**THE TWINS:** The Twins have gone 2-0 on their short three-game homestand with Tampa Bay...today the Twins will play the three-game series finale with the Rays before traveling to Chicago to begin a six-game, seven-day roadtrip with three vs. the White Sox over the weekend, an off-day in the Bay Area on Monday, then three against Oakland July 2-4...the Twins play just four home games in their next 19 days.

**TWINS TAKE ANOTHER SERIES FROM TAMPA:** The Twins beat the Rays last night by a score of 6-4...Jake Odorizzi was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing three runs on four hits in 5.1 innings pitched...the offense recorded 10 hits and went 4-for-12 with runners in scoring position...Nelson Cruz had three hits and three RBI, all runs coming on a double in the seventh inning...the attendance was 31,650.

**WELCOME WADE:** The Twins have placed Williams Astudillo on the 10-day Injured List with a left oblique strain...to replace Astudillo on the 25-man roster, the Twins have recalled outfielder LaMonte (lah-MONT) Wade Jr. from Triple-A Rochester...Wade, 25, played in 70 games for the Red Wings, hitting .248 (59-for-238) with five home runs, 24 RBI, 51 walks and a .759 OPS...in his last 20 games for the Wings, he has hit .338 (22-for-65) with six doubles, two home runs, 12 RBI, 16 walks, 15 runs scored and a .987 OPS.

**TWINS-RAYS:** The Twins and Rays are playing for the final time this season...the Twins are looking to win their sixth straight vs. the Rays, which would be their longest streak since winning 14 straight over them from July 21, 2004-September 5, 2006...the Twins are looking to sweep the Rays today for the first time since July 17-20, 2006 at the Metrodome when they took all four...they are looking to sweep a *three-game* series of the Rays for the first time since July 1-3, 2005 at the Dome.

☞ C.J. Cron is hitting .333 (15-for-45) with three doubles, three home runs, 13 RBI and a .954 OPS in his last 12 games vs. TB.

☞ Jonathan Schoop is hitting .304 (28-for-92) with eight home runs and 18 RBI in his last 22 games vs. TB...he has 17 career home runs and 42 RBI against the Rays, both his most vs. any opponent.

☞ Through six games this season, the Twins are hitting .410 (25-for-61) with runners in scoring position vs. TB...conversely, the Rays are hitting .405 (15-for-37) with RISP vs. Minnesota.

**SWEEPS WEEK:** The Twins are seeking their eighth sweep of an opponent this season...their previous seven sweeps came: three games May 24-26 vs. Chicago-AL, three games May 20-22 at Los Angeles-AL, three games May 6-8 at Toronto, three games April 26-28 vs. Baltimore, three games at Baltimore April 20-21, two games April 13-14 vs. Detroit, and two games April 2-3 at Kansas City...Twins recorded seven sweeps all of last season.

**FANS ON TARGET:** The Twins have drawn 482,146 total attendance in their last 15 home games for an average of 31,161...they have drawn 30,000-plus 11 times this season...Twins rank sixth in the AL in total attendance, having drawn 965,298 this season, trailing New York (1,789,422), Los Angeles (1,433,880), Boston (1,365,318), Houston (1,351,956) and Texas (1,127,694)...through games of May 9, the Twins had the third lowest attendance in the AL at 269,493, averaging 16,843 per date.

**BIRTHDAY BOYS:** Former Twins infielder and current Single-A Cedar Rapids coach Luis Rodriguez is celebrating his 39th birthday today; played for the Twins from 2005-07...former Twins First Base Coach Wayne Terwilliger is celebrating his 94th today...Terwilliger was a coach for the Twins from 1986-94 and played for the franchise from 1953-54 while they were in Washington.

**LAST START:** Pérez did not factor into the decision last Friday at Kauffman Stadium after allowing six runs (four earned) on five hits with three walks, a home run and two strikeouts... allowed six of the first seven batters to reach in Kansas City's three-run first inning, including run-scoring hits by Cheslor Cuthbert and Martín Maldonado...retired 10 of the next 11 batters before a walk and an HBP preceded a go-ahead, three-run shot to Cuthbert in the fifth.

**A TALE OF TWO SEASONS:** Has allowed 14 earned runs in the month of June over four starts after allowing 12 in May over six starts and 13 in March/April in six appearances...he remains winless in his last five starts, in which he's 0-2 with a 7.50 ERA (24.0 IP, 20 ER), after starting 7-1, 2.95 ERA (58.0 IP, 19 ER).

