**THE TWINS:** The Twins have gone 1-3 to begin their nine-game homestand, losing a two-game series to the Mets, followed by a win and a loss vs. the A's the last two nights...they will continue the homestand tonight with the third of four vs. Oakland...after this series, the Twins will host the Yankees for three games from Monday-Wednesday...16 of the Twins next 28 games are against teams above .500...all those opponents have a combined winning percentage of .515.

**A'S EVEN IT OUT:** The Twins lost to the A's last night by a score of 5-3, evening the four-game series at 1-1...Jake Odorizzi was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing three runs on six hits in 5.0 innings pitched...the offense recorded just seven hits, two from Jason Castro...Marwin Gonzalez drove in two of the three runs with his 11th home run of the season...the attendance was 31,082, their 13th 30-plus in attendance in their last 17 home games.

**ARRAEZ AND SHINE:** Arraez has reached safely in 13 consecutive games and hit safely in 12 straight, the second longest active hit-streak in baseball, trailing Matt Olson (14)...during the on-base streak, he is hitting .347 (17-for-49) with four doubles, one home run, seven runs scored, a .407 on-base percentage and a .897 OPS...below are the Twins longest rookie hitting streaks, dating back to 2000:

**TWINS-A'S:** The Twins and Athletics are playing each other for the sixth of seven times this season...the Twins have gone 15-30 vs. the A's since the start of 2013 for a winning percentage of just .333, the Twins' second lowest winning percentage against any team since (New York-AL - .302).

☞ Nelson Cruz leads all active players with 34 home runs against the Athletics...also leads with 115 RBI, is second with 174 games played and third with 170 hits.

☞ C.J. Cron is hitting .325 (26-for-80) with four doubles, one triple, six home runs, 15 RBI and a 1.011 OPS in his last 21 games vs. Oakland.

☞ Jonathan Schoop is hitting .315 (34-for-108) with six doubles, three home runs, 12 RBI, 15 runs scored and an .805 OPS in 28 career games vs. the A's...he enters tonight with an eight-game hitting streak vs. Oakland.

**SANÓ STORMING:** Miguel Sanó has reached safely in 15 straight games (with an at-bat)...tied for the fifth longest streak of his career, his longest being 21 from September 7-30, 2015...during the streak, he is hitting .327 (16-for-49) with three doubles, one triple, four home runs, 10 RBI, 12 runs scored, 10 walks, a .441 on-base percentage and a 1.114 OPS...also during the streak, he has raised his batting average 39 points (.195 to .234) and his on-base percentage 50 points (.278 to .328).

**WE'RE BRINGIN' BOMBAS BACK:** The Twins 178 home runs are the most in baseball, ahead of Seattle (167)...they have homered in 78 of 96 games, going 51-27 in those games...178 homers already are ninth-most in club history...they need 47 home runs to match their all-time record of 225, set in 1963.

☞ Twins hitters have a launch angle of 25 degrees-or-higher 130 times this season on home runs, the most in baseball (OAK 6th with 111).

☞ Twins have an exit velocity of 100-plus mph on 151 of their home runs this season, the most in baseball (OAK 7th with 130).

☞ Twins have hit 96 homers 400-plus feet, the most in baseball (OAK 12th with 73).

**EXTRA! EXTRA!** The Twins enter tonight having recorded at least one extra-base in 50 straight games, dating back to May 20...tied for 14th longest XBH hit-streak in club history...the club record is 98 straight from June 9-September 29, 2009...for the season, the Twins rank first in baseball in extra-base hits with 390, ahead of Colorado (362).

☞ Max Kepler's 45 extra-base hits are tied for seventh most in the AL and Jorge Polanco's 44 are tied for ninth most.

**ROSTER MOVES:** Earlier today the Twins traded right-handed pitcher Mike Morin to Philadelphia in exchange for cash consideration...Morin was designated for release or assignment on Tuesday...also left-handed pitcher Adalberto Mejia was claimed off waivers by Los Angeles-AL...Mejia was designated for release or assignment on Saturday.

**HAPPY BIRTHDAY, TONY-O!** Twins great Tony Oliva is celebrating his 81st birthday today...he played nine games on his birthday, hitting .364 (12-for-33) with two triples and four RBI.
