL during May: $\begin{array}{ccccccc}\text { WINS } & \text { IP } & \text { ERA } & \text { BAA } & \text { K } & \text { OPS } & \text { WHIP } \\ 5 \text { (1st) } & 45.0 \text { (2nd) } & 1.40 \text { (1st) } & .200 \text { (2nd) } & 47 \text { (1st) } & .538 \text { (2nd) } & 1.00 \text { (3rd) }\end{array}$ NOTE: Twins pitchers enter tonight with a 22.0 inning scoreless streak...their last streak as long came July 12-18, 2015 (also 22.0)...their last streak longer that 22.0, came July 30-August 2, 2010 (23.0).

TWINS-JAYS: The Twins are playing the seventh and final game vs. the Blue Jays this season...a win tonight would give the Twins the season series over the Blue Jays for the third straight time, going 4-2 last season and 4-3 in 2017...the Twins have gone just 25-42 vs. the Jays since 2010, but have gone 7-3 in their last 10, dating back to May 2018.
玉 Eddie Rosario is hitting . 328 (19-for-58) with nine home runs, 15 RBI, 14 runs scored and a 1.175 OPS in his last 14 games vs. the Blue Jays.
$\Phi$ Byron Buxton is hitting . 333 (17-for-51) with four doubles, five home runs, 12 RBI \& a 1.088 OPS in 13 career games vs. the Jays...he is hitting . 381 ( 8 -for-21) at Rogers Centre. $\Phi$ Nelson Cruz is hitting 297 (107-for-360) with 19 doubles, 25 home runs, 88 RBI and a

$\Phi$ Jonathan Schoop has 82 hits ( 35 extra-base hits) against the Jays, his most off any opponent, and 14 home runs in his career vs. Toronto, his second-most off any opponent (15-Tampa Bay)
$\Phi$ Twins have hit 31 home runs off Jays pitching since the start of 2017, their second-most vs. any non-divisional opponent (Baltimore $-40,23$ this season).
BACKSTOPS WITH THE BATS: Catchers Willians Astudillo (IL), Jason Castro and Mitch Garver have combined to hit . 336 (38-for-113) with nine doubles, 12 home runs, 29 RBI and 30 runs scored when catching....at catcher, Garver has made 15 starts, Castro has made 15 starts, while Astudillo has made four starts...where those three combined offensive numbers rank in baseball compared to other team's catchers: first in home runs (12), slugging percentage (.735), OPS (1.147) and batting average (.336), second in OBP (.412), third in RBI (29), and tied for fifth in doubles (9).

BRING A BROOM: The Twins are seeking their fifth sweep of an opponent this season...their previous sweeps came: three games April $26-28$ vs. Baltimore, three games at Baltimore April 20-21, two games April 13-14 vs. Detroit, and two games April 2-3 at Kansas City... the Twins last sweep of Toronto came July 23-25, 2018 at Rogers Centre in three games.
ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 1984, Twins rookie Kirby Puckett hit four singles in his first major league game, becoming the ninth player in history to collect four hits in his first 9-inning game...the Twins ended up winning 5-0 over the Angels, getting a homer from current FS North analyst Tim Laudner.

$\Phi$ The Twins have used a defensive shift 245 times in 426 plate appearances ( $57.5 \%$ shift rate) vs right-handed batters this season -- highest in MLB; League Avg: 22.5\%.
$\mp$ Kyle Gibson has induced opposing right-handed batters to ground into 21 double plays in 83 opportunities ( $25.3 \%$ ) since the start of last season -- best among qualified SPs in MLB; League Avg: $12.1 \%$.
$\Phi$ Kyle Gibson has walked 3 of 75 left-handed batters (4.0\%) this season -- 4th best among qualified SPs in MLB; League Avg: 9.0\%. $\Phi$ Kyle Gibson has recorded 10 of his 15 strikeouts ( $66.7 \%$ ) vs right-handed batters with his slider this season -- 7th highest in MLB among starting pitchers with at least 16.0 IP; League Avg: 26.2\%.

LAST START: The big right-hander dealt his first loss of the season at New York-AL on May 3 , which snapped his eight-start unbeaten streak (since $9 / 16 / 18$ )...he tossed 5.0 innings and allowed two runs on seven hits with two walks and five strikeouts.... is now winless in his last seven starts against the Yankees, going 0-5 with a 5.86 ERA ( 35.1 IP, 23 ER) over the span (since $7 / 4 / 14$ )...has allowed two ER-or-fewer in three straight starts.

- Surrendered his first home run to a right-handed batter this season in the fifth inning to Gary Sánchez, who was also the last RHB to homer off of Gibson on 9/10/18.

