**THE TWINS:** After completing their 10-game roadtrip with a record of 6-4 (3-1 vs. Tampa Bay, 1-2 vs. Cleveland and 2-1 vs. Detroit), the Twins began their nine-game homestand with a win over Seattle last night...tonight they will play the second of three with the Mariners then finish the three-game series tomorrow afternoon...following this series, the Twins will host Kansas City for three over the weekend then Boston for three from Monday-Wednesday...the Twins have won 14 of their last 19 and 19 of their last 25...the Twins are at their 2019 high-water mark of 23 games over .500, their highest since finishing the 2010 season 26 games over (.94-68).

**GO GONZO, MARWIN WINS IT:** The Twins beat the Mariners last night by a score of 6-5, scoring three runs in the eighth inning, erasing a two-run deficit, marking their 13th comeback win this season...Martín Pérez was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing four runs on six hits in 5.0 innings pitched...the offense recorded nine hits, three from Jorge Polanco, who doubled twice...the Twins hit back-to-back home runs in the fourth inning with homers from Jonathan Schoop (12) and Jason Castro (8); it marked the seventh back-to-back homers in 2019, tied for sixth most in club history for a single season.

**POLO ON THE MARK:** Last night Jorge Polanco extended his career-long on-base streak to 25 straight games, dating back to May 13, hitting .365 (38-for-104) with a .414 on-base percentage...marks the longest Twins streak since Brian Dozier reached in 34 straight from September 12, 2017-April 23, 2018...he has now hit in 12 straight games, the second longest of his career, his best being 13 games from May 20-August 11, 2016...the streak marks the longest by a Twin this season and longest active streak in baseball...below are his AL rankings on the season:

**TWINS AND M'S:** The Twins and Mariners are playing the sixth of seven games this season...last night's win secured the season series, their first over Seattle since 2016 (4-2)...the Twins are looking to win back-to-back series vs. the Mariners for the first time since July 7-10, 2014 and April 24-26, 2015.

- ☞ C.J. Cron is hitting .305 (25-for-82) with seven home runs, 13 RBI and 17 runs scored in his last 21 vs. the Mariners.
- ☞ Marwin Gonzalez is hitting .324 (101-for-312) with 22 doubles, 18 home runs, 44 RBI and a .938 OPS in 93 career games vs. the Mariners...he has hit safely in 11 straight games against Seattle, hitting .391 (18-for-46) during that span.
- ☞ Miguel Sanó has nine career homers vs. SEA, his most vs. any non AL Central opponent...he has the second highest OPS (1.059) among actives vs. the Mariners.
- ☞ Eddie Rosario is hitting .338 (23-for-68) with five doubles, one triple, five home runs, 12 RBI and a 1.028 OPS in 19 career games against Seattle...he has 11 hits in his last six games vs. the Mariners.

**SOUND THE BOMBA HORN:** The Twins have hit 127 home runs this season, tied with Seattle for the most in baseball...they are on pace to hit 316, which would mark a major league record...Twins have homered in all nine games this month, totaling 21 in June, third most in baseball, trailing Seattle (24) and Atlanta (23).

- ☞ 45.7 percent of the Twins hits have gone for extra bases, the highest in baseball.
- ☞ Minnesota has seven players with at least 10 home runs this season, most in baseball (Buxton and Castro each have 8)...the Twins had seven such players all of last season...the only other team with more than five such players this season is Seattle (6).
- ☞ Twins have partnered with Prostate Cancer Foundation for Home Run Challenge, starting last night through Sunday...the organization will donate \$7,500 for each homer by a Twins player and \$1,000 for each strikeout by a Twins pitcher...the running total is at \$25,000.

**BACKSTOPS WITH THE BATS:** Catchers Willians Astudillo (now at AAA), Jason Castro and Mitch Garver have combined to hit .309 (71-for-230) with 15 doubles, 19 home runs, 49 RBI, 24 walks and 55 runs scored when catching...at catcher, Castro has made 30 starts, Garver has made 23 starts, while Astudillo has made 12 starts...where those three combined offensive numbers rank in baseball compared to other team's catchers: first in home runs (19), slugging percentage (.630), OPS (1.017), batting average (.309), RBI (49) and OBP (.386), tied for first in hits (71), and tied for fourth in doubles (15).

- ☞ The 1.017 OPS from the catching spot is the highest in club history...next being .931 in 2009 when Joe Mauer was the primary catcher and eventual AL MVP.

**DID I CATCH A 'NINER' IN THERE?:** Byron Buxton is hitting .367 (11-for-30) with two doubles, three home runs and seven RBI in nine games this month, hitting in the ninth spot of the order in each game...where he ranks from the ninth spot in the batting order among all of baseball: hits - 1st (50), doubles - 1st (19), home runs - 1st (8), RBI - 1st (35), runs - 1st (31), walks - 2nd (12), OPS - 2nd (.847).

- ☞ Left-handed batters are hitting just .069 (2-for-29) against José Berríos in his last two starts -- best in MLB over the last two weeks; League Avg: .261
- ☞ José Berríos has thrown his curveball 40.7% of the time (261/642) vs right-handed batters this season -- highest among qualified SPs in MLB; League Avg: 15.1%
- ☞ Opponents have a chase percentage of 50.2% (112/223) against José Berríos with two strikes this season -- 4th highest in MLB among starting pitchers with at least 32 IP; League Avg: 39.3%

**ANOTHER (W)ON:** In his last outing, June 6 at Cleveland, Berríos allowed two runs (one earned) on two hits with one walk and six strikeouts over 6.0 innings, earning his eighth win of the season (a 5-4 victory)...he allowed two-or-fewer hits for the third time this season (last, April 7 at Philadelphia) and yielded one-or-fewer earned runs for the fourth time (last, May 24 vs. Chicago-AL)...has walked one-or-fewer batters in nine of his 13 starts.

• With the win, Berríos and right-handed starter, Jake Odorizzi, became the third Twins duo to each have recorded eight wins through 61 team games, joining Jim Kaat and Bert Blyleven, who turned the trick twice in 1972 and 1973, as well as Jack Morris (8) and Scott Erickson (10) in 1991.

**AGAINST THE MARINERS:** This will be Berríos' fifth career start against the Mariners, going 1-2 with a 4.74 ERA (24.2 IP, 13 ER) over his previous four starts...his most recent start came May 18, when, despite having been given a 15-0 lead, he had a no-decision after throwing 4.2 innings and surrendering four runs on four hits while striking out six...his lone win came on June 15, 2017, his first start against the Mariners, (went 8.0 innings and allowed just two runs on five hits with one walk and six strikeouts)...currently has a two game-losing streak against Seattle, dating back to April 7 of last season...he is looking to earn his second win in his third game vs. Seattle at Target Field.

**DELIVERING QUALITY:** Berríos is tied for second in the American League behind Justin Verlander (12) with 10 quality starts (tied for fifth-most in baseball), while 11 out of his 13 starts have gone at least 6.0 innings (including four 7.0+ inning efforts).

- His 10 quality starts through his first 13 marks the best start of his career...in 2018 he had seven through his first 13, in 2017 he recorded eight and in 2016 he he posted one quality start.
- Left handed batters are hitting just .069 (2-for-29) in his last two starts (two games) which ranks the best in baseball over the last two weeks...the league average is .261.

**NO FREE PASSES:** Entering tonight's start, Berríos has only walked 15 batters this year, which is tied for the fewest in the AL among starters with at least 65.0 innings pitched...his BB/9 rate is 1.63, which ranks fifth best in the AL and is 10th best in baseball...has five starts without walking a batter this season, and has yet to walk more than three batters in his 13 starts, the last time coming September 28, 2018 vs. CWS where he walked four.

**JOSÉ'S HOME TURF:** In six starts at home this season, Berríos is 5-1, 2.72 ERA (39.2 IP, 12 ER) with 37 strikeouts...compared to going 3-1, 3.53 ERA (43.1 IP, 17 ER) with 41 strikeouts away from Target Field...he began the season 4-0 in his first four starts at home but has since gone 2-1 in his last three...has 23 career wins at Target Field, second to only Kyle Gibson since its inception in 2010...below is a chart of all-time wins at Target Field:

**PITCH SELECTION:** José is throwing his curveball this season at a 31.7 percent usage rate...in 2018 he threw it 30.4 percent of time, 30 percent in 2017 and 21.6 in 2016...he has thrown a total of 1,273 pitches on the year with 51.4 percent of those landing in the strike zone...below is the breakdown of his 2019 pitch arsenal, according to Baseball Savant:
