THE TWINS: After completing their short three-game homestand with a record of 2-1 vs. Tampa Bay, the Twins began their six-game, seven-day roadtrip by splitting the first two games against the White Sox, losing 6-4 on Friday and winning 10-3 yesterday...today they will play the series finale on the South Side, looking to improve to 17-6-4 in series play... following today's game, they will travel to northern California, enjoy an off-day in the Bay Area tomorrow, then play three against Oakland from Tuesday to Thursday...the Twins play seven more games leading up to the All-Star break, four on the road and three at home.

BOMBA SQUAD BACK IN BUSINESS: The Twins offense erupted yesterday with a 10-run, five home run performance to take game two against the White Sox by a score of 10-3...Michael Pineda (5-4) was the starter and winner, pitching 6.0 innings of one-run baseball, scattering just four hits and a walk with a season-high tying eight strikeouts...Nelson Cruz led the way with four hits, two home runs and a season-high five RBI, while Max Kepler collected his 20th and 21st home runs of the year, setting a new career-high...Miguel Sanó also collected his third home run in his last two games.

☞ Max Kepler (21) and Eddie Rosario (20) became the second pair of Twins to record 20 home runs before the All-Star break, joining Harmon Killebrew (30) and Bob Allison (21) in 1964.
☞ Nelson Cruz joined Max Kepler with two home runs yesterday, marking the fifth game this season in which the Twins have had two-or-more players record a multi-HR game in the same game...counting them individually, those were the 16th and 17th multi-HR games by a Twins player this season, most in the majors this year, tying the 1986 Twins for the most such games in Senators/Twins history (since 1908).

TWINS AND SOX: The Twins and White Sox are playing each other for the sixth of 19 times this season...Twins enter today having won eight of their last nine over the Sox...Twins have gone 28-15 vs. Chicago since the start of 2017.

☞ Mitch Garver is hitting .370 (17-for-46) with five doubles, seven RBI, five walks and a .953 OPS in 15 career games vs. the Sox.
☞ Max Kepler is hitting .386 (17-for-44) with four doubles, one triple, six home runs, 16 RBI, a .932 slugging percentage and a 1.348 OPS in his last 11 vs. the Sox...riding a six-game hitting streak, with 12 hits in his last 26 at-bats vs. the Sox with three doubles, five homers and 14 RBI.
☞ Jorge Polanco has seven home runs and 20 RBI in 19 career games at Guaranteed Rate Field...the homers and RBI are his personal most in any opposing ballpark.
☞ Miguel Sanó has four home runs and seven RBI with a 1.837 OPS against CWS this season.

WALK TALL AND CARRY A BOOMSTICK: Nelson Cruz launched his 374th and 375th home run yesterday, moving into sole possession of 78th on the all-time home run list...he is now one shy of Carlton Fisk for 77th...he is batting .306 with eight home runs, 22 RBI and a 1.051 OPS in his last 21 games since being reinstated from the 10-day Injured List with a left wrist strain.

ALL A-RRAEZ: Luis Arraez is riding a 10-game hitting streak in which he is slashing .469/.541/.531 with 15 hits and five walks with just two strikeouts...the streak is tied for the third-longest by an American League rookie this season, two shy of Brandon Lowe's 12-game streak from April 22-May 8.

* The streak passed Jorge Polanco's nine-game stretch from June 15-25 as the fifth-longest streak by a Twin this season, while also passing the longest streak by a Twins rookie since Zack Granite's nine-game stretch from July 19-29, 2017...the next most recent streak by a Twins rookie is Jorge Polanco's 13-game streak from May 20-August 11, 2016.
* Has reached base safely in 15 of 16 ML games in which he had a plate appearance (hit in 14), going 23-for-52 (.442) with 10 runs, 10 walks, 3 doubles, one home run, 5 RBI, a .558 slugging percentage and a 1.082 OPS.

