**THE TWINS:** The Twins began their "second half" with a series win over the Indians last weekend, winning games one and two...tonight the Twins will begin a nine-game homestand with two vs. New York-NL through tomorrow afternoon, followed by four vs. Oakland Thursday-Sunday and three vs. New York-AL July 22-24...20 of the Twins next 32 games are vs. teams above .500...all those opponents have a combined winning percentage of .506.

**TWINS CAN'T COMPLETE TRIBE SWEEP:** The Twins lost to the Indians on Sunday afternoon by a score of 4-3...José Berríos was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing three runs on six hits in 5.0 innings pitched...the Twins tied the game at three in the seventh inning but Trevor May allowed a go-ahead solo homer to Carlos Santana in the bottom half...the offense recorded seven hits, three coming from Marwin Gonzalez...the Twins went 3-for-12 with RISP.

**ROSTER MOVES:** The Twins announced today that they have reinstated first baseman C.J. Cron and outfielder Eddie Rosario from the 10-day Injured List...Cron, who missed the Twins last five games with right thumb inflammation, is hitting .266 (80-for-301) with 18 doubles, 17 home runs, 54 RBI, 23 walks and an .821 OPS in 78 games this season...Rosario, who missed the last 13 games with a left ankle sprain, is hitting .282 (87-for-308) with 14 doubles, 20 home runs, 60 RBI, 51 runs scored and an .841 OPS in 75 games...to make room for Cron and Rosario on the 25-man roster, the Twins have placed outfielder Byron Buxton on the 7-day Injured List (retro 7/14) with concussion-like symptoms and designated right-handed pitcher Mike Morin for release or assignment...Buxton has appeared in 75 games this season, hitting .249 (61-for-245) with 24 doubles, four triples, nine home runs, 42 RBI and a .798 OPS...Morin appeared in 23 games for the Twins this season, posting a 3.18 ERA (22.2 IP, 8 ER), one save, two walks and 11 strikeouts.

**HEART AND HUSTLE:** The MLBPA announced this morning that Byron Buxton is the Twins 2019 Heart and Hustle Award winner...the esteemed award honors active players who demonstrate a passion for the game and best embody its values, spirits and traditions...this marks the second of Buxton's career after winning this honor in 2017...Major League Baseball's final overall winner will be announced on November 7 at the 20th Annual Legends for Youth Dinner in NYC.

**INTERLEAGUE PLAY:** The Twins have gone 3-4 in Interleague Play this season, going 1-2 at Philadelphia, 1-1 in New York and 1-1 vs. Milwaukee...they are 214-195 all-time in IL play, the eighth most wins in IL history, trailing Boston (246), New York-AL (244), Los Angeles-AL (233), Texas (224), Oakland (222), Detroit (217) and Chicago-AL (215).

- ☞ Twins are 14-6 in their last 20 IL games at home.
- ☞ Eddie Rosario is hitting .318 (42-for-132) with 11 doubles, eight home runs and 20 RBI in his last 32 games vs. NL opponents.
- ☞ Jorge Polanco is hitting .362 (46-for-127) with a .956 OPS in 37 career games against NL teams...he became the 11th Twin to hit for the cycle April 5 at Philadelphia.
- ☞ C.J. Cron is hitting .309 (54-for-175) with 11 doubles, 11 home runs, 36 RBI and a .927 OPS in 65 career IL games.

**TWINS AND METS:** The Twins are 8-12 all-time vs. the Mets, going 3-3 at Shea Stadium, 3-0 at the Metrodome, 2-6 at Citi Field, 0-3 at Target Field in 2013...they split a two-game series in April, as the Twins won game one at Citi Field 14-8 and lost game two 6-9...Twins are just 1-8 vs. the Mets dating back to June of 2010.

- ☞ Twins assistant pitching coach (in the bullpen) Jeremy Hefner was drafted twice by the Mets, once in the 46th round in 2004 and again in the 48th round in 2005...he pitched parts of two seasons with the Mets from 2012-13, going 8-15, 4.65 ERA (224.1 IP, 116 ER) in 50 games (36 starts).
- ☞ Assistant hitting coach Rudy Hernandez played five seasons in the Mets system from 1987-91...he was signed by NY as a free agent in 1986.

**#BOMBASQUAD:** The Twins 171 home runs are the most in baseball, ahead of Seattle (162), already surpassing their 2018 total of 166 home runs...171 homers already rank 10th in club history...they need 54 home runs to match their all-time record of 225, set in 1963...they have a plus +58 home run differential, which also leads baseball.

- ☞ They did not homer in their last game and have not gone more than two consecutive games all season without homering at least once.

**STREAKING SANÓ:** Miguel Sanó enters tonight with a career-high 11-game hitting streak...during the current streak, he is hitting .368 (14-for-38) with three doubles, one triple, four home runs, nine RBI, nine runs scored, five walks and a 1.258 OPS...it marks the second longest active streak in baseball, trailing Whit Merrifield (13)...the Twins long this season is 14 by Jorge Polanco from May 27-June 13.

**THE LEFTORIUM:** The Twins are hitting .296 (247-for-835) with 41 doubles, 44 home runs, 72 walks and an .868 OPS vs. lefties this season...they lead baseball in batting average vs. lefties and rank second in OPS (Houston - .882).

