THE TWINS: The Twins have gone 4-3 through seven games on their nine-game homestand, going 2-1 vs. the Mariners, 2-1 vs. the Royals and 0-1 vs. the Red Sox...tonight the Twins will play the second of three games with Boston...they will wrap the series tomorrow night before traveling to Kansas City for four through the weekend...the Twins have won 7 of their last 11, 17 of their last 25 and 22 of their last 31.

TWINS SUFFER RARE SHUTOUT: The Twins lost to the Red Sox last night at Target Field by a score of 2-0, suffering their second shutout this season (the other 4/30 vs. HOU)...José Berríos (8-3) was the starter and loser, allowing one run on five hits in 8.0 innings pitched with no walks and 10 strikeouts...the offense recorded just five hits, their 12th time this season with five hits-or-fewer...the Twins went 0-for-5 with RISP and left seven men on base.

POLO ON THE MARK: Yesterday Jorge Polanco extended his career-long on-base streak to 31 straight games, dating back to May 13, hitting .341 (44-for-129) with a .396 on-base percentage...marks the longest Twins streak since Brian Dozier reached in 34 straight from September 12, 2017-April 23, 2018...below are the longest on-base streaks in baseball this season:

ADDITIONAL NOTE: Polanco's 31-game streak is tied for 16th best in club history (since 1961), the all-time long being 43 by Joe Mauer from August 7-September 24, 2015.

SHORT SLIDE: The Twins are looking to avoid losing three straight tonight for the first time all season...they have lost two straight five different times...they are the only team in baseball yet to lose three-straight...since 1961, only one Twins team has ever recorded their first three-game losing streak later in the season: the 1970 Twins, who lost three-straight from June 17-20...below are the latest dates in a season for the Twins to drop three-in-a-row:

ROSTER MOVE: Earlier today the Twins placed Byron Buxton on the 10-day Injured List (retro to June 15) with a right wrist contusion, an injury he suffered after getting hit by a pitch on Friday vs. Kansas City...Buxton has played in 65 games for the Twins this season, hitting .266 (55-for-207) with 21 doubles, three triples, nine home runs, 38 RBI, 40 runs scored and an .851 OPS...to replace Buxton on the 25-man roster, the Twins have recalled outfielder Jake Cave from Triple-A Rochester...since being optioned from Minnesota in mid-May, Cave has appeared in 33 games for the Red Wings, hitting .326 (42-for-129) with 12 doubles, two triples, five home runs, 25 runs scored and a .945 OPS.

TWINS-SOX: The Twins and Red Sox are playing the second of six scheduled meetings this season...the Twins will visit Fenway Park for three games September 3-5...Twins have lost four straight to the Sox and are just 4-10 in their last 14...they are looking to avoid losing five straight to the Sox for the first time since May 7-August 9, 2011 (also 5).

☞ Nelson Cruz has hit .302 (100-for-331) with 20 doubles, 22 home runs, 64 RBI and a .954 OPS in 88 career games vs. Boston.

DANKE SCHOEN: Max Kepler has reached safely in 11 straight games with an at-bat, dating back to June 5...it marks the sixth longest streak of his career, his best being 19 games from July 5-27, 2018...during the streak, he is hitting .350 (14-for-40) with 11 walks and a .490 OBP...he has drawn a team-high 32 walks this season, 27 coming from the leadoff spot, third best in the AL and fifth best in baseball, trailing Andrew McCutchen (43), Matt Carpenter (35), Marcus Semien (31) and Shin-soo Choo (30).

THIS IS MY BOOMSTICK!: Nelson Cruz is hitting .311 (14-for-45) with six home runs, 12 RBI, six walks and a 1.148 OPS in 11 games since coming off the IL (left wrist strain) June 3...among designated hitters this season, he ranks first in slugging percentage (.568), and second in batting average (.278) and OPS (.929)...as of yesterday he was third among DH's in ASG voting with 506,211 votes.

BIRTHDAY BOYS: Jason Castro is celebrating his 31st birthday today...he has played five career games on his birthday, hitting .278 (5-for-18) with two doubles and one RBI...first base coach Tommy Watkins is celebrating his 39th birthday...they share a birthday with country singer Blake Shelton (43), singer Paul McCartney (77), and NFL tight end Antonio Gates (39) - Dan Gladden's first round pick in his fantasy football draft last season.