ROAD RULES: The Twins have gone 27-15 on the road this season, the most road wins in baseball...Twins have out-scored opponents on the road 268-208...the Twins went 29-52 on the road in 2018 and didn't record their 28th road win until September 19 at Detroit...where the Twins offense ranks among all of baseball on the road:

TWINS MINOR LEAGUE WEEKLY HONORS: The Twins have named Triple-A Rochester outfielder **Zander Wiel** and Single-A Advanced Ft. Myers right-handed pitcher **Cole Sands** as Twins minor league Player and Pitcher of the Week...in seven games for the Red Wings, Wiel hit .433 (13-for-30) with two home runs, five doubles, eight RBI, 24 total bases and five runs scored, including five multi-hit games...the Tennessee native was drafted by the Twins in the 12th round of the 2015 draft out of Vanderbilt University...this marks Wiel's third career weekly honor, first since Sept. 4, 2016...Sands made one start for the Miracle, throwing 5.0 no-hit inning with six strikeouts last Sunday against Jupiter...Sands was a fifth-round selection in the 2018 MLB draft out of Florida State...this is his first weekly honor.

WELCOME TO THE SHOW: Today marks the Major League debut for 23-year-old Lewis Thorpe, a left-handed pitcher from Melbourne, Australia...Thorpe comes into today's debut after making 14 starts this season for Triple-A Rochester...has shown improvement each month after starting his season with a 15.58 ERA (8.2 IP, 15 ER) thorough his first two starts, both against Lehigh Valley (PHI)...following those outings, the lefty went on to **throw back-to-back 12-strikeout games against Syracuse and Scranton/Wilkes-Barre, earning himself Twins Minor League Pitcher of the Week honors for the week ending April 28**...has allowed four-or-more runs just four times since April 17, and despite allowing 44 earned runs in 69.1 innings this season, owns a 3.62 ERA (397.2 IP, 160 ER) with 480 strikeouts in 85 games (79 starts) in the Minors.

- Also becomes the seventh Twin to debut in 2019, joining Ryne Harper, Devin Smeltzer, Ryan Eades, Luis Arraez, Sean Poppen and LaMonte Wade Jr.

IS THAT...POSSIBLE?: Thorpe enters today's outing with 480 career strikeouts in 85 appearances... **May 4 of this year marked his 77th professional appearance, and at it's start, he'd thrown 357.1 IP in 76 career outings, and he recorded at least one strikeout in every outing prior.**

A LOADED TROPHY CASE: Thorpe is coming off a spectacular 2018 campaign, pitching to a combined 3.54 ERA (129.2 IP, 51 ER) in 26 games (25 games) between Double- and Triple-A, earning himself the 2018 Jim Rantz Award as the Twins Minor League Pitcher of the Year, making himself the 16th player (17th award winner) to earn the title, joining the likes of teammates Kyle Gibson (2010) and José Berrios (2014-15)...entering the season, Thorpe was dubbed the 15th-best prospect in the Twins system by *MLB.com* and the 16th-best by *Baseball America*, and he appeared in the SiriusXM Futures Game for the World Team, pitching in relief, allowing four runs on three hits in 0.2 innings pitched.

- Was ultimately named a 2018 Southern League (Double-A) Postseason All-Star, joining current Rochester Red Wings outfielder/first baseman Brent Rooker.

MINORS NUMBERS: As mentioned, Thorpe has pitched to a 3.62 ERA (397.2 IP, 160 ER) with 480 strikeouts in 85 games (79 appearances) in the Minors...so far this season, lefties have hit just .225 (16 hits, 2 HR), but out of the 56 outs recorded (18.2 IP), 23 have been strikeouts...conversely, righties have batted .282 (58 hits, 9 HR) with 65 strikeouts...Thorpe thrives when he's able to get ahead in the count, holding his opposition to a .168 batting average and just 11 runs scored, but has troubles after falling behind (.338 average, 15 ER).

