THE TWINS: The Twins have gone 0-2 to begin their nine-game homestand, losing a twogame series to the Mets this week...they will continue the homestand tonight with the first of four vs. Oakland...after this series, the Twins will host the Yankees for three games from Monday-Wednesday...18 of the Twins next 30 games are vs. teams above .500...all those opponents have a combined winning percentage of .513.

TWINS SUFFER FIRST SWEEP: The Twins lost to the Mets yesterday afternoon by a score of 14-4, allowing 12 runs between innings 7-9...it marked their first sweep since September 3-5, 2018, losing three at Houston...Martín Pérez was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing two runs (1 earned) on five hits in 6.0 innings pitched...infielder Ehire Adrianza made his first career pitching appearance, allowing three runs on five hits in 1.0 inning - the 23rd time a position player has pitched for the Twins and 14th different player... the offense recorded eight hits, two from Mitch Garver, who hit his 15th home run.

THREE'S COMPANY: The Twins have lost three straight for the first time all season...they were the last team in baseball to lose three straight...date-wise and game-wise, it marks the latest into a season for the Twins to have lost three-in-a-row...below are the latest dates in a season for the Twins to drop three-in-a-row:

streak was the 2009 Dodgers, who lost four straight from July 26-29, in games 98-101 (credit Elias).

The Twins last four-game losing streak came September 1-5, 2018, losing five straight.

ROSTER MOVE: The Twins announced today that they have recalled right-handed pitcher Kohl Stewart from Triple-A Rochester...Stewart, who will be in his fifth stint with the Twins this season, appeared in four games with Minnesota, going 1-1 with a 4.15 ERA (17.1 IP, 8 ER), five walks and four strikeouts...in 14 games (13 starts) for the Red Wings this season, he has gone 5-5 with a 6.28 ERA (61.2 IP, 43 ER), 33 walks and 58 strikeouts...to make room for Stewart on the 25-man roster, the Twins have designated right-handed pitcher Matt Magill for release or assignment...Magill appeared in 28 games this season, going 2-0 with a 4.45 ERA (28.1 IP, 14 ER), 15 walks and 36 strikeouts.

TWINS-A's: The Twins and Athletics are playing each other for the fourth of seven times this season...their last meeting came July 2-4 in Oakland as the Twins won the middle game of the three-game series...the Twins have gone 14-29 vs. the A's since the start of 2013 for a winning percentage of just .326, the Twins' second lowest winning percentage against any team since (New York-AL - .302).

₱ Jonathan Schoop is hitting .315 (34-for-108) with six doubles, three home runs, 12 RBI, 15 runs scored and an .805 OPS in 28 career games vs. the A's...he enters tonight with an eight-game hitting streak vs. Oakland.

₱ Nelson Cruz leads all active players with 34 home runs against the Athletics...also leads with 115 RBI, is second with 172 games played and third with 168 hits.

₱ C.J. Cron is hitting .347 (25-for-72) with four doubles, five home runs, 14 RBI and a 1.051 OPS in his last 19 games vs. Oakland.

#BOMBASQUAD: The Twins 174 home runs are the most in baseball, ahead of Seattle (164), already surpassing their 2018 total of 166 home runs...174 homers already are ninth-most in club history...they need 51 home runs to match their all-time record of 225, set in 1963...they have a plus +58 home run differential, which also leads baseball.

© Mitch Garver hit his 15th home run yesterday giving the Twins six players with 15-plus (Max Kepler - 23, Eddie Rosario - 20, Nelson Cruz - 18, C.J. Cron - 17, Jonathan Schoop - 15)...the Chicago Cubs are the only other team in baseball with six players having 15-plus homers...Jorge Polanco and Miguel Sanó have both hit 13.

© The Twins have had six players with 15+ homers four other times outside of this season: 2017, 1965, 1964 and 1963.

ARRAEZ AND SHINE: Since being recalled back to Minnesota on June 18, Luis Arraez is hitting .382 (29-for-76) with four doubles, one home run, four RBI, 10 runs scored, seven walks, a .434 on-base percentage and a .907 OPS...among all rookies with a minimum of 70 plate appearances since that date, he ranks first in batting average and on-base percentage, and tied for third in hits.