AGAINST THE JAYS: Gibby is making his second start against the Jays this season, with the other coming on April 16 at Target Field, when he threw 5.1 innings, allowing four runs on four hits with three walks and four strikeouts and received a no-decision in a 5-6 loss...in eight career starts vs. Toronto, he is 3-1, 5.01 ERA (46.2 IP, 26 ER) with 22 walks and 37 strikeouts....his last outing at Rogers Centre came August 27, 2017, when he allowed two runs on seven hits with one walk and seven strikeouts over 6.2 innings pitched

- His 7.56 ERA at Rogers Centre is his second-highest of any stadium in baseball, trailing only Nationals Park, where he allowed seven runs in 3.0 IP on April 22, 2016 ( 21.00 ERA).

NIGHT VS. DAY: Gibson is making his fourth night start on the season...carries a record of 34-33, 4.34 ERA ( 568.0 IP, 274 ER) with 199 walks and 430 strikeouts with opponents hitting . 268 in 96 career night starts...conversely, is 22-29, 4.66 ERA (391.2 IP, 203 ER) with 147 walks and 284 strikeouts and a 271 opponents average in 69 day starts...this season he is $0-1$ with eight walks and 15 strikeouts in three night starts as opposed to $2-0$ with two walks and 14 strikeouts in three day starts

MAY FLOWERS: Kyle owns a career record of 5-7, 3.47 ERA (122.0 IP, 47 ER) with 42 walks and 91 strikeouts in the month of May....his 3.47 career ERA in that month marks his lowest out of any month and his .253 opponent batting average in May is also his lowest...he went $0-2,3.75$ ERA ( 36.0 IP, 15 ER ) with four home runs, 14 walks and 36 strikeouts while holding opponents to a .237 average in six May starts last season.

PITCH ARSENAL: Gibson's 21.5 percent usage rate of his slider is the most he's thrown that pitch since 2014, when it was logged at 21.9 percent...in 2018, he threw it 20.8 percent of time, 17.2 percent in 2017, 18.2 percent in 2016 and 18.5 in 2015...below is the breakdown of his 2019 pitches according to Baseball Savant

LEFT AND RIGHT: He has held right-handed hitters to a 250 ( 15 -for-60) average with just one home run, seven walks, 15 strikeouts and a .328 0BP this season, while lefties have hit . 265 (18-for-68) with four home runs, 14 strikeouts and a .315 0BP...for his career, righties have hit . 255 (466-for1825) with 156 walks and 402 strikeouts, while lefties have hit .283 ( 534 -for-1886) with 190 walks and 312 strikeouts.

- He has induced opposing right-handed batters to ground into 21 double plays in 83 opportunities $(25.3 \%)$ since the start of last season -- best among qualified SPs in MLB; League Avg: $12.1 \%$. - Has also walked three of 75 left-handed batters (4.0\%) this season -- 4th best among qualified SPs in MLB; League Avg: 9.0\%.

THAT'S KYLE WITH A 'K': Gibson has improved his strikeouts-per- 9.0 innings rate nearly every year in his career, peaking in 2018 by fanning 8.19 batters-per- 9.0 innings (196.2 IP, 179 SO)...currently sits at 7.99 ( 32.2 IP, 29 SO).

THE SHERIDAN STORY: Gibson, along with catcher Jason Castro, are proud to support The Sheridan Story, an organization dedicated to fighting child hunger in Minnesota...the innovative organization serves over 6,500 kids in over 200 schools - with the aid of strong community partnerships...Kyle will donate $\$ 100$ for every Twins win while Jason will contribute $\$ 250$ per victory.

## CAREER NOTES

- Named 2018 Charles 0. Johnson Award for Most Improved Twin, also Mike Augustin "Media Good Guy" award.
- Since the start of 2014 has induced 121 ground ball double plays, the most in baseball...teammate Martín Pérez is third with 110.
- Finished 2018 with 32 starts; along with José Berríos (32) and Jake Odorizzi (32), they became the first trio of Twins with 30-plus starts in the same season since 2007 (Johan Santana - 33, Carlos Silva - 33 and Boof Bonser - 30)
- Won 50th career game August 11 at Detroit, allowing one run on seven hits in 7.0 innings. - Recorded double-digit win totals four times in career ( 13 in 2014, 11 in 2015, 12 in 2017 and 10 in 2018).
- Was given the 2015 Joseph W. Haynes Award for Twins pitcher of the Year as voted on by the Twin Cities chapter of the BBWAA.
- His 2.85 ERA pre-ASG in 2015 was the fourth-lowest for a Twins starter since 1992 with a minimum of 80.0 IP (Liriano - 1.83 in 2006, Santana - 2.75 in 2007, Radke - 2.77 in 1998).
- In 2014, his first full season in the majors, became one of three pitchers in Twins history to win each
of their first three games while posting a sub-1.00 ERA.