- ☞ Individuals vs. LHP this season: Luis Arraez is hitting .391 (9-for-23)...Mitch Garver is hitting .360 (18-for-50)...C.J. Cron is hitting .358 (29-for-81) with seven home runs...Marwin Gonzalez is hitting .324 (22-for-68)...Ehire Adrianza is hitting .303 (10-for-33).
- ☞ Twins hitters have a line drive rate of 27.8% (182/654) against LHP this season -- highest in MLB; League Avg: 23.5%.
- ☞ Miguel Sano is averaging 4.76 Pitches per Plate Appearance (119/25) against LHP over the last 30 days (12 Games) -- 6th highest in MLB; League Avg: 3.86.
- ☞ Mitch Garver has a Well-Hit Avg of .380 (19/50) against LHP this season -- best in MLB among hitters with at least 135 PA's; League Avg: .184.
- ☞ Twins hitters have 2 home runs against LHP over the last 14 days (7 Games) -- tied for 6th fewest in MLB.

**RIP, JOE GRZENDA:** Former Twins left-handed pitcher Joe Grzenda passed away on Friday at age 82...Grzenda pitched in 38 games for the Twins in 1969, going 4-1, 3.88 ERA (48.2 IP, 21 ER), three saves, 17 walks and 24 strikeouts...on September 30, 1971, he threw the final pitch in Washington Senators history...Grzenda took the mound in the ninth inning at RFK Stadium with a Senators 7-5 lead...with one out remaining, thousands of fans suddenly stormed the field and Grzenda ran off the field with the final ball used in Washington Senators history...he kept it in a drawer for 33 years until baseball returned to The Capital and on April 14, 2005 at RFK Stadium in the first ever Washington Nationals game, he gave the ball to President George W. Bush, who tossed the ceremonial first pitch.

**LAST START:** Pineda earned his sixth win of the season and his second consecutive in his last start on July 6 vs. Texas at Target Field...cruised through his first 5.0 innings of work, scattering just four hits and a walk before a leadoff home run by Elvis Andrus in the sixth inning got Texas on the board...threw 61.5 percent of his pitches for strikes, his lowest percentage of the season.

- Recorded his eighth quality start of the season as well as a season high nine strikeouts which marked his most since striking out 11 on April 10, 2017 vs. the Tampa Bay Rays as a member of the New York Yankees.
- Has lasted at least 5.0 innings in all but two starts this season, including 13 in a row dating back to April 18 vs. Toronto.

**WALK HARD:** Through 17 starts, Pineda has only issued 16 walks in 92.2 innings, which is the fewest in the American League and tied for third fewest in all of baseball among starters with at least 90.0 innings pitched...owns 771 career strikeouts, 173 walks and a lifetime SO/BB ratio of 4.46...he hasn't issued more than three walks since July 31, 2016 at Tampa Bay, a stretch of 45 starts...since 2016, is one of nine starters with an active streak of 40+ starts with three-or-less walks in each, (full list below).

**AGAINST THE METS:** This will be Pineda's third career start vs. New York-NL and his first since 2015...is 2-0, 0.69 ERA (13.0 IP, 1 ER) while holding Mets' batters to a .196 average...in his last start against them on September 19, 2015, as a member of the New York Yankees, he earned the win after tossing 5.1 shutout innings, on four hits with one walk and four strikeouts.

- Pineda is 8-3 over 16 career starts against National League opponents...owns a 3.09 ERA, (93.1 IP, 32 ER) with 23 walks and 94 strikeouts while holding batters to a .205 average.
- Has faced two NL opponent this season: at the Philadelphia Phillies on April 6 and vs. the Milwaukee Brewers on May 27...is 1-0, 4.09 ERA (11.0 IP, 5 ER) with one walk and 11 strikeouts over those two starts.

**MORE WALK TALK:** Pineda is tied for fourth in the all of baseball with 16 free passes this season, and has the fewest in the American League among starters with at least 15 starts (excludes openers)...his walks allowed per nine innings rate is 1.55, which ranks seventh-best in the majors among qualified starters and is second in the American League (behind Mike Leake-1.40)...has six starts without walking a batter this season and six with walking just one.

- Michael also averages one walk per 0.42 batters he faces, the sixth-lowest in baseball, while his 5.25 strikeout-to-walk rate sits 11th (6th in the American League).

## CAREER NOTES

- Spent the entire 2018 season on the Injured List, recovering from "Tommy John" surgery on right elbow.
- Appeared in four minor league games in 2018, allowing two runs over 12.0 innings pitched.
- Was shut down due to right knee discomfort suffered while throwing a bullpen in late August.
- Struck out 207 batters over 175.2 innings pitched in 2016, setting the fifth-lowest innings total for a pitcher who recorded 200+ strikeouts in American League history.
- Was an AL All-Star in 2011 as a member of the Seattle Mariners, posting a 3.03 ERA (113.0 IP, 38 ER) with 113 strikeouts and an opponents average of .198 in the first half, and finished the year fifth in the AL Rookie of the Year voting.
- In 2011, he became one of 27 rookie pitchers in the Expansion Era (1961-present) to throw at least 171.0 innings and strikeout 173 or more batters, and first since Daisuke Matsuzaka (Boston, 2007).
- Was signed by Seattle as a 16-year-old undrafted free agent December 12, 2005.
- He owns a farm in his native Dominican Republic, where he raises chickens in addition to growing a number of crops.