◆ Arraez has reached safely in 11 consecutive games and hit safely in 10 straight, the fourth longest active hit-streak in baseball... Arraez's second 10-game hit-streak this season.

FANS ON TARGET: Twins rank sixth in the AL in total attendance, having drawn 1,170,988 this season, trailing New York (2,005,933), Los Angeles (1,832,235), Boston (1,700,732), Houston (1,609,247) and Texas (1,409,726)...through games of May 9, the Twins had the third lowest attendance in the AL at 269,493, averaging 16,843 per date...they now have drawn 30,000+ in 12 of their last 15 home games.

HAPPII BIIRTHDAY, TORII: Torii Hunter is celebrating his 44th birthday today...Hunter appeared in 12 games on his birthday throughout his career, hitting .262 (11-for-42) with three doubles, two home runs and six RBI.

LAST TIME OUT: Did not factor into the decision after allowing three runs (one earned) on four hits with one walk and five strikeouts...has not factored into a decision since June 25, a span of three starts and one relief appearance...he allowed just two hits until a three-run fourth inning started with a lead-off shot from Carlos Santana that was followed by a José Ramírez walk who would move over to second on a fielder's choice and later score on a Roberto Pérez single...Gibson then struck out and walked a batter before exiting after 3.2 innings of work.

SWING AND A MISS: Gibson has recorded 99 strikeouts through 19 appearances (18 starts) and owns a SO/9 rate of 9.06 and a SO/BB ratio of 3.41...the SO/9 ranks 12th in the American League while his SO/BB rate ranks 14th.

• Gibson has improved his strikeouts-per-9.0 innings rate nearly every year in his career, setting a career-high in 2018 with 8.19 SO/9 (6.89-2017, 6.35-2016, 6.70-2015, 5.37-2014, 5.12-2013).

DAY NUMBERS: So far in 2019, Gibson has compiled a 4-2 record with a 3.80 ERA (42.2 IP, 18 ER) with only seven of his 29 walks coming during the day...Gibson is 4-2, 4.20 ERA (55.2 IP, 26 ER) with 22 walks and 57 of his 99 strikeouts coming at night.

NO DAMAGE DONE: Gibson has only allowed 30 XBH this season, tied for the 14th fewest allowed in the AL and tied for 23rd fewest in baseball among starters with at least 15 starts...Gibson has given up 14 doubles, which is the seventh fewest in the AL among starters with at least 15 starts.

AGAINST THE A's: Gibson is making his sixth career start against Oakland tonight...is 2-2 with a 3.81 ERA (28.1 IP, 12 ER), allowing 29 hits (two home runs), 17 walks and 15 strikeouts...in his last start on July 3 in the Bay, Gibson did not factor into the decision after allowing three runs (two earned) on five hits over 6.0 innings pitched...after exiting the game, the combination of Zack Littell, Ryne Harper, Tyler Duffey and Taylor Rogers, kept a clean sheet as the Twins went on to win 4-3 in 12 innings...Gibson has faced the A's twice at Target Field over his career, going 1-1 with a 3.60 ERA (10.0 IP, 4 ER) with five walks and four strikeouts.

• The last time Gibson pitched against Oakland at home was May 4, 2017, when he tossed 4.0 innings allowing four runs on eight hits and striking out three...last win came on May 6, 2019 where he pitched 6.0 shutout innings in a 13-0 Twins win.

HOME SWEET HOME: Gibson is making his 10th appearance at home this season (nine starts) and is looking for his sixth win at Target Field this season...since the beginning of 2018, the Twins have gone 12-11 in home games started by Gibson, as he owns a 9-7 record, 3.68 ERA (129.2 IP, 53 ER) with 49 walks and 121 strikeouts...over his career, Gibson has posted a 29-33 record with a 4.53 ERA across 87 appearances (86 starts) as compared to his 33-32 record (4.33 ERA) on the road.

LEFT AND RIGHT: He has held right-handed hitters to a .257 (47-for-183) average with six home runs, 15 walks and 51 strikeouts while lefties have hit .245 (48-for-199) with eight home runs, 48 strikeouts and 14 walks...for his career, righties have hit .256 (498-for-1948) with 164 walks and 438 strikeouts, while lefties have hit .280 (564-for-2014) with 201 walks and 346 strikeouts.
