SANÓ STORMING: Miguel Sanó has reached safely in 15 straight games (with an at-bat)...tied for the fifth longest streak of his career, his longest being 21 from September 7-30, 2015...during the streak, he is hitting .327 (16-for-49) with three doubles, one triple, four home runs, 10 RBI, 12 runs scored, 10 walks, a .441 on-base percentage and a 1.114 OPS...also during the streak, he has raised his batting average 39 points (.195 to .234) and his on-base percentage 50 points (.278 to .328).

A WEEK IN CLEVELAND: Berríos, who participated in his second All-Star Game in Cleveland on July 9, was fortunate enough to spend an extra few days in Cleveland as the Twins opened the "second half" there as well...was handed the ball in the series finale and gave the Twins 5.0 innings of three-run ball on six hits for the second straight start as they fell 4-3, and were unable to clinch the sweep...allowed a run in the first inning and two more in the fourth, but was unable to pitch past the fifth inning for his second start in a row, after doing so in seven straight from May 24-June 28... in fact, he has allowed 12 runs (9 earned) over his last three starts after surrendering just 37 runs (33 earned) in his first 16 starts.

HISTORY MADE: In his last start, Berríos eclipsed the 500 strikeout threshold by setting down Jake Bauers to end the fifth inning, and his outing...the start was his 91st career game, so he became first pitcher in Senators/Twins history to reach 500 strikeouts in 91 career games or fewer, usurping Bert Blyleven who accomplished the feat in 92 games.

He also became the eighth Twin to do so at 25-or-younger, first since Johan Santana in 2004.

TURNING THE CORNER: Berríos owns a 3.10 ERA through 19 starts this season, and has seen an uptick in performance in a myriad of different pitching categories between 2017-18 and 2019.

*Berríos is tied for fourth in the American League (T-7th in MLB) behind Gerrit Cole (16), Justin Verlander (16) and Mike Fiers (15) with 14 quality starts, while 15 out of his 19 starts have gone at least 6.0 innings (including seven 7.0+ inning efforts)...not only that, but in 90 career starts, Berríos has thrown 44 quality starts (48.9 percent).

YOUNG GUN: At 25 years old, Berríos continues to establish himself as one of the great young pitchers in Twins history...his 3.10 ERA is the lowest by a Twins starter younger than 26 years old since Johan Santana's Cy Young campaign in 2004 (2.61 ERA)...he also enters today's start with just 26 walks in 19 starts...last season, he walked a total of 61 batters in 32 starts...currently sits on an 8.11 SO/9 ratio (110 SO), and is looking to become the third Twins pitcher to have back-to-back seasons with a SO/9 ratio north of 8.00, joining Dave Boswell (1966-67) and Johan Santana (2004-07).

• Kyle Gibson and Jake Odorizzi are also on-pace to have SO/9 rates higher than 8.00, would become

first trio of Twins to do so in the same season.

A LING-ERING STRUGGLE: Berríos comes into today's start having faced Oakland just three times in his career, once this season...hasn't fared too well against the A's, as he's gone 0-2 with a 6.32 ERA (15.2 IP, 11 ER), including a loss in his first start against them on Aug. 26 here at Target Field when he tossed 5.0 innings, allowing three runs on eight hits and four strikeouts in an eventual 6-2 Twins loss.

• In his last start against the A's, he was handed his fifth loss of the year as the Twins fell to

the Athletics on Independence Day after allowing three runs on six hits over 5.0 innings pitched in a 7-2 Twins loss...the 5.0 innings marked the shortest start of his season, and he snapped a seven-game quality start streak dating back to May 24 vs. Chicago-AL...allowed just two baserunners through the first three innings, but scattered five hits, including a solo home run to Marcus Semien, over his final two...exited down 3-2, but the Twins' offense wasn't able to muster anymore runs, while Semien would launch an eighth-inning grand slam to seal the Twins fate...threw 58.1% strikes, his worst showing this year.

THIS IS JOSÉ'S HOUSE: In eight starts at home this season, Berríos is 5-2 with a 2.32 ERA (54.1 IP, 14 ER) with 53 strikeouts, compared to going 3-3, 3.72 ERA (67.2 IP, 28 ER) with 57 strikeouts away from Target Field...has 23 career wins at Target Field, second to only Kyle Gibson since its inception in 2010...below is a chart of all-time wins at Target Field:
