LAST TIME OUT: Berríos was the tough-luck loser, being handed his third loss of the season despite spinning 8.0 innings of one-run ball in an eventual 2-0 loss to the Red Sox on Monday night...in it, he became the first Twins pitcher to strikeout 10-or-more batters and not issue a walk this season...the last two to do it were both Berríos, on June 7 and April 12 of last season, both against the White Sox.

• Berríos has a 2.86 ERA through 15 starts this season -- the last Minnesota pitcher with a sub-3.00 ERA through 15 starts was Ervin Santana in 2017 (2.97)

 Berríos is second in the American League behind Justin Verlander (13) with 12 quality starts (tied for fourth-most in baseball), while 13 out of his 15 starts have gone at least 6.0 innings (including five 7.0+ inning efforts)...his 12 quality starts through his first 15 mark the best start of his career...in 2018 he had seven through his first 13. in 2017 he recorded eight and in 2016 he posted one quality start.

WESTERN AUTO-MATIC JOSÉ: Berríos enters tonight with a six-game streak of quality starts against Kansas City, dating back to Sept. 9, 2017 here at Kauffman Stadium (both of his last two starts against the Royals have been away from home)...has made one start against them this year, back on April 2, throwing 7.0 innings and yielding three runs on seven hits in an eventual 5-4 Twins win (did not factor into the decision)...his last win against the Royals came on August 4 of last year at Target Field, a start in which he scattered a pair of runs in 7.0 innings in an 8-2 Twins win.

INDUCING WEAK CONTACT: José has been able to create weak contact off the bat of his opponents for the entirety of his career, but especially over the past two seasons...since 2018, he has allowed an average exit velocity of 85.9 MPH on balls put into play, and only two American League starters have a lower average exit velocity on batted balls: Yankees starter CC Sabathia (85.0) and Rays pitcher Ryan Yarbrough (85.3), (min. 500 batted balls)...he's also seventh in the American League (13th in baseball) with a wOBA of .289 since 2018, (min. 1,000 results).

HAVE A DÉ: The Puerto Rican right-hander is making his sixth day-game start of the year, and is 4-1 with a 2.16 ERA (33.1 IP, 8 ER) with 37 strikeouts in those outings...among AL starters with at least five day-starts, he ranks: second in opponents' OPS (.508), fourth in ERA, fourth in opponents' batting average (.182, 22-for-121) and sixth in earned runs allowed.

YOUNG GUN: At 25 years old, Berríos continues to establish himself as one of the great young pitchers in Twins history...his 2.86 ERA is the lowest by a Twins starter younger than 26 years old since Johan Santana's Cy Young campaign in 2004 (2.61 ERA)...he also enters today's start with just 17 walks in 15 starts...last season, he walked a total of 61 batters in 32 starts...currently sits with an 8.66 SO/9 ratio (94 SO), and is looking to become the third Twins pitcher to have back-to-back seasons with a SO/9 ratio north of 8.00, joining Dave Boswell (1966-67) and Johan Santana (2004-07).

Note: Kyle Gibson and Jake Odorizzi are also on-pace to have SO/9 rates higher than 8.00, would become first trio of Twins to do so in the same season.

- Teamed with Jake Odorizzi (11 Ks on March 30 against the Indians) to become just the second pair of pitchers in baseball history (since 1893 - when the mound was placed at its current distance to home plate) to start a team's season with consec-
- utive double-digit strikeout totals...the only others to ever do it were Hall of Famer Randy Johnson, along with Curt Schilling, for the 2001 Arizona Diamondbacks. Finished 2018 with 32 starts, his fifth-straight season with at least 28 starts; along with Kyle Gibson (32) and José Berríos (32), they became the first trio of Twins with 30-plus starts in the same season since 2007 (Johan Santana 33, Carlos Silva 33, and Boof Bonser - 30).
- Given 2018 Joseph W. Haynes Award for Twins Pitcher of the Year, voted on by the Twin Cities Chapter of the BBWAA...also awarded with the Carl R. Pohlad Community Service Award.
- Became 21st pitcher in Twins history to reach the 200-strikeout mark (202 in 2018).

Fundación CAP is a non-profit organization that since 1989 has been working for children with cancer at Hospital Pediátrico, the leading public pediatric hospital in Puerto Rico and the only one that treats certain types of cancer. The mission of CAP is to ensure that all children with cancer, regardless of their financial resources, have access to first-rate cancer treatment in Puerto Rico, close to their family and home. Entering today's start, Berríos is set to donate \$4,700.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - MICHAEL PINEDA, RHP (SEASON: 4-3, 4.76 ERA ; CAREER: 44-44, 4.12 ERA)

Pineda will be on the hill tomorrow afternoon on the series finale against the Royals...the right-hander was the starter on Tuesday against the Red Sox in the marathon 17-inning game, but he did not factor into the decision despite allowing just one run on five hits over 6.0 innings pitched in a 4-3 Twins win...has been cruising on the mound since his last loss on May 5 at New York-AL, as he owns a 3.67 ERA (41.2 IP, 17 ER) with 32 strikeouts to five walks, the Twins are 5-2 in those games, and he has not allowed more than three runs in any of them...lifetime is 5-5 with a 3.84 ERA (63.1 IP, 27 ER) and an opponents' batting average of .241...hasn't seen them since May 22, 2017, and his last appearance here was just five days prior...owns a 5.08 ERA in Kansas City.

Twins' bullpen went 4-4-4 with a 4.52 ERA (79.2 IP, 40 ER) vs. KC last season...in seven games this season, are 3-0-5 with an 0.83 ERA (21.2 IP, 2 ER) with five walks and 13 strikeouts.
 Twins relievers have pitched 239.2 innings, 2nd-fewest in the AL (behind the Indians, 232.2) and 4th-fewest in baseball...bullpen has gone 13-8-22 with 39 holds, a 4.47 ERA (119 ER), 100 walks, 248 strikeouts and a .258 opponents' batting average (243-for-941) in 75 games...Twins 'pen is 4th in baseball in save percentage (81.5%), trailing just the Indians (88.0%), Giants (83.3%) & White Sox (81.8%), going 22-for-77 in save opportunities and have the 1-4th-fewest hown saves in baseball with five