GET TO KNOW THE SOUTHPAW FROM DOWN UNDER: When he takes his first steps on the mound today, Thorpe will become just the eighth Australia-born player to don a Twins uniform, joining James Beresford (2016), Liam Hendriks (2013), Luke Hughes (2012), Justin Huber (2009), Glenn Williams (2005), Grant Balfour (2004) and Brad Thomas (2004)...Thorpe, 23, was discovered by the Twins back in 2010 as a 15-year-old playing in a 16-and-under tournament in México, as former scout Howard Norsetter, who also discovered Balfour and Hendriks, was the first major league scout to connect with the young Australian, and it was that first contact that lured Thorpe to sign with the Twins in 2012.

- Thorpe remained in Australia until the 2013 season when he joined the GCL Twins (where he was teammates with Fernando Romero, Stephen Gonsalves and even a brief stint with Darin Mastroianni), and would go on to earn a 4-1 record with a 2.05 ERA with six walks and a team-best 64 strikeouts...**according to an MiLB.com story from 2014 by Jake Seiner, there was a team rule that each walk issued by a pitcher that season would cost them a dollar, encouraging pitchers to focus on throwing strikes, so Thorpe was ultimately fined \$6.**
- Following his impressive stint in the GCL, Thorpe returned home to Australia to pitch for his hometown Melbourne Aces, where he struck out 30 batters and pitched to a 2.45 ERA over 36.2 IP, despite being the youngest pitcher on the staff...Thorpe came back to the States for the 2014 season and led Cedar Rapids with a 3-2 record, a 3.52 ERA (71.2 IP, 28 ER) in 16 starts with 36 walks to 80 strikeouts, leading the Kernels in SO/9 percentage (10.11), and was ultimately ranked the 11th best Twins prospect by *Baseball America* entering 2015.
- Thorpe was diagnosed with a sprained ulnar collateral ligament in his pitching elbow late in 2014 but did not undergo "Tommy John" surgery until March of 2015 after it tore while trying to rehab the injury...while rehabbing in 2016 he came down with mononucleosis and would miss all of that season as well...**overall, Thorpe went 991 days between professional appearances (August 31, 2014 for Single-A Cedar Rapids-May 19, 2017 for Single-A Ft. Myers).**
- Completed his comeback as he made his season debut on May 19, 2017, throwing 4.0 innings of two-hit ball vs. Bradenton, and went on to go 3-4 with a 2.69 ERA (77.0 IP, 23 ER) with 84 strikeouts, earning a late-season promotion to Chattanooga, where he'd earn his first Double-A victory...**spent most of 2018 with the Lookouts, compiling a 3.58 ERA and 131 strikeouts over 108.0 innings before earning his next promotion to Triple-A Rochester, pitching to a 3.32 ERA in four starts with 26 more strikeouts.**

LAST TIME OUT: Thorpe last saw game action on June 23 against the Toledo Mud Hens (Detroit), receiving his first losing decision in nearly a month after allowing five runs on eight hits while striking out six and walking two...after allowing a three-run home run in the first inning to Jeimer Candelario, the Mud Hens plated two more runs in the fifth, forcing Thorpe from the game...Toledo went on to win 7-1.

Odorizzi will make his 17th start of the year Tuesday night in the series opener in Oakland...is 10-3, 2.73 ERA (85.2 IP, 26 ER) with 27 walks and 94 strikeouts, tying for the American League lead in wins and ranking fourth in ERA...in his last start against Tampa Bay on June 26 in Minneapolis, Odorizzi didn't factor into the decision after allowing just three runs in 5.1 innings pitched, yielding four hits (two home runs) with seven strikeouts...owns a career 2.95 ERA (36.2 IP, 12 ER) against the Athletics, with an opponents' batting average of .189 (25-for-132), but his teams are just 1-5 against the A's...last saw them on August 24 of last year, receiving his third loss against them despite throwing 7.0 innings of two-run ball (one earned) on five hits and a walk with five strikeouts...earned his lone win against Oakland on July 17, 2017 at Rickey Henderson Field at the Oakland-Alameda County Coliseum after throwing 7.0 one-hit innings, the lone hit being a solo home run to Khris Davis in the fourth inning, in a 3-2 Rays win.
