TWINS LOSE RARE HEARTBREAKER: The Twins lost to the A's last night by a score of 5-4...José Berríos was the starter but did not factor into the decision, pitching 5.2 scoreless innings with five hits allowed, three walks and four strikeouts...Taylor Rogers allowed two runs with two outs in the top of the ninth, the Twins first loss this season when leading after 8.0 (53-1)... the offense recorded nine hits, two from both Miguel Sanó and Max Kepler...Nelson Cruz hit his 19th home run, Mitch Garver hit his 17th and Sanó hit his 14th.

TWINS-A's: The Twins and Athletics are playing each other for the final time this season... the Twins have gone 15-31 vs. the A's since the start of 2013 for a winning percentage of just .326, the Twins' second lowest winning percentage against any team since (New York-AL - .302)...Twins are looking to avoid losing their fifth straight series vs. the A's.

▼ Nelson Cruz leads all active players with 35 home runs against the Athletics...also leads with 116 RBI, is second with 175 games played and third with 171 hits.

▼ C.J. Cron is hitting .325 (27-for-83) with four doubles, one triple, six home runs, 15 RBI and a .999 OPS in his last 22 games vs. OAK.

LAST START: Pineda was dealt the loss, his fifth of the season last Tuesday vs. the Mets after tossing 6.0 innings while allowing three runs (one earned) on six hits with zero walks and three strikeouts...Robinson Canó put the Mets on the board with a sacrifice fly that scored Jeff McNeil who reached on a single...a passed ball by Jason Castro put runners at second and third and Michael Conforto, who also reached on a single, then came home on an error by Jonathan Schoop...kept a clean sheet until a wild pitch in the fifth inning allowed Amed Rosario to advance to third after a double and a Conforto single would bring home the Mets' third run of the game...Pineda went three-up, three-down in the sixth before exiting.

 He recorded his third consecutive quality start and his ninth of the season, which ranks second among Twins starters, trailing José Berríos, who has 14.

SIX-PACK: Pineda has allowed just one run in five of his last six starts (5 allowed June 23 at KC)...in that span, he has gone 2-2, 2.60 ERA (34.2 IP, 10 ER) with five walks, 34 strikeouts and an opponent batting average of .234...in fact, in his last three starts he has gone 2-1, 1.50 ERA (18.0 IP, 3 ER) with two walks and 20 strikeouts.

WALK HARD: Through 18 starts, Pineda has only issued 16 walks in 98.2 innings, which is the fewest in the American League and is second fewest in all of baseball among starters with at least 95.0 innings pitched...owns 774 career strikeouts, 173 walks and a lifetime SO/BB ratio of 4.47...he hasn't issued more than three walks since July 31, 2016 at Tampa Bay, a stretch of 46 starts...since 2016, is one of nine starters with an active streak of 40+ starts with three-or-less walks in each, (full list below).

Pineda owns a lifetime record of 12-11 vs. AL West opponents while posting a 4.64 ERA over 191.1 IP...he is 7-4 with a 4.64 ERA vs. AL West opponents on the road as opposed to 5-7 with a 4.67 ERA when facing them at home.
