THE TWINS: The Twins have gone 4-3 through seven games on their 10-game roadtrip, going 3-1 in St. Petersburg and 1-2 in Cleveland...tonight the Twins will play the first of three at Comerica Park against the Tigers over the weekend...the Twins have won 11 of their last 15 and 16 of their last 21...Twins are 12-5 vs. the AL Central this season; 10 of the next 16 games are against the division.

THE MAX KEPLER GAME: The Twins beat the Indians last night at Progressive Field by a score of 5-4, avoiding the three-game sweep...José Berríos (8-2) was the starter and winner, allowing two runs (1 earned) on two hits, one walk and six strikeouts...the offense recorded seven hits, four from Max Kepler, who homered three times and singled...it marked the second three-homer game of his career and 10th all-time for the Twins.

BIG MIKE BACK, SMELTZ SENT OUT: The Twins announced today that they have reinstated right-handed pitcher Michael Pineda from the 10-day Injured List...Pineda, who missed the Twins last eight games with right knee tendinitis, has made 11 starts this season, going 4-3 with a 5.34 ERA (59.0 IP, 35 ER), 11 walks and 50 strikeouts...to make room for Pineda on the 25-man roster, the Twins have optioned left-handed pitcher Devin Smeltzer to Triple-A Rochester...Smeltzer made two starts for the Twins, going 0-1 with a 3.65 ERA (12.1 IP, 5 ER), three walks and nine strikeouts.

NOTE: As a team, the Twins are hitting .266 (351-for-1320) the first time through the lineup, .294 (145-for-493) the second time through and .261 (71-for-272) the third time through...the Twins lead baseball in third inning runs...their OBP (.363) the second time through the lineup is best in baseball.

TWINS AND TIGERS: The Twins are playing the seventh of 19 games against the Tigers this season...they have gone 5-1 vs. Detroit thus far...Twins have won six of their last eight over the Tigers and 10 of their last 13, dating back to August 19...the Twins last series at Comerica Park came September 17-19, sweeping in three...they are 10-4 in their last 14 here.

- ☞ C.J. Cron is hitting .310 (18-for-58) with four doubles, six home runs and 17 RBI in his last 14 games vs. Detroit...he has 10 RBI in his last seven games vs. DET.
- ☞ Nelson Cruz is hitting .333 (27-for-81) with six doubles, five home runs, 16 RBI and a 1.034 OPS in his last 22 vs. the Tigers.
- ☞ Jorge Polanco has 14 RBI in his last 15 games against the Tigers.
- ☞ Twins have scored 130 runs against the Tigers since the start of last season, their most for any opponent...also the most Tigers pitchers have allowed to any team since.

YES WAY, JORGE!: Last night Jorge Polanco extended his career-long on-base streak to 21 straight games, dating back to May 13, hitting .356 (31-for-87) with a .412 on-base percentage...marks the longest Twins streak since Logan Morrison, 23 from April 20-May 16, 2018...Polanco is tied for first in the AL in hits (78), second in average (.336), and sixth in OPS (.982).

THE LEFTORIUM: The Twins are facing two left-handed starters in this series...as a team, they are hitting .301 (141-for-468) with 22 doubles, 23 home runs, 44 walks and a .873 OPS vs. lefties this season...they lead baseball in both batting average and OPS vs. left-handed starters this season.

- ☞ Individuals vs. LHP this season: Mitch Garver is hitting .385 (10-for-26)...C.J. Cron is hitting .364 (16-for-44) with five home runs...Byron Buxton is hitting .350 (14-for-40)...Jorge Polanco is hitting .322 (19-for-59).

#BOMBASQUAD: The Twins have hit 117 home runs this season, the most in baseball...they are on pace to hit 310, which would break the major league record of 267, done by the Yankees last season...they lead baseball in both home runs-per-game (1.92) and at-bats-per-home runs (17.95)...the Twins have 61 home runs over 400 feet this season, the most in baseball.

FOR STARTERS: Since the start of May, Twins starting pitchers have combined to go 20-7, 3.01 ERA (200.1 IP, 67 ER) with 192 strikeouts, a .227 opponent batting average and .661 opponent OPS...for the entire season, the Twins starting staff ranks third in baseball in ERA (3.52), wins (41) and quality starts (31), and fifth in opponent OPS (.709).

TENACIOUS D: The Twins defense ranks fifth in all of baseball in defensive runs saved (34), trailing Los Angeles-NL (75), Houston (58), Arizona (45) and Tampa Bay (43)...additionally, they rank fourth in OOB (Out of Zone Plays Made) with 251, trailing Houston (263), Baltimore (263) and Arizona (258).

- ☞ OOB reflects the number of plays a fielder makes on balls that were hit outside his "zone"... zone is considered parts of the field in which on average the fielder is able to convert half their chances to outs...Jorge Polanco leads the club with 46 out-of-zone plays made - 7th in AL, ahead of Byron Buxton with 37 - 12th in the AL.

BIG MIKE RETURNS: Pineda has been reinstated from the 10-day Injured List today...he missed the Twins last eight games with right knee tendinitis.

- In his last four starts, is 2-0, 4.32 ERA (25.0 IP, 12 ER) with two walks, 20 strikeouts and a .196 average against (18-for-92)...however, seven of 18 hits allowed have been homers.

LAST START: Pineda made his first career start vs. the Brewers on May 27 and turned in his fourth-straight quality start after allowing three runs on three hits with no walks and six strikeouts...did not give up a walk for the fourth time this season and marks his 39th straight start without issuing three or more walks, dating back to July 31, 2016 at Tampa Bay.

WALK HARD: Through 11 starts, Pineda has only issued 11 walks in 59.0 innings pitched...owns 737 career strikeouts, 168 walks and a lifetime SO/BB ratio of 4.39...he hasn't issued more than three walks since July 31, 2016 at Tampa Bay, a stretch of 39 starts...since 2016, is one of nine starters with an active streak of 38+ starts and three or less walks (full list below).

AGAINST THE TIGERS: Pineda will be making his seventh career start against Detroit and his third of the season...is 2-2, 4.11 ERA (35.0 IP, 16 ER) with six walks and 39 strikeouts in his career...is 1-0, 4.50 ERA (12.0 IP, 6 ER) in two starts this year (both at Target Field).

- Last time out against the Tigers was May 11 of this season...took a no-decision after allowing three runs on six hits and zero walks with five strikeouts over 6.0 innings of work.
- Last win at Comerica Park came June, 2 2016 as a member of the Mariners, allowed one run on seven hits with zero walks and eight strikeouts over 5.2 innings..

ROAD SUCCESS: In five road starts this season, Pineda is 3-1, 4.76 ERA (28.1 IP, 15 ER) with eight walks, 26 strikeouts, six home runs and a .250 (27-for-108) opponents' batting average...at home, he is 1-2, 5.87 ERA (30.2 IP, 20 ER) with three walks, 24 strikeouts and a .281 (34-for-121) batting average against in six starts.

THE REPERTOIRE: Coming into 2019, Pineda relied on high-velocity fastball, as referenced by the 59.6 percent (2011), 29.7 (2014), 38.7 (2015), 47.6 (2016) and 47.9 (2017) usage rates for his fastball that averaged 94.1 MPH each year...similarly this season, has thrown the fastball 55.6 percent of the time, despite a 2.0 MPH drop in velocity this season (92.1)...below is Baseball Savant's breakdown of Pineda's pitches and usage in 2019:

KEEPING IT ON THE DOWN-LOW: Since his debut in 2011, Pineda has made a living off of striking people out and getting opposing batters to hit the ball into the ground...in fact, dating back to his debut, he has recorded 932 ground balls to his 703 fly balls, a 44.5 percent ground ball rate.

CAREER NOTES

- Spent the entire 2018 season on the Injured List, recovering from "Tommy John" surgery on right elbow.
- Appeared in four minor league games in 2018, allowing two runs over 12.0 innings pitched.
- Was shut down due to right knee discomfort suffered while throwing a bullpen in late August.
- Struck out 207 batters over 175.2 innings pitched in 2016, setting the fifth-lowest innings total for a pitcher who recorded 200+ strikeouts in American League history.
- Was an AL All-Star in 2011 as a member of the Seattle Mariners, posting a 3.03 ERA (113.0 IP, 38 ER) with 113 strikeouts and an opponents average of .198 in the first half, and finished the year fifth in the AL Rookie of the Year voting.
- In 2011, he became one of 27 rookie pitchers in the Expansion Era (1961-present) to throw at least 171.0 innings and strikeout 173 or more batters, and first since Daisuke Matsuzaka (Boston, 2007).
- Was signed by Seattle as a 16-year-old undrafted free agent December 12, 2005.
- He owns a farm in his native Dominican Republic, where he raises chickens in addition to growing a number of crops.