LAST START: Pineda did not factor into the decision, his sixth of the season as the Twins won 10-5 last Thursday vs. the Mariners...allowed just one run on two hits over 5.2 innings pitched which marked the fewest hits off him since he allowed just one hit on a shortened start March 31 vs. Cleveland...he did not allow a hit the first time through the lineup marking the first time this season he's done so...gave up a double to Daniel Vogelbach in the fourth inning and a single to Kyle Seager in the sixth (his only two hits), who would come around to score on a Vogelbach single off Ryne Harper for Pineda's only earned run of the game.

WALK HARD: Through 13 starts, Pineda has only issued 13 walks in 69.2 innings which is the third fewest in the American League among starters with at least 69.0 innings pitched...owns 744 career strikeouts, 170 walks and a lifetime SO/BB ratio of 4.38...he hasn't issued more than three walks since July 31, 2016 at Tampa Bay, a stretch of 41 starts...since 2016, is one of seven starters with an active streak of 40+ starts and three or less walks (full list below).

VS. THE RED SOX: Pineda is 5-5 in 12 career starts vs. Boston...was the starter and winner in his last time out on June 8, 2017 (with New York-AL) after tossing 7.0 innings with two walks, eight strikeouts and held batters to a .167 (4-for-24) batting average...earned his first career win against the Red Sox on April 10, 2014 tossing 6.0 four-hit innings with seven strikeouts and two walks as a member of the New York Yankees...owns a 2-2 record with a 4.50 ERA over 30.0 IP with six walks and 29 strikeouts in five career home games vs. the Red Sox.

QUALITY CONTROL: In his last six starts, Pineda has gone 2-0, 4.04 ERA (35.2 IP, 16 ER) with an opponent batting average of .212, four walks and 27 strikeouts...in that span he has four quality starts and was one out short of a quality start last outing and three outs from a QS the start before that...he has not lost a start since May 5 at New York-AL.

MORE WALK TALK: Pineda's 13 walks on the year is tied for the fourth fewest in the all of baseball and the third fewest in the American League among starters with at least 12 starts...his walks allowed per nine innings rate is 1.68, which ranks 11th best in the majors and is fourth in the American League (behind Mike Leake-1.51, Carlos Carrasco-1.52 and José Berríos-1.57)...has five starts without walking a batter this season, the most through his first 13 starts since 2015 where he also had five starts without giving up a walk.

NIGHT N' DAY: Big Mike is making his seventh night start of the season and is 2-1, 5.50 ERA (34.1 IP, 21 ER) with five walks and 24 strikeouts in his first six outings...in seven day starts, he is 2-2, 4.58 ERA (35.1 IP, 18 ER) with eight walks and 33 strikeouts...in 81 career night starts, Pineda is 29-29, 4.24 ERA (476.0 IP, 224 ER) with 105 walks and 434 strikeouts, as opposed to 15-15, 3.98 ERA (273.2 IP, 121 ER) with 65 walks and 310 strikeouts in 49 day starts in his career.

THE REPERTOIRE: Coming into 2019, Pineda relied on high-velocity fastball, as referenced by the 59.6 percent (2011), 29.7 (2014), 38.7 (2015), 47.6 (2016) and 47.9 (2017) usage rates for his fastball that averaged 94.1 MPH each year...similarly this season, has thrown the fastball 53.7 percent of the time, despite a 1.6 MPH drop in velocity this season (92.5)...right-handed batters are batting .289 (46-for-159) against Pineda this season, and lefties are hitting .227 (25-for-110) below is Baseball Savant's breakdown of Pineda's pitches and usage in 2019:

CAREER NOTES

- Spent the entire 2018 season on the Injured List, recovering from "Tommy John" surgery on right elbow.
- Appeared in four minor league games in 2018, allowing two runs over 12.0 innings pitched.
- Was shut down due to right knee discomfort suffered while throwing a bullpen in late August.
- Struck out 207 batters over 175.2 innings pitched in 2016, setting the fifth-lowest innings total for a pitcher who recorded 200+ strikeouts in American League history.
- Was an AL All-Star in 2011 as a member of the Seattle Mariners, posting a 3.03 ERA (113.0 IP, 38 ER) with 113 strikeouts and an opponents average of .198 in the first half, and finished the year fifth in the AL Rookie of the Year voting.
- In 2011, he became one of 27 rookie pitchers in the Expansion Era (1961-present) to throw at least 171.0 innings and strikeout 173 or more batters, and first since Daisuke Matsuzaka (Boston, 2007).
- Was signed by Seattle as a 16-year-old undrafted free agent December 12, 2005.
- He owns a farm in his native Dominican Republic, where he raises chickens in addition to growing a number of crops.