**STILL UP IN THE RANKS:** Since joining the rotation on April 15, Pérez still ranks tied for 11th in the AL with six wins (T-21st in the majors) and is 22nd in the AL in ERA (3.91).

**THE TERRIFIC TRIO:** Pérez has won seven games this season (six as a starter)...with a win today, Pérez, Jake Odorizzi (10) and José Berríos (8) would become the fifth Twins trio ever to have eight wins apiece through 80 team games.

- The impressive company the Twins 2019 trio could join: Camilo Pascual (9 wins), Jim Perry (8) and Jim Kaat (8) in 1963; Bert Blyleven (11), Kaat (9) and Dick Woodson (9) in 1973; Kevin Tapani (9), John Smiley (12) and Bill Krueger (8) in 1992 and Joe Mays (10), Brad Radke (8) and Eric Milton (8) in 2001.

**RIGHTY-LEFTY SPLITS:** Pérez has posted an opponent batting average of .248 (62-for-250) with 20 extra-base hits to right-handed batters this season while lefties are hitting .269 (18-for-67) with two extra-base hits...for his career right handed batters have hit .294 and lefties have hit .244.

**PÉREZ VS. THE RAYS:** Pérez is making his eighth career start against the Rays and the second this season...last time out vs. Tampa, May 30 at Tropicana Field, he received the loss after allowing six runs, six hits and two walks with three strikeouts...over his career, Pérez is 0-4 in nine games (seven starts) vs. Tampa Bay...owns a 7.49 ERA (39.2 IP, 33 ER) with 14 walks and 32 strikeouts.

- Today is his 34th career start against the AL East; he is 10-14, 5.64 ERA (183.2 IP, 115 ER) with 62 walks and 121 strikeouts with his worst ERA against a division; his next highest mark is 5.54 (141.1 IP, 87 ER) against the AL Central.
- However, is 3-1, 3.90 ERA (27.2 IP, 12 ER) with seven walks and 23 strikeouts in five starts against AL East opponents this season.

**ROUGH MONTH:** In the month of June, Pérez is 0-1 with a 5.91 ERA (21.1 IP, 14 ER) with nine walks and 17 strikeouts over four starts...since joining the starting rotation in April, his June ERA is the highest of any month by more than a run while he has already allowed more runs (20) in this month than any other month (in May allowed 12 in six starts)...opponents are hitting .264 with an on-base percentage of .340 and slugging percentage of .356.

**ORGULLO VENEZOLANO:** Born in Guanare, Venezuela, where he makes his home today with his wife, Viclena, daughter, Malena, and newborn son, Martín, Pérez currently ranks fifth among active Venezuelan-born pitchers (min. 500.0 IP) in starts (141), sixth in wins (50) and innings pitched (843.1), while sitting eighth in strikeouts (538) and 10th in ERA (4.60).

## CAREER NOTES

- Battled through injury in 2018 after breaking his non-throwing arm in the offseason after being charged by his pet bull.
- According to Inside Edge, opponents had a groundball rate of 67.3 percent (37/55) against Pérez's changeup in 2018, the highest in Major League Baseball with at least 80.0 IP.
- Made three starts at three different stops on rehab assignment last season, Single-A Hickory, Double-A Frisco and Triple-A Round Rock, going 2-0, 0.52 ERA (17.1 IP, 1 ER).
- Led the Rangers in wins (13-career high), starts (32) and innings (185.0) in 2017, while setting a career-best in strikeouts (115).
- His career-high 198.2 IP in 2016 were the sixth-most by a Texas pitcher age 25-or-younger and the most since José Guzmán in 1988.
- Went 10-6 with a 3.62 ERA (50 ER in 124.1 IP) in 2013, ranking tied for first among American League rookies in wins, second in ERA and third in both starts (20) and quality starts (11).
- Was named Rangers Nolan Ryan Minor League Pitcher of the Year after combining to go 6-8, 2.90 ERA (37 ER in 114.2 IP) with 119 strikeouts in 27 games (19 starts) across two levels.
- Entered 2008 as the youngest player in the Northwest League and was rated by Baseball America as the second-best prospect in the NWL, fifth-best in the Rangers' organization.
